

2 killed, 8 hurt as vehicles collide head-on near Annur

Driver of one car attempted to overtake a bike, resulting in the crash

TWO persons were killed and eight others sustained injuries following a road accident near Annur in Coimbatore on Thursday afternoon after two multipurpose vehicles collided head-on on Sathyamangalam Road.

The accident occurred around 2.30 pm on Thursday near Chettiyar Mill bus stop at Pasur.

According to police, M Devanan (73) of Vadakkalur was proceeding from Annur towards Puliyampatti on his moped when an MPV driven by K Karu Marimuthu (42) of Ponnegoundanpudur near Annur, a BJP North district functionary, attempted to overtake the two-wheeler.

In the process, the vehicle collided head-on with another MPV headed from the opposite direction, travelling from Puliyampatti towards Annur. The four occupants of the car from Manangudi — Parasuram (42), Palanivel (52), Vikram (23) and Sathish (22) — were returning after attending a marriage function. Parasuram and Palanivel sustained injuries on impact and were shifted to the government hospital at Annur, but were declared brought dead.

Vikram and Sathish sustained injuries and are undergoing treatment. Five occupants of the car driven by Marimuthu, including his wife Jothimani (38), Pannari (60), his wife Rukmani (58) and their son Murugan (36), were also injured and admitted to a private hospital at Thirumuruganpoondi.

Devanan also sustained injuries and is being treated.

Annur police reached the spot, regulated traffic and shifted the injured to hospitals. A case was registered and further investigation is under way.

ELECTRICIAN KILLED AS STEAM UNIT EXPLODES DURING REPAIR WORK

A 35-year-old electrician was killed after a steam iron compressor exploded while he was repairing it at a private garment unit in Avinashi in Tiruppur district.

The deceased has been identified as Selvam of Perundurai in Erode district.

He was working as an electrician at a private knitwear company at the Nethaji Apparel Park at New Tiruppur

near Avinashi.

Police said Selvam had gone to the ironing section of the unit on Thursday to fix a leakage in the steam iron.

While he was working on it, the steam compressor burst unexpectedly, and he was killed on the spot.

Avinashi police recovered the body and sent it to Tiruppur Government Medical College Hospital for postmortem examination.

A case was registered and further investigation is under way, said police sources.



EPFO to disburse ₹84 cr benefits under PM scheme

THE regional office of the Employees' Provident Fund Organisation (EPFO) would disburse incentives worth a total of ₹84 crore to the employers and employees under the jurisdiction of Coimbatore Zone at events to be held at nine locations on Friday (June 19).

The regional events are a part of the programmes being organised under the Pradhan Mantri Viksit Bharat Rojgar Yojana (PMVBRY) across the nation on Friday, in which incentives worth a total of ₹2,400 crore would be disbursed.

At a press briefing in Coimbatore on Thursday, Additional Central PF Commissioner Swagata Rai and Regional PF Commissioner K Prasant said that 41,701 employees would receive incentives worth ₹21 crore during an event to be held at Hin-

dusthan College in Coimbatore on Friday.

Swagata Rai said, "A total of 2,94,803 establishments have registered under the scheme in Coimbatore Zone since the implementation in August 2025. In the second phase of incentive disbursement, ₹63.5 crore incentives will be disbursed to 3,225 establishments in Coimbatore Zone." She added that the events would be organised in Coimbatore, Tiruppur, Salem, Krishnagiri, Tiruchy, Madurai, Dindigul, Tirunelveli, and Nagercoil on Friday.

Prasant said, "In March, benefits amounting to ₹247 crore were disbursed under phase I of the scheme to 4.41 lakh first-time employees. Under the scheme, first-time employees with EPFO and earning wages up ₹1 lakh a month are eligible to receive an incentive equivalent to one month's wage, up to a maximum of ₹15,000, in two instalments."

Bharathiar univ to hold 89th senate meeting in July

COIMBATORE: After an 18-month gap, Bharathiar University is set to convene its 89th senate meeting in July. A senate member, who did not wish to be named, told TNIE that the delay in conducting the meeting amounted to an administrative lapse on the university's part. He said he is going to raise a question about the failure to conduct senate meetings on time, pointing out that, as per norms, the university must hold senate meetings twice in an academic year, in June and January. According to sources, Bharathiar University last held a senate meeting in January 2025, during which members raised several issues concerning the tenure of principals in affiliated colleges and administrative inefficiencies. A senior university official told TNIE that a syndicate meeting would be held at the end of this month, while the senate meeting is scheduled for the second week of July.

TNAU admission rank list to be out on June 23

WITH the application process ending on Wednesday, Tamil Nadu Agricultural University (TNAU) will release the rank list for admission to its undergraduate and diploma courses for the 2026-27 academic year on June 23.

An official from TNAU told TNIE that online registration for admission to 14 undergraduate courses and three diploma courses offered by the university's constituent colleges, affiliated colleges, and the Faculty of Agriculture at Annamalai University commenced on May 6 and concluded on June 17. "As many as 29,961 applications have been received for the 7,592 undergraduate seats available in TNAU constituent colleges, affiliated colleges, and Annamalai University. For 1,240 seats in diploma courses, 1,954 applications have been received," he said. "TNAU will release the rank list on June 23, and candidates can seek corrections to the rank list from June 24 to 27. Offline counselling for diploma courses will be held on June 29. Online counselling for undergraduate courses under the general category and the 7.5% government school reservation quota will be conducted from July 6 to 12," he added. He further said that counselling for the special category is held on July 16. "Certificate verification for admission confirmation will be conducted in four phases between July 20 and August 27. Dates for supplementary candidates will be announced after the publication of supplementary examination results by the school education department. Colleges are scheduled to reopen on September 9, while spot admissions for undergraduate courses will begin on September 15," he said.
