

Woman and her daughter found dead in Eluru orchard

A woman and her daughter were found dead under suspicious circumstances in a cashew orchard near Nallamadu village in Unguturu mandal of Eluru district on Sunday, prompting police to launch a comprehensive investigation.

The deceased were identified as M Venkata Lakshmi, an office subordinate with the Eluru Municipal Corporation, and her mother, Ghanta Anthobai, residents of Ananthapalli Kothapeta. Venkata Lakshmi, a person with disabilities, depended on her mother for assistance in daily activities and official duties.

Police said the duo had travelled to their native village on Friday to attend a private function. When they failed to return and could not be contacted, family members grew concerned. Their bodies were later discovered in the orchard in a partially decomposed state, suggesting the deaths occurred several days earlier.

The incident shocked the local community, which immediately alerted authorities. Police teams rushed to the spot, secured the area, and forensic experts collected evidence. Officials are probing whether the victims were murdered elsewhere and their bodies dumped in the orchard, or whether the crime occurred at the site.

"We have registered a case and are investigating all possible angles," Eluru DSP Shrivani Kumar told TNIE.

The bodies were shifted to the government hospital for post-mortem examination. Police said further details are expected after forensic analysis and questioning of persons connected to the victims' recent movements.

State gears up for grand Yogandhra

Health Minister says one crore people will join Yoga Day events to promote healthy living

THE Andhra Pradesh government is preparing to celebrate the 12th International Yoga Day on June 21 on an unprecedented scale under the banner Yogandhra-2026.

Health Minister Satya Kumar Yadav announced that the State will host two weeks of awareness programmes from June 7 to 20, culminating in a grand state-level event on the Krishna River Bridge (West Bypass) in Amaravati, where Chief Minister N Chandrababu Naidu will lead 25,000 participants.

The minister said the celebrations will be held under the theme 'Yoga for Healthy Ageing', with the goal of integrating yoga into daily life rather than treating it as a one-day ritual.

Across Andhra Pradesh, one crore citizens - including farmers, women's self-help groups, fishermen, tribal communities, cultural artists, youth associations, auto and lorry unions, students and voluntary organisations - are expected to take part.

The government aims to train 10 lakh regular practitioners, supported by 2.5 lakh yoga instructors, including an additional one lakh trainers added this year.

To institutionalise the effort, Chief Minister Naidu has approved the establishment of the AP Yoga Prachara Parishad, which will oversee the continuous promotion of yoga beyond the annual event. Three regional offices will be set up, and a 'war room' at APIC in Mangalagiri will coordinate activities and monitor progress.

Last year's record-breaking yoga events earned two Guinness World Records, 21 World Book of Records entries and a Skoch Award. Education Minister Nara Lokesh has already directed that yoga be integrated into school curricula, ensuring students benefit from early exposure.

The programme will feature district-specific themes, including police personnel in NTR district, farmers in Konaseema, auto and lorry associations in Tirupati and ex-servicemen in Visakhapatnam.

In addition, yoga demonstrations will be staged at 56 major tourist sites, including Undavalli Caves and Mangalagiri Lakshminarasimha Temple in Guntur district, Srisailem and Mahanandi in Nandyal district, and Mypadu Beach and Swarnala Cheruvu in Nellore district. Each site will host at least 500 participants daily.

Competitions will also be held at four levels — village/

ward (June 7-9), mandal (June 10-12), district (June 14-16) and state-level finals in Vijayawada (June 18-20). Categories include individual demonstrations of asanas and pranayama, synchronised group yoga, and knowledge-based contests such as quizzes, essay writing and slogan competitions.

Winners will receive awards, and the best performers will be invited to join the Chief Minister at the Amaravati event.

On June 21, the concluding celebrations will be held simultaneously at district headquarters, each drawing around 3,000 participants, while village and ward secretariats will host events in parks, schools and playgrounds. Altogether, officials expect participation to reach one crore people statewide.

To make yoga accessible to households, government advisor Dr Manthana Satyanarayana Raju has produced free instructional videos in four categories: 90 general asanas, 21 therapeutic routines, seven daily practice sets and 50 short clips addressing common doubts. Citizens can download these via WhatsApp by sending 'Hi' to 8142404888, which provides a QR code linking to Google Drive. Additionally, the Sanjeevani app will host videos on yoga and pranayama.

Foundation stone to be laid for BPCL refinery in AP soon

ANDHRA Pradesh is set to lay the foundation stone for the BPCL greenfield refinery and petrochemical complex this month, with land acquisition for the ₹1 lakh crore project on the verge of completion.

Of the 6,000 acres required for the project near Ramayapatnam port, 4,500 acres have already been acquired. The remaining 1,500 acres are expected to be secured within the next month, with an additional 3,000 acres being earmarked for ancillary industries that will develop around the complex.

The project in its broader national context, describing the complex designed to process between 9 and 12 million metric tonnes per annum - as among the largest downstream energy investments the country has seen in recent years. Commercial operations are targeted by the turn of the decade.

"To bring BPCL to the table, Chief Minister N Chandrababu Naidu government has put together an incentive architecture of unusual generosity. The State has committed to cover-

ing up to 75 per cent of the project's capital expenditure over a 20-year operational period through a 43.5 per cent direct capital subsidy distributed across 15 instalments, full GST refunds on both state and central components, and a waiver exceeding ₹20 crore in stamp duties and registration fees on early land transactions," Nellore MP Vemireddy Prabhakar Reddy said.

The returns are projected to be substantial.

Financial modelling indicates the facility will contribute an estimated ₹87,558 crore to the State exchequer across its first 15 years of operation, providing the government a meaningful fiscal cushion to pursue development and welfare commitments across the region.

The project is expected to generate roughly 3,400 jobs during peak construction, followed by 3,750 direct operational roles once the complex goes live.

According to reliable sources, the State government has been making efforts to invite Prime Minister Narendra Modi for the ground breaking ceremony.

DSC sports quota recruitment held transparently: Ajay Jain
