



Rythu Bharosa from June 30; panel to study VB-GRAMG

TG govt to transfer ₹9,000 crore to ryots' accounts for Kharif 2026-27

THE State government on Thursday announced that it would begin disbursing nearly ₹9,000 crore under the Rythu Bharosa scheme from June 30, constitute a Cabinet sub-committee to examine the implications of the Centre's proposed changes to the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS) under the VB-GRAMG framework, and press the Union government for a larger share of urea produced at the Ramagundam Fertilisers and Chemicals Limited (RFCL) plant for Telangana farmers.

The decisions were taken at an informal Cabinet meeting chaired by Chief Minister A Revanth Reddy at the Secretariat. Briefing the media later, Ministers N Uttam Kumar Reddy, Thummala Nageswara Rao and Danasri Anasuya (Seethakka) said the chief minister would formally launch the Rythu Bharosa payments at a Rythu Sammelanam in Madhira, Khammam district, on June 30.

The government will transfer around ₹9,000 crore directly into farmers' accounts over nine

days as crop investment support for the ongoing Kharif 2026-27 season.

Seethakka said the Cabinet had decided to constitute a sub-committee comprising Uttam, Nageswara Rao, Vivek Venkataswamy and herself to study the proposed MGNREGS reforms. The committee will examine developments in other States, assess the financial burden on Telangana and recommend Telangana's future course of action. She said the government would also write to the Centre opposing VB-GRAMG.

The minister said the government was concerned that some of the proposed changes could reduce employment opportunities while increasing the financial burden on States. The committee would consult stakeholders and submit its recommendations shortly, she added.

Nageswara Rao said the Cabinet had decided to seek a larger share of urea produced at the RFCL plant in Ramagundam instead of allowing substantial quantities to be transported to distant States. Allocating locally produced fertiliser to Telangana farmers would reduce transportation costs and help prevent shortages during the agricultural season, he said.

He said the Centre had assured monthly allocations of around two lakh metric tonnes of urea but had not supplied the committed quantities in recent months. The minister also expressed concern over what he described as inadequate procurement of Telangana-grown crops by Central agencies. He said that while the State had procured large quantities of paddy and around 15 lakh MT of maize, Central agencies had not procured crops.

TVK govt to fight for due share of funds

THE TVK government led by Chief Minister C Joseph Vijay on Thursday, through the customary address of Governor Rajendra Arlekar, outlined an ambitious governance agenda that mirrored the position of former Dravidian governments on education and economic sovereignty, while committing itself to transparent administration, economic revival, and eradication of corruption.

The new government also promised to conduct a "social justice survey" soon after the Census and form a "special legal committee" to fight for the funds due from the Union government.

Reforms in education, industry, law and order, environment, tourism, temple administration, and poverty alleviation were the other focal areas of the address. After years, the governor's cus-

tomary address was smooth, starting with the Thamizhthai Vaazhthu, followed by the National Anthem. The governor hailed the rendition of the National Anthem at both the beginning and end of the Assembly session as the dawn of a new era.

The Vijay government, through the governor's address, conveyed its strong opposition to the National Education Policy 2020, particularly the three-language formula, while promising to introduce structural reforms aimed at providing world-class education to students.

It termed as unacceptable the centre's position that the release of ₹3,458 crore due to Tamil Nadu under the Samagra Shiksha Abhiyan was contingent upon the implementation of the three-language policy. The State would urge the centre to delink the release of funds and language policy, Arlekar said.

Mysuru emerges as transit hub in Odisha-Andhra ganja network

THE seizure of nearly 280 kg of ganja by the Mysuru City Police last week, followed by the recovery of another 110 kg in neighbouring Mandya district on

Wednesday, has once again exposed a growing narcotics corridor linking the cannabis-producing regions of Odisha and Andhra Pradesh with southern Karnataka.

Investigating officers told

TNIE that these are not isolated incidents but part of a well-established supply chain that has been operating for years.

Large quantities of ganja cultivated in remote forest belts along the Odisha-Andhra border

are finding their way into the Mysuru region through a network of transporters, middlemen and local distributors, turning the area into a major transit point for the illegal trade across South India. Police sources said

traffickers are increasingly using the highway network to move consignments from eastern India. Vehicles carrying ganja often enter Karnataka through Andhra Pradesh before reaching Mysuru.

K'taka MLC elections: Cong wins five seats, BJP 2; cross-voting jolts JDS

IN the biennial polls to elect seven MLCs from the Karnataka Legislative Assembly on Thursday, the ruling Congress won five seats and the opposition BJP won two. The JDS, which fielded a lone candidate and was expecting the support of its alliance partner BJP, faced a humiliating defeat.

The victory comes as a morale-booster for the Congress government, and a shot in the arm for Chief Minister DK Shivakumar. The cross-voting jolted both the BJP and JDS. Eleven legislators, seven

from the BJP and four from JDS, reportedly cross-voted to hand a massive victory to Vinay Karthik. The Congress polled 151 first preference votes.

Candidates BK Hariprasad, also KPCC president, Thippannappa Kamakanoor and Shivanna BS secured 30 votes each, PV Mohan got 29 and Vinay Karthik pocketed 32 votes, and emerged winners. BJP's Raghu R Kautilya polled 29 and Lingaraj Patil got 27. Their term will be six years in the Upper House. JDS' lone candidate Inchara Govindaraju garnered only 14 votes to face defeat.
