Act on B'gavi row probe: Chief secy to officials

THE long-standing controversy over the implementation of resolutions reaffirming Belagavi's status as an integral part of Karnataka, as well as other Kannada-related concerns, has entered its final phase. Acting on a formal complaint, the office of the State Chief Secretary has instructed the relevant authorities to undertake a detailed investigation

tion and take necessary action in accordance with the outcome of the inquiry.

The functioning of the Belagavi City Corporation has been facing allegations of acting against Karnataka's interests for quite a long time. The officials have also been instructed to submit a detailed report to the government and inform the complainant about the action taken.



The directive was issued on June 10 following a petition submitted to the Chief Minister's Office by Ashok Chandrangi, the president of the Belagavi District Kannada Organisations Action Committee.

The communication further mandates that details of the action be uploaded to the Janaspandana IGRS portal and that a formal response be provided to the complainant. Kannada organi-

sations have raised objections to several decisions and policies adopted by the corporation, alleging official indifference to concerns relating to language and regional identity.

Authorities are expected to explain, with supporting records, what decisions were allegedly taken against the interests of Kannada and Karnataka, who was responsible for them, and whether there were lapses in implementing the state's language policy.

KARNATAKA is set to celebrate the 12th International Yoga Day on June 21 with a series of programmes across the state under the theme 'Yoga for Healthy Ageing.' The main state-level event will be held at 7 am on the grand steps of Vidhana Soudha in Bengaluru on Sunday and is expected to attract around 2,000 practitioners and members. Governor Thawar Chand Gehlot will inaugurate the programme. Chief Minister DK Shivakumar, Deputy CM Dr G Parameshwara, Health Minister UT Khader, and other dignitaries will attend the event. Actor Sudharani, Vasishtha Simha and Haripriya will participate as special guests.

A 40-minute common yoga protocol session will be held. Khader said this year's celebrations aim to move beyond a symbolic one-day observance and encourage yoga as a daily practice. The government has launched 'Nitya Yoga', a year-round initiative designed to promote regular yoga practice among rural communities, women, children and senior citizens. Special yoga programmes will be conducted throughout the year in AYUSH institutions

and Ayushman Health Centres, particularly in rural areas.

The AYUSH Department organised several activities at the state, district and taluk levels in line with the International Yoga Day theme. A national symposium on 'Yoga for Healthy Ageing' under the concept of 'Science Yoga' is organised by Indian Institute of Science (IISc) in Bengaluru.

Seminars are scheduled to be held at Sri Jayadeva Institute of Cardiovascular Sciences and Research and Kidwai Memorial Institute of Oncology respectively in the coming weeks.

As part of the run-up to Yoga Day, the Government Ayurveda

Research Centre in Mysuru completed a 100-day countdown campaign and organised 12 national-level online competitions. Karnataka conducted yoga-related competitions in at least 1,000 government schools.

The Bangalore Metro Rail Corporation Limited (BMRL) has announced early morning services across all Namma Metro corridors starting at 5 am from all terminal stations, instead of the usual Sunday start time of 7 am. BMRL said the special arrangement is made to enable participants to conveniently attend Yoga Day programmes.

Man dies by suicide, alleges extortion over atrocity case

BENGALURU: A 48-year-old man allegedly died by suicide after claiming that he was subjected to harassment, blackmail and extortion in connection with what he described as a false atrocity case. The incident was reported from Channasandra, under the Kadugodi police station limits, on Friday night. The deceased, identified as Papanna, allegedly consumed poison after recording a video in which he named five people, including a woman, and held them responsible for his death.

According to the police, Papanna sent the video to his friends around 10.05 pm. In the video, he alleged that the accused had extorted nearly Rs. 10 lakh from him over the years by promising to withdraw an atrocity case registered against him in 2021. He further claimed that they had filed another false case and continued to demand money. ENS

Techie and YouTuber among 3 held in Rukmini Vasanth case

THE background of the three accused arrested by the Cyber Crime Police for circulating objectionable Artificial Intelligence (AI) images and videos of actress Rukmini Vasanth on social media has shocked the police officials. The trio are well-educated and were holding respectable positions in society. One of them was a software engineer, while the other with a nursing degree was a YouTuber and the third accused was working in a reputed chartered accountancy firm in the city. Three high-end mobile phones that were allegedly used in the crime were recovered from the trio.

G Ravikumari (24) of Chilakumki in Bagalkot had completed a degree in nursing and was running a YouTube channel. Having recently received his first earnings from YouTube, he allegedly developed a desire to

make quick and easy money and began creating and uploading deep fake videos of actresses.

L Chandrakanth, (33), from Thirthahalli taluk in Shivamogga and a resident of Kamakshipalya, was employed at a reputed chartered accountancy firm in Bengaluru. Despite that he allegedly created deep fake images of actresses for personal gratification.

R Ranjith (25), from Mahalakshmi Nagar 4th Main Road in Nagasandra, is a software engineer earning an annual package of Rs 20 lakh. Police said that the accused who had a strong technical background confessed to creating AI-generated deep fake videos of leading actresses purely for "fun" and entertainment. The actress had filed a case at Cyber Crime Police Station of Bengaluru City.

The accused had created the AI videos of the actress with the intention of portraying her in a derogatory manner.
