

Social audit of Kangra govt schools reveals gaps in learning, safety, infra

A large-scale social audit of government schools in Kangra district has uncovered widespread deficiencies, ranging from inadequate classrooms and poor sanitation facilities to serious concerns over student safety and child protection, painting a troubling picture of school education in Himachal Pradesh's largest district. The findings were presented during a public hearing held in Dharamsala on Friday, where more than 2,000 participants — including parents, teachers, School Management Committee (SMC) members, elected representatives, education officials and local residents—gathered to review the audit report and discuss corrective measures. Kangra Deputy Commissioner Hemraj Bhairwa attended the hearing and reviewed the observations. The audit, conducted by a team from Himachal Pradesh University under the leadership of Dr Randhir Ranta, covered 519 schools—nearly 20 per cent of the district's 2,364 educational insti-

tutions. The remaining schools will be assessed in four subsequent phases. Presenting the findings, Dr Ranta said the audit had exposed significant gaps in infrastructure, governance and educational standards that require urgent intervention. "The findings indicate that many schools are struggling to meet the quality benchmarks envisioned under the Right to Education Act," he said. According to the report, nearly 44 per cent of the surveyed schools lack adequate

classroom space and sufficient rooms for teaching and administrative staff. More than a quarter of the institutions were found to have inadequate furniture, adversely affecting the learning environment. Student safety emerged as a major concern. The audit found that over 78 per cent of schools lack boundary walls or fencing, leaving children vulnerable to potential risks. In addition, nearly 65 per cent of the schools are not connected by motorable

roads, creating accessibility challenges, particularly for students with disabilities. Basic amenities remain inadequate in several institutions. Around nine per cent of schools do not have separate toilets for girls, while a similar proportion lack drinking water facilities. Two per cent of the schools surveyed were operating without kitchens for the mid-day meal programme. The audit also highlighted concerns related to adolescent health and well-being.

More than 40 per cent of schools do not provide sanitary pads to girl students, despite their importance in promoting menstrual hygiene and reducing absenteeism. Serious shortcomings were reported in child protection mechanisms. Nearly one-third of the schools have not constituted mandatory school safety committees, while complaint and suggestion boxes were absent in many institutions. None of the schools covered in the audit had access to professional counselling services. The report further pointed to gaps in inclusive education, citing inadequate facilities for children with special needs. Library infrastructure was another weak area, with more than 80 per cent of schools failing to meet prescribed standards. The audit team also flagged weak monitoring practices, noting that field-level education officials were not conducting school visits as frequently as mandated. Additionally, the "One Nation, Great Nation" programme was reportedly not being implemented in 48 per cent of the schools surveyed.

NEET to be held at 12 centres in Kangra today

The National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test (NEET) will be conducted at 12 examination centres across Kangra district tomorrow (June 21). Additional Deputy Commissioner (ADC) Vinay Kumar reviewed the arrangements during a meeting with centre superintendents and officials yesterday. Addressing the meeting, the ADC emphasised the need for close coordination among all departments to ensure the smooth and hassle-free conduct of the examination. He directed officials to complete all necessary arrangements well in advance. Vinay Kumar said elaborate security measures have been put in place for the examination. "Apart from police personnel, the Indo-Tibetan Border Police (ITBP) will also assist in maintaining security at the examination centres," he said. The examination will be held from 2 pm to 5.20 pm. Specially-abled candidates will be provided additional time, and their examination will conclude at 6.20 pm. Candidates will be allowed entry into examination halls

between 11 am and 1.30 pm. The ADC urged aspirants to reach their respective centres well ahead of time to avoid congestion and delays at entry points. He further informed that CCTV cameras and jammers would be installed at all exam-

ination centres. Video recording of candidates and examination-related activities will also be carried out. In addition, the movement of question papers and answer sheets will be monitored through a mobile application to ensure transparency and security. The designated examination centres include Himachal Pradesh Regional Centre, Mohli Khaniyara; Government College, Nagrota Bagwan; Government College, Dharamsala; Rajiv Gandhi Government Engineering College, Nagrota Bagwan; PM Shri Kendriya Vidyalaya (KV), Palampur; Government Senior Secondary School (Boys), Dharamsala; PM Shri Government Senior Secondary School (Girls), Dharamsala; State Institute of Hotel Management (SIHM), Dharamsala; College of Agriculture, Palampur; PM Shri Kendriya Vidyalaya (KV), Bhanala; and other notified centres. Dharamsala Cantonment Kendriya Vidyalaya Principal and City NTA Coordinator Sunil Chauhan briefed the participants on various arrangements and guidelines related to the conduct of the examination.

87 students take part in month-long SAMARTHAN internship at IIT-Una

The one-month-long SAMARTHAN: Internship Connect Programme of the All India Council for Technical Education was inaugurated today at the Indian Institute of Information Technology (IIIT) campus in Saloh village. According to a press release issued by IIIT-Una, the programme aims to provide academic and research exposure to students supported under the Pradhan Mantri Uchchatar Shiksha Protsahan Yojana (PM-USPY), a flagship initiative of the Union Ministry of Education, Government of India. Nauni varsity, forest institute explore collaboration in education, research

In a significant step towards strengthening forestry education and research in India, a high-level delegation from Dr YS Parmar University of Horticulture and Forestry (UHF), Nauni, led by Vice-Chancellor Dr HS Baweja, visited the Forest Research Institute (FRI), Dehradun, to explore avenues for a comprehensive memorandum of understanding (MoU) and long-term collaboration in teaching, research,

extension education and industry engagement. The delegation held extensive discussions with scientists and experts from various departments of the FRI, focusing on opportunities for joint initiatives that could benefit forestry education, research and outreach activities across the country. Discussions focused on developing collaborative academic and research programmes. Key areas identified for cooperation include curriculum development, faculty

exchange, student mobility programmes and joint research projects addressing critical forestry challenges such as biodiversity conservation, climate-resilient silviculture, carbon sequestration, agroforestry systems, invasive species management, non-timber forest products and forest genetic resources. Both institutions evinced interest in strengthening extension education and community outreach activities to ensure that scientific advancements reach stakeholders at

the grassroots level. Collaboration with forest-based industries, start-ups and policy-making bodies were also identified as an important area for future engagement. Dr HS Baweja said, "This visit to the FRI marks an important milestone for both institutions. By combining our strengths in education, research and extension, we can create new opportunities for innovation in forest science and contribute meaningfully to sustainable forest management and climate resilience."
