Fresh jolt to UBT as MLC Ahir joins Shinde camp

Files Nomination For Council Dy Chairperson Post

Mumbai: In a fresh and major setback for Sena UBT, its MLC Sachin Ahir Tuesday filed his nomination for election to the post of deputy chairperson of the legislative council from deputy CM Eknath Shinde's Sena, effectively switching over to the Shinde-led party. A former MLA from Aadiya Thackeray's Worli assembly constituency, Ahir was considered close to Aadiya.

Ahir was earlier an NCP MLA from Worli and had joined the undivided Shiv Sena before the 2019 assembly polls. Sena UBT MLC JM Abhyankar filed his nomination as MVA nominee for the council deputy chairperson's post. The poll will be held Wednesday, but the Mahayuti is expected to win easily with its numbers.

With Ahir leaving, Sena UBT is left with just five MLCs in the council. Legislature officials said the nomination for the deputy chairperson's post is not filed through any political party, so it would not attract the anti-defection law. Officials also said Ahir was elected as MLC of the undivided Shiv Sena in 2022, so he could not be disqualified now.

Shinde said last week six Sena UBT MPs had come to Sena "and hit sixes, and now Sachin Ahir has hit sixes".

Aadiya said, "We have been seeing this for four years... There is nothing new in this and it does not shock us at all. Worli-Sewri was and will remain Sena UBT's stronghold. Our work there speaks for itself. Therefore, no matter who joins or leaves the party, our stronghold will not be shaken."

"The only unfortunate thing is that those to whom we gave so much, what more do they want? He cannot even say Aadiya Thackeray did not meet him. He himself is an MLC, his daughter was given the post of ward committee member. He was also given the post of deputy leader in Sena UBT. So what more do you want? Should we now perform your 'aarti' every day? Sena UBT does not care if someone leaves," he added.

Shinde said, "This (Ahir's) nomination has been filed by Mahayuti which is in a majority. Therefore, he will be elected as deputy chairperson. He will work to provide justice not only in Mumbai but also in Maharashtra in this role. With his arrival, Sena's strength has also increased. Sena is a party of workers. There is no doubt that Ahir will do a great job."

Ahir said he would respond at the right time and from the right platform to the barbs hurled at him from Sena UBT. Sena UBT MLC Ambadas Danve claimed Ahir sent him a message Tuesday morning just before switching over: "I have taken this decision for my political survival. I have no background in politics and my work is my only proof," stated Ahir's text, Danve claimed.

SC seeks Raj govt reply on Asaram's medical bail plea

New Delhi: Supreme Court Tuesday issued notice to Rajasthan govt on a bail plea of self-proclaimed godman Asaram on medical grounds even as it directed that the treatment provided to him would continue. Asaram had approached the apex court against a high court order upholding his conviction and life sentence for raping two minor girls.

As advocate Shradha Deshmukh, appearing for victims' families, strongly opposed any interim relief to him, a bench of Justices MM Sundresh and Shree Narayan assured her that the order would be passed only after hearing all the sides and asked the petitioner to make them party to the case.

Senior advocate Dama Seshadri Naidu, appearing for Asaram, contended that his client, who is around 90 years old, was suffering from multiple diseases

The bench assured the advocate appearing for victims' families that the order would be passed only after hearing all the sides and asked the petitioner to make them party to the case

es and pleaded for relief. He said the petitioner was a victim of a "social media trial" which had led to his conviction while the other accused were acquitted.

The bench, however, said it would consider a plea for bail only if it is necessary on medical grounds and allowed him to approach the court in case of any medical emergency.

In April 2018, a special Pocco court at Jodhpur had sentenced Asaram to imprisonment for the remainder of his natural life. The HC upheld his conviction for IPC offences (except gang rape and criminal conspiracy charges) but acquitted the co-accused.

Ayushman covers acid survivor, treat 4-year-old: HC to pvt hosp

Indore: The Madhya Pradesh HC has directed a private hospital here to immediately admit a four-year-old acid attack survivor for specialised treatment after finding out that the burn ward of a govt hospital where she was earlier asked to be shifted was poorly maintained with fungus on the walls and rodent infestation.

Justice Deepak Khot issued the directions on June 24 on a writ petition filed under Article 226.

According to the family, also the petitioner, the child was subjected to an acid attack on May 29, along with her brother and mother, all of whom suffered serious burn injuries. They were undergoing treatment at the community health centre, Rajpur in Barwani district, but were discharged on June 18, citing inadequate treatment facilities.

The court noted it had earlier directed the petitioner's admission to the Super Speciality Hospital, Indore, by June 23, and sought a state report on alternative treatment at Aurobindo Hospital. While the state's report fa-

voured the govt facility, the petitioner's counsel objected, producing photographs showing unhygienic conditions in the burn ward, including fungal growth and rats, which the court examined and showed to state counsel.

The report confirmed that the girl and her six-year-old brother required specialised treatment and warned that inadequate care could result in sepsis or septic shock.

The court referred to the Supreme Court's directions which mandate that private hospitals don't refuse treatment to acid attack victims, provide first aid before referral, and ensure full treatment including medicines, food, bedding, and reconstructive surgery. The top court had ruled that compensation matters were to be handled by District Legal Service Authority functioning as a criminal injury compensation board.

Noting the petitioners held an Ayushman Card for cashless treatment up to Rs 5 lakh and that they had sought admission to Bombay Hospital, Apollo Hospital or CHL Hospital, Indore, the court held they were entitled to treatment at a private hospital of their choice.

11-year-old killed, 4 hurt as tree falls on school bus in Mumbai

Mumbai: An 11-year-old student was killed and four others were injured after a roadside peepal tree fell on a school bus carrying 12 children in the Chembur area of Mumbai Tuesday afternoon, officials said.

The incident occurred at 2:58pm on Road No. 11, they said. Fire brigades rushed to the spot and evacuated all 12 students, including the two who were trapped in the school bus.

Of them, five injured students were taken to the nearby hospital for treatment, a civic official said.

According to the hospital's medical officer, four of the injured students were in stable condition, while 11-year-old Vihan Srivastava, who had sustained serious injuries, was declared dead around 4:30pm.

The bus was ferrying students of Universal High School, officials said. School Bus Owners' Association

(SBOA), a body of school bus owners, claimed 11 students were injured.

"This incident cannot simply be brushed aside as an unfortunate act of nature. It raises serious questions about civic preparedness, preventive maintenance, and the accountability of the authorities responsible for public safety," said Anil Garg, president of SBOA. PTI
