SHARES of SpaceX soared 23 per cent in their Wall Street debut on Friday, making the rocket maker's CEO Elon Musk the first-ever trillionaire. The shares opened at \$150 and kept rising, reaching \$166.90 around 12:20 pm ET (9.50 pm IST). That price gave the company a market value of \$2.18 trillion. Forbes is now estimating Musk's net worth at \$1.1 trillion.

Institutional and retail investors jumped at the opportunity to buy 555.6 million shares of SpaceX at the offering price of \$135 apiece. The \$75 billion in proceeds easily topped the previous record IPO from oil giant Saudi Aramco in 2019. Musk says SpaceX is going public now because it needs money to fund its ambitions of putting satellites and data centres in space and eventually establishing a colony of people on Mars. Musk earlier marked

the opening of trading on Nasdaq, where the company is trading under the symbol "SPCX," by joining a ceremonial bell ringing from Starbase, the South Texas home of SpaceX. He reiterated his lofty goals "to make life multi-planetary." "Not just a few astronauts, I mean literally you," Musk said.

"Whoever you are watching this, SpaceX wants to be able to take you to the moon,

take you to Mars and ultimately beyond."

Known for his technology breakthroughs, as well as wild claims and missed deadlines, Musk was widely expected to break the trillion dollar mark despite SpaceX generating losses as big as its ambitions. In addition to establishing a one-million person Martian colony, the company has promised to save humanity by establish-

ing other outposts in space, launch data centers the size of football fields into orbit and outdo rivals Anthropic and OpenAI in the race to make money from artificial intelligence. To reach its goals, SpaceX needs billions more than it currently takes in from its rocket and satellite business. Between the start of 2025 and March 31, 2026, the company lost \$8.7 billion. **Continued on Page 7**

Centre caps diesel sales at petrol pumps

NEW DELHI: The government has capped diesel sales to a vehicle in a day at 200 litres and restricted industrial, commercial, and institutional users from buying petrol and diesel from petrol pumps in a bid to prevent local shortages amid global supply disruption, according to an official order. Retail outlets can sell diesel only into a vehicle tank or PESO-approved container, and not more than 200 litres per customer or vehicle per day. Also, industrial, commercial and institutional consumers will no longer be allowed to buy petrol or diesel from retail outlets.

PARTIES WORKED UP OVER MOVE TO RECAST 4 LOK SABHA SEATS

THE contemplated move to restructure the Hyderabad, Malkajgiri, Secunderabad, and the Medak Lok Sabha segments as part of the delimitation exercise, has set the cat among pigeons for political parties because of its potential impact on vote banks nurtured by them over the years.

For context, a recent working paper prepared by the Economic Advisory Council to the Prime

Minister (proposes a "targeted delimitation" model to redraw Lok Sabha boundaries and expand the strength of the lower house in Parliament from 543

to 824 seats. Towards this end, the EAC proposes dividing 170 large, highly populated constituencies, specifically recommending a three-way split for both the

Hyderabad and Secunderabad Lok Sabha segments. Under the plan, while Hyderabad and Secunderabad are marked for targeted three-way division to reduce size and boost declining voter participation among urban residents; the huge Malkajgiri constituency could lose its present status as India's largest parliamentary segment as several new Lok Sabha seats could be carved out within the expanded metropolitan region.

Stock investors' wealth surges by Rs 9.41L cr

Stock investors became richer by Rs 9.66 lakh crore on Friday following a strong rally in shares fuelled by a global surge and a sharp correction in crude oil prices. The 30-share BSE

Sensex jumped 1,695.40 points, or 2.30 per cent, to settle at 75,527.95. During the day, it surged 1,775.47 points, or 2.40 per cent, to 75,608.02. The 50-share NSE Nifty ended sharply higher by 461.30 points, or 1.99 per cent, at 23,622.90.

Jolt to Cong as SC junks Natarajan's RS poll plea

Apex court grants her liberty to raise the challenge in a poll petition

NEW DELHI: The Supreme Court on Friday dismissed Congress leader Meenakshi Natarajan's plea against rejection of her nomination papers for the Rajya Sabha election from Madhya Pradesh while granting her liberty to raise the challenge in an election petition. A bench comprising justices Prashant Kumar Mishra and Atul S Chandurkar rejected the argument by senior advocate Abhishek Singhvi, appearing for Natarajan, that Article 32 can be invoked to cure "glaring and manifest" errors in the rejection of her nomination. The top court said whenever an attempt has been made to invoke the jurisdiction of this court under Article 32, or that of the High Courts under Article 226, during the process of elections, it has repeatedly declined interference due to the constitutional mandate contained in Article 329(b) of the Constitution.



It's 'seat chori', maintains Cong leader

NEW DELHI: With the Supreme Court dismissing her plea challenging the rejection of her nomination papers for the Rajya Sabha polls, Congress leader Meenakshi Natarajan on Friday said it is very apparent to everyone that "seat chori" is not a question about "personal defeat" but more worrisome are the "shocks that democracy is repeatedly receiving".

'40 fake FIFA WC 2026 ticket sites linked to fraud network'

The report by cybersecurity firm CloudSEK said the operation goes beyond traditional phishing scams and uses cloned FIFA ticketing platforms

NEW DELHI

AT least 40 fake FIFA World Cup 2026 ticketing websites linked to a fraud network involving 15 active cybercriminal operators have been identified, according to a report released on Friday.

The report by cybersecurity firm CloudSEK said the operation goes beyond traditional phishing scams and uses cloned FIFA ticketing platforms, real-time card skimming and potential OTP interception capabilities to steal payment information

from unsuspecting users.

The fraudulent websites closely mimic legitimate FIFA ticketing portals, featuring official-looking branding, match schedules, stadium information, shopping carts, payment gateways and secure checkout messages designed to gain users' trust, it said.

The campaign functions as a real-time man-in-the-middle phishing framework capable of tracking a victim's checkout process, capturing card details including card numbers, expiry dates and CVV information, and potentially



relaying one-time passwords (OTPs) to bypass SMS-based authentication. In addition, the investigation identified a broader fraud ecosystem that



includes a rogue payment processing network and a multi-tenant infrastructure supporting multiple operators. The backend infrastructure is hosted through a Chinese-language administrative panel and supports at least 15 separate operator instances, suggesting a scalable cyber-

crime operation rather than isolated phishing websites. "This campaign shows how major global events are being weaponised by organised cybercriminal groups. The threat is no longer limited to fake ticket listings or basic phishing pages. We are now seeing full checkout impersonation, live victim tracking, card skimming and OTP interception capabilities being combined into one operational platform," said Gagan Aggarwal, Threat Intelligence Researcher at CloudSEK TRIAD.

Mallu calls for proactive steps to maximise tax revenue

Sub-Committee deliberates on asset monetisation, excise performance and fiscal targets

DEPUTY Chief Minister and Finance Minister Mallu Bhatti Vikramarka directed all government departments to work with seamless coordination and achieve targeted goals to strengthen the state's financial stability and augment revenue resources.

At a high-level meeting of the Cabinet Sub-Committee on resource mobilisation, the deputy CM emphasised the need to strengthen the enforcement and intelligence wings of the Commercial Taxes Department to maximise tax revenue.

He instructed officials to take proactive steps to ensure Telangana secures a dedicated representation in the national-level GST Fitment Committee, which plays a vital role in key economic decisions. He noted that this representation would effectively safeguard the state's financial interests.

The Sub-Committee extensively deliberated on a comprehensive plan prepared by officials for efficient asset monetisation and accelerating land pooling processes under the Hyderabad Metropolitan Development



Authority (HMDA) limits.

Highlighting the progress, Special Chief Secretary Jayesh Ranjan informed the committee that following the success of the Uppal Bhagayat project, land pooling initiatives in Mokila and Budwel have yielded excellent results.

He added that three new prospective projects are currently under evaluation. The Ministers instructed officials to identify more potential sites for land pooling within the city limits, maintaining the same trans-

parency adopted in the Uppal Bhagayat model.

Expediting the HILT Project

The Cabinet Sub-Committee placed special emphasis on fast-tracking the Hyderabad Infrastructure and Land Transformation (HILT) project.

Furthermore, the Deputy CM reviewed the performance of the Excise Department, a major revenue contributor, and ordered the immediate formulation of a foolproof action plan to meet fiscal targets timely.
