Mumbai: At least three legislators of Shiv Sena (UBT) on Monday skipped a meeting convened by embattled Shiv Sena (UBT) chief Uddhav Thackeray in Mumbai to discuss a strategy to corner the Maharashtra government.

Thackeray chaired the meeting of MLAs and MLCs at the party office 'Shivalay' on the first day of the monsoonsession, even as six MPs of Sena (UBT) formally joined the Eknath Shinde-led Shiv Sena, just 500 metres away at the Yashwantrao Chavan Pratishthan.

MLC polls: Rebel defeats Sena in Nashik; BJP wins in Aurangabad

Mumbai: BJP rebel Gokul G. Deshpande surprised on Monday as he swept Maharashtra legislative council's Nashik district local governing body constituency, defeating ruling Shiv Sena's candidate.

In Nanded, Aurangabad-Jalna and Osmanabad-Latur-Bed seats, BJP candidates won, as counting was being held on Monday for the June 18 elections to 11 seats in the state legislature's Upper House.

The biennial elections were originally notified for 17 seats, including one held by a buty, but this was reduced to only 11 constituencies as candidates of the Mahayuti alliance, comprising the RJP, Shinde-led Shiv Sena and Sunetra Pawar's NCP, secured unexpected victories in six seats. In Nashik, Gide secured 357 votes against Darade's 248, winning by 109 votes, as per election officials. His victory came as a surprise, as the ruling party candidate was expected to put up a strong challenge.

Darade belonged to the Ek-nath Shinde-led Shiv Sena, which has been in the spotlight following the arrest of its leader, the nine Shiv Sena (UBT) Lok Sabha members, with two of them confirming their switch to the ruling Sena, en-

The bench said Collegium's decision is based on its subjective satisfaction. Neither the SC nor the HC is taking up petitions and issuing directions (on recommending one candidate or the other). "The issue is whether the SC is free for appointment of judges to constitutional courts is neither amenable to judicial review nor is it within the ambit of RTI Act," it said.

"We do not want to open a Pandora's box. We will not interfere in the Collegium decisions. We are not recommending that hundreds of candidates are called for interviews are called for interviews prior to selecting a few and recommending their names for elevation as judges of the HC by the Collegium.
