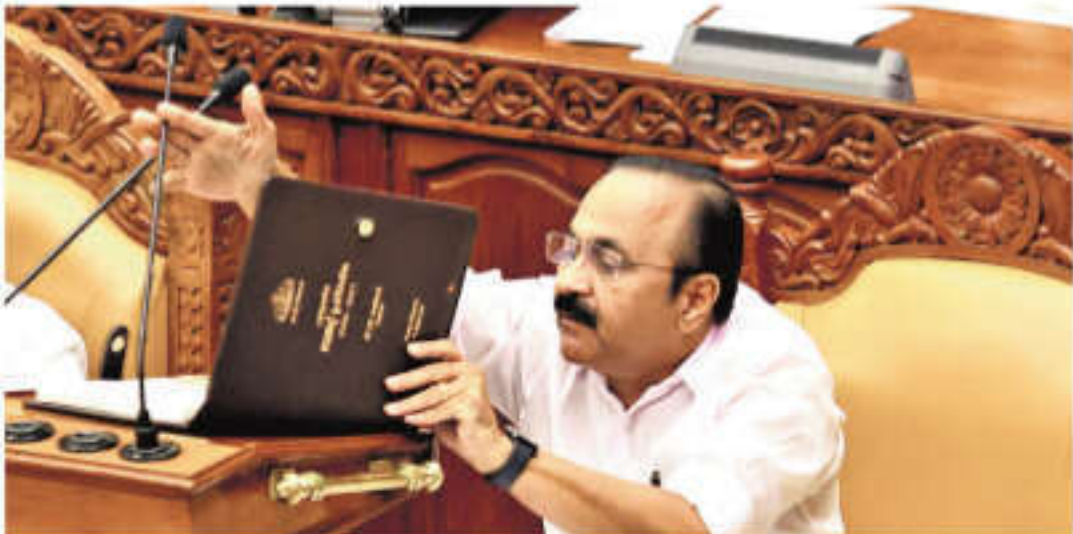


Satheesan's 1st budget bets big on pvt capital & reforms

CHIEF Minister V D Satheesan's maiden budget as finance minister was less an exercise in accounting and more a statement of intent. Framed around the vision of a "New Age Kerala" (Puthuyuga Keralam), the revised 2026-27 budget marked a decisive shift towards private investment, land reforms, and port-led development, while leaving unanswered questions on how several of its ambitious promises will be financed.

If previous governments often approached private capital with caution, Satheesan signalled a clear departure. "We need private capital. We want to move forward," he said after presenting the budget. That message runs through almost every major announcement—from Land Reforms 2.0 aimed at easing re-

strictions that hamper commercial investments to Mission Samudra, a five-year programme intended to place Kerala prominently on the global maritime map. The budget's economic geography is equally ambitious. The proposed Southern Kerala Economic Corridor seeks to

combine the strengths of Thiruvananthapuram, Kollam, and Alappuzha into a single growth zone. Thiruvananthapuram is envisioned as a knowledge and space technology hub, Kollam as a centre for rare earth and mineral processing, and Alappuzha as India's blue economy capital.

SC junks plea seeking probe into May 18 trust vote in TN

THE Supreme Court on Friday rejected a petition seeking a probe into alleged irregularities and corruption in the May 13 trust vote in the Tamil Nadu Assembly, after noting that the allegations lacked substance.

While dismissing the plea, a division bench comprising Chief Justice of India (CJI) Surya Kant and Justice V Mohana observed that the petition was based on "vague, wild and casual allegations" without any supporting material on record.

"Serious allegations against constitutional processes must rest on facts," the bench observed before rejecting the plea with no further directions.

The petition was filed by one K K Ramesh, who had moved the

court seeking a CBI probe into the matter and the imposition of President's Rule in the state till the completion of the investigation.

The plea claimed, "The Assembly floor test in Tamil Nadu was reportedly not carried out according to democratic principles. There are allegations that some thousand crores were distributed to other parties' MLAs."

The petitioner also claimed that in the TN Assembly, some MLAs from other parties were allegedly involved in horse-trading, and huge amounts of money were handed over to certain MLAs by the TVK. Some MLAs from other parties did not join the government, but violated the party whip for money and other benefits, he claimed. The plea sought an appropriate order or direction to respondents No 1 to 3 (the state government, CBI and others) in the matter.

K'taka's bid to build dam against CWDT & SC verdicts: Minister

DURING the discussion on the resolution on Friday, LOP Udhayanidhi Stalin said the previous DMK regime, on March 4, 2026, had written to the centre to set up a tribunal to adjudicate the dispute over the Mekedatu dam proposal and requested that this amendment be incorporated into the resolution moved by the CM. Agreeing to this, the CM moved an amendment to this regard, and the amended resolution was unanimously adopted by the House. The resolution stated that the Cauvery Water Disputes Tribunal (CWDT) and the SC have held that the Cauvery is a deficit basin and that its entire available water has already been apportioned among the basin states. Hence, no new project can

be undertaken nor can any additional water be utilised in the basin. As the Cauvery is a highly sensitive issue between TN and Karnataka, the centre should advise Karnataka not to construct a dam at Mekedatu or undertake any new water storage project anywhere in the Cauvery basin without the concurrence of the other basin states and the centre's approval, it added.

Moving the resolution, the CM said it was the duty of all political parties to safeguard the rights of farmers and the people. Though parties may differ in ideology and principles, they stand united on issues affecting the people, he said, adding that the TVK, as a conscientious government, was no different. Describing water resources as fundamental to life, he said pro-

tecting river water rights was both an important right and responsibility. On that basis, he sought the House's approval for the resolution and appealed to all parties to set aside differences and demonstrate unity on the issue.

Conveying full support to the resolution, Udhayanidhi detailed the steps taken by DMK regimes to stall Karnataka's repeated attempts for the dam. He suggested a delegation of MLAs and MPs of all parties could hand over the resolution to the centre to show the state's unity. Recalling the steps taken during AIADMK regimes to thwart Karnataka's efforts to build the Mekedatu dam, AIADMK general secretary Edappadi K Palaniswami explained how the proposal would be detrimental to the interests of TN farmers as well as

the people, and supported the resolution.

Tourism Minister S Rajesh Kumar (Congress) condemned Karnataka's attempts to build the dam, pointing out that the move was against the final verdict of the CWDT in 2007 and the SC verdict in 2018. DMKD MLA Premalatha Vijayakanth urged the state to achieve water self-sufficiency, just as it had become power-surplus, through measures such as inter-linking rivers and desilting water bodies to prevent wastage of water into the sea.

She called upon the CM to lead an all-party delegation to New Delhi to assert TN's rights. MJK MLA Thamimun Ansari recalled that former CM K Kamaraj had laid the foundation for a dam at Rasimanal at the border of TN and Karnataka

to benefit both states. The Mekedatu dam, however, would severely affect TN people, he said, adding that a section of farmers in Karnataka had also opposed the proposal. KMDK MLA K Nithyanandan said the Congress in Karnataka was backing the project, while its TN unit opposed it. Arguing that a legal battle was the only viable option, he urged the TVK govt not to show any lethargy in pursuing the case despite its alliance with Congress. Though present, BJP MLA M Bhojarajan (BJP) did not speak on the issue. Meanwhile, ex-minister Duraimurugan told reporters in Katpadi, "Competent lawyers should be engaged to argue the case strongly in the SC, and pressure should be exerted on the union government at the appropriate time."
