cer concerned to rush to the affected site for assessment and coordination of rescue operations.

“A team of SDRF has been deployed, while the National Disaster Response Force (NDRF) has been alerted and is moving towards the area to assist in relief and rescue efforts,” Sulu said.

An IAF helicopter dropped SDRF personnel and a rubber boat near Pitapool, and all available reserve personnel and vehicles in Yazali area have been mobilised, while ex-servicemen have also been called in to support emergency operations, he said.

The state Civil Aviation Department had requested the IAF to undertake rescue operations and airlift SDRF men and material from Itanagar to Keyi Panyor, Sulu said.

“The IAF air support team, despite difficult weather conditions, reached Hollongi and took off for Pitapool to drop the SDRF team and materials. Further air support exercises have been planned for succeeding requirements,” he said.

The North Eastern Electric Power Corporation (NEPCO) has begun releasing water from the reservoir of the Panyor Lower Hydropower Project as a precautionary measure, and power generation at the project has been temporarily suspended, the secretary said.

Heavy rainfall also disrupted road connectivity in the district, with three stretches of NH-13 near Potin and Hoj blocked by landslides, leaving several people stranded, he said.

ED RAIDS PREMISES OF DELHI BIZMAN IN 2021 MUNDRA DRUG BUST CASE

NEW DELHI: The Enforcement Directorate (ED) on Wednesday carried out raids in Delhi on businessman Harpreet Singh Talwar alias Kabir Talwar and others in connection with the 2021 drug bust at Mundra port in Gujarat, in which 2,988 kg of Afghan heroin worth ₹21,000 crore was intercepted by the Directorate of Revenue and Intelligence (DRI), people familiar with the development said.

The Mundra port drug bust of around 3,000 kg Afghan heroin worth ₹21,000 crore, intercepted in September 2021, was one of the biggest consignments ever which came to India via maritime route.

HT had first reported about this drug bust in 2021.

Even though a Prevention of Money Laundering Act or PMLA probe is on in the matter since 2021, ED launched fresh raids on Wednesday based on certain fresh inputs, according to officials.

Kabir Talwar was arrested by the National Investigation Agency (NIA) in August 2022 and later charge sheeted to take part in Pakistan-backed conspiracy to smuggle high-quality drugs into India. He was recently released on bail, said an officer.

Officials said on Wednesday that a total five premises were being searched in Delhi belonging to Talwar, one Shamshudeen and their associates.

“It is alleged that the money generated through the smuggling of drugs was invested in the night clubs in Delhi,” said the officer cited above.

The NIA had found in its probe in the Mundra drug bust that money generated through drugs which came to Mundra was meant for terrorists.

The NIA filed its first charge sheet in the Mundra case on March 14, 2022, against 16 cartel members, including Afghan nationals, Iranians and several Indians.

‘UP emerged revenue surplus state overcoming ‘Bimaru’ status’

BENGALURU: Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath on Wednesday asserted that his state has emerged as a revenue surplus state overcoming the ‘Bimaru’ (ailing) category in the last nine years.

Making a strong pitch for investment at the Industry Leaders’ Road Show here in Bengaluru, Adityanath said the state’s infrastructure makes Uttar Pradesh a favoured investment destination.

“The atmosphere of stability and safety provided by the double-engine government over the past nine years has enabled Uttar Pradesh to emerge from the Bimaru category,” the chief minister said.

“Double engine government” refers to the BJP-ruled government in the Centre and the state.

Over the past nine years, the BJP government in the state succeeded in tripling Uttar Pradesh’s economy and tripling per-capita income, Adityanath said.

“For the last six years, Uttar Pradesh has been a revenue-surplus state. Rising from the bottom three, Uttar Pradesh is now counted among India’s top three economies,” he claimed.

The CM said his state is moving forward strongly to invite investment partners into every sector.

With 36 sector-specific policies, Uttar Pradesh has not only created policy support for each sector but also developed a

comprehensive land bank of 75,000 acres, Adityanath said.

He added that along the expressways, the state has land available at 27 locations for developing industrial and logistics clusters. Further, a grand industrial city is being developed in the form of Bundelkhand Industrial Development Authority (BIDA).

He also emphasised the rich demographic dividend of 26 crore people.

The chief minister also harped upon the existing infrastructure, saying the state has completed the country’s largest expressway-the Ganga Expressway-which was dedicated to the nation by Prime Minister Narendra Modi on April 29.

Adityanath said Uttar Pradesh has become a model of India’s 3S-Safety, Stability and Speed, which are the three important dimensions for industry.

Uttar Pradesh has established itself as a state with a strong rule of law, he said, adding that investors will find world-class infrastructure and connectivity in the state along with an excellent network of transparent governance institutions.

“Skill, talent, technology and investment-friendly policies-this complete industrial ecosystem is available today in the new India and the new Uttar Pradesh,” the CM said.

Recalling the past, he said

nine years ago, Uttar Pradesh did not have a positive perception.

“The state was plagued by a deteriorating law-and-order situation and policy paralysis where governance was virtually absent. Development was rarely discussed. It was known as one of the backward Bimaru states of northern India. Decline had become its destiny. Its fundamental pillars-agriculture and MSMEs-had been neglected,” he noted.

Everything that represents India’s strengths can be found in Uttar Pradesh now, the chief minister claimed.

Noting that the state has an excellent law-and-order situation, Adityanath said it has world-class infrastructure, outstanding road, rail and air connectivity, India’s first operational National Inland Waterway from Varanasi to Haldia and the first Rapid Rail service between Delhi and Meerut.

Adityanath said there are five international airports and 11 domestic airports, two IITs, one IIM in Lucknow, five agriculture universities, 89 Krishi Vigyan Kendras (KVKs) and three technical universities.

He said the agricultural growth, which was once 8 per cent, has now reached 18 per cent.

According to him, nine years ago, the state had around 14,000 large factories and industries, which has now grown to more than 33,000. PTI

Kashmiri pandits need spl care and support: PDP chief

SRINAGAR: In a significant appeal aimed at reconciliation and improved welfare, Peoples Democratic Party (PDP) Chief Mehbooba Mufti on Wednesday urged a shift in the discourse surrounding the rehabilitation of Kashmiri Pandits.

Speaking in Anantnag, the former Chief Minister stressed that the onus for reintegrating the community lies as much with the local populace as it does with the state.

Mufti pleaded for social healing, pushing back against the tendency to dwell on past grievances. "People living here have a greater role to play than the government," she stated. "We must look ahead, not remain stuck in the past." She pointed to the lived realities of Kashmiri Pandits who migrated back under the government's 'PM Package' for employment, highlighting that many are struggling with inadequate living conditions.

"Many Kashmiri Pandits who returned under the PM package live in poor housing, with water and electricity problems," Mufti noted. "They need special support and care."

Mufti proposed a more comprehensive approach to rehabilitation that integrates physical and cultural support. She proposed investing in more robust housing and infrastructure to ensure that returnees have a dignified standard of living and acknowledged the importance of heritage. She called for the construction of "larger facilities and temples," framing these as essential to the identity and comfort of the returning community.

Earlier, the Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh High Court at Srinagar issued notice to the respondents in a writ petition filed by The Displaced Kashmiri Residents Housing Cooperative Ltd., seeking implementation of long-pending rehabilitation commitments made for displaced Kashmiri Pandits. ANI



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
