DHAKA, JUN 12: India's new High Commissioner to Bangladesh Dinesh Trivedi arrived in the country on Friday through the Petrapole-Benapole land border to take up his diplomatic assignment. Trivedi, who is the first politician to serve as India's envoy to Bangladesh, was seen walking into the country carrying his own trolley bag as the land border gate was opened. He was accompanied by his wife, Mrinal Trivedi.

"Nice to be here," Trivedi said after crossing the border.

Senior Bangladesh and Indian High Commission officials received him at the Benapole land border.

Trivedi, a former Union minister and leader of the Bharatiya Janata Party, succeeds Pranay Kumar Verma, a 1994-batch officer of the Indian Foreign Service.

Verma's four-year tenure, which ended last month, witnessed the ouster of Sheikh Hasina's government in a student-led uprising in August 2024 and a subsequent downturn in India-Bangladesh relations under the interim administration led by Muhammad Yunus. After his arrival on Friday, Trivedi briefly interacted with Bangladeshi reporters in the border area, where he said India and Bangladesh should work together in areas such as sports, health and technology for future generations by leveraging the talent and resources of both countries.

frontation between protesters and law enforcement personnel near Rawalakot, one activist was killed, and several others were injured.

The deceased was identified by fellow protesters as 32-year-old Sohban Arif from Sudhnoti district. JAAC leaders reiterated that the return of bodies of slain activists, release of detained mem-

bers, and withdrawal of the ban on the organisation were among the conditions for ending the sit-ins.

JAAC representative Imtiaz Aslam told protesters that demonstrations would continue until authorities hand over the bodies of activists to their families and revoke notifications proscribing the committee.
