

Telangana's Singareni gets Rs 40 cr refund for successful closure of Dorli-2 Opencast Mine

Hyderabad, June 10 (Agency)

The Singareni Collieries Company Limited (SCCL) has received approval for the refund of nearly Rs 40 crore, including accrued interest, from the Coal Controller Organisation (CCO) following the successful closure of the Dorli-2 Opencast Mine in Bel-lampalli Area in accordance with the Ministry of Coal's guidelines. The refund is a recognition of the company's commitment to environmentally sustainable mining practices and its effective implementation of mine closure obligations, the state owned mining company said in a release here on Wednesday.

ECoR observes International Level Crossing Awareness Day

East Coast Railway (ECoR) observed International Level Crossing Awareness Day (ILCAD) on 9th June 2026 across its jurisdiction with a series of awareness programmes aimed at promoting safe behaviour at railway level crossings and preventing accidents caused by unsafe road user practices. The observance was held in line with the global ILCAD campaign slogan "Alert Today, Safe Tomorrow", emphasizing the importance of vigilance, patience and responsible conduct at railway crossings. Through public announcements, distribution of safety pamphlets, display of posters, counselling sessions, awareness rallies and street plays, road users were educated on the need to obey warning signals and gate barriers, stop before crossing railway tracks, avoid trespassing and refrain from using mobile phones or earphones while approaching railway crossings. The campaign prominently carried the message "Someone is Waiting for You", reminding road users that a few moments of patience at a railway crossing can save lives and ensure a safe return to their loved ones. The initiative highlighted that trains cannot stop instantly and that strict adherence to safety rules is essential for preventing accidents and safeguarding lives. The observance reflects East Coast Railway's unwavering commitment to enhancing railway safety through public awareness, community participation and continuous safety initiatives. It also served as a reminder that safety at level crossings is a collective responsibility and that every responsible action contributes to safer journeys for all. End of Years of Waiting; New Anganwadi Centre Opened at Ghutana

A task that could not be accomplished during the tenure of two previous BDOs has finally been turned into reality by Bisam Cuttack Block Development Officer (BDO) Shiva Patnaik and his technical team. After assuming charge, Rayagada District Collector Ashutosh Kulkarni reviewed the status of Anganwadi centres across the district and directed officials to expedite the completion of unfinished and long-pending projects. Following this, Chief Development Officer Akshaya Khemundu is said to have regularly reviewed the progress of such important projects and instructed BDOs to complete them on a war footing.

As a result, the Anganwadi Centre project sanctioned during the financial year 2021-22 for Ghutana village under Raskola Gram Panchayat in Bisam Cuttack Block, with an approved budget of Rs. 10 lakh, has now been completed. The centre was formally inaugurated in the presence of BDO Shiva Patnaik, CDPO Sagarika Sahu, Additional Assistant Engineer Ramesh Sahu, Engineer Sagar Gouda, Sarpanch Rita Bredeka, and other Panchayat representatives. Earlier, the same Panchayat had witnessed the completion of another project that had remained unfinished for nearly eight years. The BDO and his technical team successfully completed that project in a record nine days. The project was subsequently inaugurated statewide by the Hon'ble Chief Minister through a one-time virtual programme.

The company had deposited Rs 26.79 crore with the State Bank of India during 2013-14 as an escrow fund towards environmental protection measures, land reclamation, rehabilitation activities and other mine closure commitments mandated by the Ministry of Coal. After seven years of coal production, the Dorli-2 Opencast Mine was closed during 2023-24. To verify compliance, a third-party audit was conducted in July 2024 by the Indian Institute of Engineering Science and Technology (IIEST), Shibpur, West Bengal. The audit confirmed that SCCL had fulfilled all mine closure



obligations and complied with the prescribed environmental and statutory norms. Deputy Assistant Coal Controller Akash Shiva Hare, in a recent communication, informed SCCL that 90 per cent of the refundable amount, amounting to Rs 36.63 crore, would be released immediately. The company stated that the refund also acknowledges its transparent implementation of environmental safeguards, land reclamation works and rehabilitation commitments undertaken throughout the life cycle of management over the years as a responsible citizen.

Rajasthan: Seven killed, several injured in cracker factory fire in Jaipur

Jaipur, June 10 (Representative) At least 7 persons were killed several others injured in a massive fire that broke out in the godown of an 'illegal cracker factory in Khoh Nagauriya area on outskirts of Jaipur today. According police and fire brigade sources, one Feroze of New Delhi in association with Wasim was running illegal cracker factory and godown in the Aayasha Nagar Talai Colony. The fire broke out around 11:15am in the portion where crackers made in the nearby factory were stored. Around 20 labourers were at work in the factory when the mishap took place. While some were rescued by locals and emergency rescue teams of the police and the civil defence, some ran for safety on their own. Locals have saved lives of a couple of seriously burnt persons by retrieving them out and rushing them to hospital. The injured were rushed to the nearby hospital from where critically injured were referred to the SMS Hospital here. The Principal cum Comptroller of the SMS Medical College Hospital, Jaipur, Dr Deepak Maheshwari said that 7 persons including a child were killed in the incident. Five of the deceased have been identified so far, he said. According to eyewitnesses, the locals also succeeded in safely removing a gas cylinder found in the on fire premise and prevented the situation
