



Indian Naval ships reach Thai to boost maritime ties

INDIAN Naval Ships Udaygiri, Kavaratti and Shakti of the Eastern Fleet arrived at Sattahip, Thailand, as part of their operational deployment to the South East Asia region.

The ships, led by Rear Admiral Alok Ananda, Flag Officer Commanding Eastern Fleet, were received by the Royal Thai Navy. The port call is part of India's continued maritime engagement with South East Asian nations and shows the maritime partnership between India and Thailand. The visit

will include professional exchanges, cross-deck visits, operational interactions, sporting engagements and community outreach programmes to boost cooperation and interoperability between the two navies.

The port call is aimed at strengthening bilateral maritime ties, mutual cooperation and camaraderie between India and Thailand. It showcases the indigenous design, modular construction and state-of-the-art technology of Indian Naval ships, highlighting India's growing defence capabilities and its role as a reliable partner in defence technology.

SIT detains Nagaraju's aide, hunt on for 2 cops

Notices served at the houses of two absconding policemen

THE Special Investigation Team (SIT) probing the sensational custodial death of 24-year-old Gade Sai Krishna has intensified its investigation, taking into custody Suresh, a close associate of suspended Circle Inspector SSVV Nagaraju, while launching a manhunt for two absconding police personnel allegedly linked to it.

According to sources, Suresh was detained for questioning regarding his alleged role in the events that followed Sai Krishna's death in police custody.

Investigators suspect that he played a key part in assisting Nagaraju in the alleged disappearance and subsequent cremation of the victim's body. SIT officials are examining Suresh's involvement in the aftermath of the

custodial death, his relationship with Nagaraju, and allegations that he interfered in police affairs despite not being a police officer.

The investigation is also focusing on Suresh's interactions with Sai Krishna's family members after the incident. Officials are trying to determine whether he acted as an intermediary on behalf of the suspended inspector during the critical period following youth's death.

Meanwhile, special SIT teams have been dispatched to Hyderabad, Chennai and Bengaluru to trace and arrest absconding head constables Ashok and Jangam Nani.

The two policemen are suspected to have played a crucial role in the custodial torture of Sai Krishna and the subsequent efforts to dispose of evidence. Notices have already been served at their residences directing them to

appear before investigators, but both remain untraceable.

As part of the ongoing probe, SIT officials have also questioned senior police officers, including DCP Krishnakant Patel, Task Force Additional DCP K Latha Kumari and ACP Manasa. Investigators are examining the sequence of events leading to Sai Krishna's death and the alleged involvement of other individuals.

Separately, the NTR district police have initiated an investigation into the suicide of Kranthi Kumar, who had allegedly accused suspended inspector Nagaraju of harassment.

Kranthi Kumar died by suicide in the month of May after recording a selfie video detailing his allegations, and investigators are examining whether there is any connection between his claims and broader allegations against the suspended officer.



Acid beetle causes skin rashes to Kadiyam nursery workers

A growing number of nursery workers in Kadiyam, about 10 km from Rajahmundry, are reporting skin irritation caused by Paederus beetle, commonly known as the acid beetle or Nairobi fly, as plant transportation activities increase following intermittent rains.

Kadiyam, one of the largest nursery hubs with 3,000 nursery growers, provides livelihoods to 50,000 workers who come in contact with insects while handling plants. The condition, known as Paederus dermatitis, is not caused by a bite

or sting. The beetle releases a chemical called pederin when it is crushed on skin, causing redness, burning, itching and blister-like lesions that appear within 24-48 hours.

If the toxin comes in contact with the eyes, it can cause severe inflammation, known as "Nairobi eye".

East Godavari District Medical and Health Officer Dr N Vasundhara said "There is no need to panic. The condition is not life-threatening and mainly causes itching, burning sensation and skin rashes." Doctors advised workers to remove the beetle gently and wash skin.

Residents have been urged to stay away from snapped electrical wires and move to safe locations upon hearing thunder, particularly farmers, and cattle herders working in fields.

teams comprising ANMs, ASHA, Anganwadi workers and staff nurses will administer polio drops on Sunday.

Officials will mark houses with the letter 'P' after all eligible children have been vaccinated, while houses where any child is missed will be marked with an 'X' to facilitate follow-up visits.
