SPACE Exploration Technologies Corp. (SpaceX) officially began trading on the Nasdaq on Friday after completing a record-breaking \$75-billion initial public offering (IPO), marking a historic moment for global capital markets and making founder Elon Musk the world's first US dollar trillionaire (Rs 95.06 lakh crore). SpaceX shares opened trading at \$150, 11 per cent above



the IPO price of \$135. The start of trading was marked by SpaceX

executives ringing the opening bell at the Nasdaq stock exchange, while celebrations were also held at the company's headquarters, where Musk and employees watched the landmark event unfold.

The Elon Musk-led aerospace and satellite company priced its shares at \$135 apiece, valuing SpaceX at approximately \$1.77 trillion in what is being described as the largest IPO in history. The company is trading under the ticker symbol 'SPXC'.

NDA leaders. Naidu said the people had given a historic mandate to the NDA alliance in 2024 with a 57 per cent vote share and 164 Assembly seats. He said the alliance treated the victory not as a political achievement

but as a responsibility entrusted by the people for the reconstruction of Andhra Pradesh.

"We neither became complacent after the victory nor got discouraged by the condition of the state. We chose to serve the people as public servants, not as rulers," Naidu said. The Chief Minister alleged that the previous government had left the state burdened with debts and weakened institutions. He said the NDA government released seven white papers after assuming office to place facts before the public and took steps to restore governance, law and order, and investor confidence.

FORMER minister and YSRCP leader Ambati Rambabu alleged that the

coalition government in the state had failed to fulfil several key promises made to the people despite completing two years in office. He along with the YSRCP leaders and activists participated in the 'Vennupotuku Rendellu' programme conducted here on Friday and protested at GMC guest house centre. Speaking on this occasion, he said that the coalition came to power by making numerous assurances under the Super Six programme, but many of those promises remain unimplemented. He alleged that the government had failed to provide the promised Stree Nidhi benefit and had abandoned some of its major election commitments. He further claimed that the unemployment allowance promised to youth had not been implemented and that the assurances made during the Yuvagalam campaign had not been honoured. According to him, the coalition government had also failed to deliver on its promise of providing pensions to SC, ST and minority women above 50 years of age.

He accused the government of misleading the people and said public dissatisfaction was increasing across the State. He described the coalition as a government that had failed to meet the expectations of the electorate and alleged that people were questioning its performance after two years in power.

The YSRCP leader also launched a personal attack on the coalition leadership, alleging that they had deceived the public with promises that were not fulfilled. He announced that he would undertake a "Vinati Padayatra" on July 29 to highlight public concerns and draw attention to what he termed the coalition government's unfulfilled promises and governance failures.

Vishnu criticised the government's alleged move to privatise municipal assets and government medical colleges, stating that public institutions built with taxpayers' money should remain under public control. He also alleged rising corruption, increasing fuel prices, deteriorating law and order, and poor civic infrastructure in Vijayawada. Vishnu demanded an immediate inquiry into the DSC recruitment process and warned that the YSRCP would continue its agitation until justice is delivered to unemployed youth and election promises are fulfilled. Several YSRCP leaders and party workers participated in the protest.
