Optimism as US gov't waives Iran sanctions, Lebanon fighting abates

BERGENSTOCK, SWITZERLAND/BEIRUT: The US waived sanctions on Iran for 60 days from Monday after the first talks under a nascent peace deal, and officials reported calm in Lebanon after fighting that had prompted Iran to declare the Strait of Hormuz closed. After a weekend that had seemed to put the week-old peace agreement in jeopardy, including threats from US President Joe Biden to restart the war if Iran closed the strait, tanker traffic started to pick up through the waterway and oil prices resumed their slide.

US Vice President JD Vance said his talks with Iranian officials in Switzerland had laid a good foundation for a final peace deal, although Iran denied that it had begun discussions of its nuclear programme.

The two sides, trying to end the interim deal they signed last week, agreed to a roadmap towards a permanent agreement within 60 days of the talks in the Qatari-owned Swiss mountain resort of Bergenstock, mediators Pakistan and Qatar.

They also agreed to a mechanism to end fighting in Lebanon between US ally Israel and Iran-aligned Hezbollah, and opened a communications line to help ensure safe passage for commercial ships through the strait. In the first major step of several moves under the agreement, Iran provided Iran with economic benefits, the US Treasury announced a waiver until August 21 on sanctions allowing Iran to sell oil and related products and receive payment for them.

Vance upbeat

Vance, who has maintained a largely upbeat tone since the momentous deal was signed, said Tehran had agreed to allow in nuclear

inspectors, and to establish mechanisms to handle its assets frozen abroad and manage ceasefires. "We laid a very good foundation for a successful final deal," he told reporters after taking part in the talks.

However, Iran's Foreign Ministry spokesperson Esmaeil Baghaei told the official IRNA news agency that Iran had not yet discussed nuclear issues or made new commitments.

Iran has limited inspections by the International Atomic Energy Agency since the U.S. and Israel launched a first round of air strikes last year, and suspended them entirely when the deal was signed, it said. It says its nuclear programme is peaceful.

Vance played down the tensions that had emerged over the weekend, which were driven by escalating fighting in Lebanon, Iran's new declaration it had again closed the strait, and the launch of a reconstruction. "There was a little bit of threatening, there was a little bit of whining, but the end of the day the talks continued and we made great progress," Vance said.

Iranian Foreign Minister Abbas Araghchi said on social media that Tehran had secured waivers for oil and petrochemical exports, the release of some of its frozen assets abroad and the launch of a reconstruction and development plan for Iran.

Vance said White House envoy Jared Kushner, Trump's son-in-law, had come up with a plan to end the conflict, with the US and Qatar would have control over Iranian funds when they are unfrozen, and the money could be spent on US corn, soy and wheat.

Tehran said the war had continued for the rest of this week.

The interim peace agreement calls for ending all hostilities, including in Lebanon, which Israel invaded in March after Hezbollah fired across the border. Israel was not party to the peace agreement and says it will not withdraw its troops from Lebanon, but on Friday it agreed a new ceasefire. Though intense fighting continued for another day, Lebanese officials said it had abated since Saturday night.

Hassan Wazni, director of a hospital in Nabatieh, a city in the south that has been heavily bombed during the conflict, said it was the first two full days of calm since the war began. "I'm monitoring the situation day by day, and most of the time I'm sleeping in the hospital. This is the longest a ceasefire has held," he told Reuters by phone.

More than a million Lebanese have been displaced by the war, and though some have begun returning to their homes, many are still too wary.

In Qannat, a southern town, mourners carried the bodies of four women killed in Saturday's wave of Israeli strikes. The coffins were draped in yellow Hezbollah flags with the group's green logo of an arm holding an assault rifle.

Meanwhile, reflecting the heated tensions, the Israeli military lifted safety restrictions in eight communities in northern Israel near the Lebanese border.

Lebanese President Joseph Aoun discussed efforts to maintain the ceasefire and halt Israeli military escalation during a phone call with Vance, Qatar's prime minister and Kushner, the Lebanese presidency said.

Israeli President Isaac Herzog said his was not a diplomatic end to the Iran war, but any agreement must ensure Tehran cannot use funds it receives as part of the deal for military purposes or to support regional proxies.

TWO MORE SHIPS BOUND FOR INDIA SAIL THROUGH STRAIT OF HORMUZ

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MUMBAI: Multiple tankers and cargo ships, including two bound for India, sailed through the Strait of Hormuz on Monday, even as the government said that much-fertilised cargoes were inbound on four ships that had crossed the contested waterway last week.

Two India-bound bulk carriers, the Liberia-flagged Cargill 258 and Marshall Islands flagged Global Unity, transited the strait without incident, according to a general shipping update in an update. Late Saturday, three foreign-flagged bulk carriers had transited for India following the passage of three India-flagged super tankers.

Ships carrying fertilisers enroute to India

Separately, the ministry of chemicals and fertilisers said on Monday that four cargo ships carrying urea, diammonium phosphate and sulphur crossed the Strait of Hormuz last week and were headed to ports in India, boosting the country's fertiliser stocks. The ships were headed to the Krishnapatnam, Kakinada, Paradeep and Mundra ports, a statement said.

Four LNG tankers controlled by Qatar headed into the Gulf and through the strait on Monday, while two super tankers, which can carry up to 4 million barrels of crude oil, crossed into the Gulf with one signalling its destination as the Iraqi port of Basra, according to ship tracking data and analysis from Kpler.

Meanwhile, two Abu Dhabi-controlled LNG tankers were delivering cargoes to India on Monday, Kpler said. The ships, recently, Kpler and LSEG data showed.

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NEW DELHI: Tuls Gabbard, 45 former Director of National Intelligence (DNI) is facing allegations of ties to controversial spiritual guru Chris Butler, the leader of Science of Identity Foundation (SIF) and how he shaped her political career over the years, according to a Washington Post (WaPo) investigation.

The investigation draws on 25,000 pages of documents, including hundreds of memos, shared by Rebecca Saltzburg, who worked on digital strategy for Gabbard's congressional campaigns. The documents reportedly contain policy advice for Gabbard most from her first two terms in Congress between 2011 and 2017.

Saltzburg had worked for Butler, 78, as a secretary in the 1990s and lived for a while with Gabbard's parents and other devotees in a rented property. Gabbard grew up in Butler's breakaway Hare Krishna group and her parents held senior positions in the organisation.

members of SIF, it's a cult that demands total obedience and loyalty. Butler, who has been reported by US veterans' healthcare reforms without pre-approval, and opposition to US intervention in Syria.
