

TG to tap non-BJP ruled States on GRAM G

Civil society groups urge gov't to frame a separate job scheme for State; new framework could cost TG ₹2,500 cr

EVEN as civil society organisations urged the Telangana government to enact its own employment guarantee law instead of adopting the Union government's proposed framework, the Cabinet sub-committee set up by the State to examine the Centre's VB GRAM G Act has decided to reach out to non-BJP-ruled States to explore co-ordinated legal and political action.

The State Cabinet is expected to take a final decision on July 2 on whether Telangana should

adopt the Union government's framework, enact its own legislation, move the Supreme Court, or pursue a combination of legal and administrative measures.

The sub-committee, headed by Irrigation and Civil Supplies Minister N Uttam Kumar Reddy, proposed consultations with the chief ministers of Karnataka and Kerala to assess whether the two States would be willing to pursue a common legal strategy or other coordinated measures to protect the powers and financial interests



of States. The meeting was attended in person by Rural Development and Panchayati Raj Minister Danasari Anasuya (Seethakka), while Agriculture Minister Thummala Nag- eswara Rao and Labour Minister G Vivek Venkataswamy participated virtually.

During the meeting, members of the sub-committee maintained that the proposed law infringes upon the constitutional powers of States and contains several provisions that may not withstand judicial scrutiny. Legal experts informed the

panel that they had identified multiple constitutional issues that could form the basis of a challenge before the Supreme Court. The committee also discussed whether Telangana should challenge the legislation in the Supreme Court instead of implementing it in line with the Union government's guidelines.

Representatives of nearly 20 civil society organisations who attended the meeting criticised the Union government for introducing sweeping changes without consulting State governments. They described the move as a violation of coopera-

tive federalism, saying employment guarantee programmes directly affect State finances, rural livelihoods and local implementation.

The organisations urged the State government to enact its own employment guarantee law under the Constitution instead of adopting the proposed Centre's framework, which they estimated could cost the state exchequer nearly ₹2,500 crore.

They also warned that the proposed changes could reduce employment opportunities for thousands of agricultural labourers.

IN a ghastly incident, a man allegedly blew up an explosive even as he was sitting inside a rented car on Bengaluru-Pune NH-48 at Jogihalli village in Sira taluk near Tumakuru on Saturday afternoon. While he was charred to death, his estranged girlfriend, who he had stabbed, and the driver of the car managed to escape.

The deceased, Nagendra (30), who was a shopkeeper, had allegedly kidnapped his girlfriend of seven years, Ramya Ullas, from Bengaluru and was taking her to their village Agasuru in Ankola when the strange drama unfolded.

Nagendra was said to have arrived in Bengaluru over a week ago and was pestering Ramya to marry him. Ramya works as a technician at Sanjay Gandhi Hospital at Jayanagar in Bengaluru.

After abducting Ramya from her paying guest accommodation in Bengaluru, he started arguing with her in the car. As their tiff escalated, Nagendra



pulled out a knife and stabbed her. A terrified Ramyascreamed and jumped out of the moving car. The driver, who was petrified seeing the horrific scene on the backseat, braked the car to a halt and escaped.

Nagendra, who was inside the car, put on the central locking system and blew up the explosive he had carried. He was charred to death and the car was completely gutted by the time a fire extinguisher arrived at the spot.

Nagendra seemed prepared for the extreme action as he had carried the explosive as well as the knife, police sources said.

"We are yet to ascertain whether he used a petrol bomb or country made bomb for the explosion," said Superintendent of Police Ashok KV.

Trump thanks India for naming Hyd road after him

US President Donald Trump has thanked India after a road in Hyderabad was named after him. On Saturday, Trump shared a post on the social media platform Truth Social featuring photographs from the inauguration of Donald Trump Avenue in Hyderabad's Financial District.

The photographs show Deputy Chief Minister Mallu Bhatti Vikramarka and US Ambassador to India Sergio Gorravega unveiling the ceremonial plaque.

Sharing the photographs, Trump wrote: "The new Donald Trump Avenue in Hyderabad, India — The first US President to ever be honoured in this way. Thank You!"

Chief Minister A Revanth Reddy had earlier announced that key roads in Hyderabad would be named after globally recognised companies and prominent personalities.

The Telangana government named the road as Donald Trump Avenue. Deputy Chief Minister Mallu Bhatti Vikramarka officially unveiled the plaque on June 24 as part of the celebrations marking the 250th anniversary of American Independence. Earlier, the state government named a radial road connecting to the proposed Regional Ring Road (RRR) after Ratan Tata.

Stalker hurls petrol into woman's room, sets her ablaze

IN a horrific incident, a youth allegedly set a 27-year-old woman ablaze while she was asleep in her house at Jaratoli hamlet under Santoshpur village, around 25 km from Rourkela, late on Friday night.

The victim is battling for life with more than 60 per cent burn injuries at JP Hospital in Rourkela. Hours after the crime, police on Saturday evening arrested the accused, identified as Rajat Kiro, a tribal youth, from the Sonaparvat area of Lathikata block.

Kiro belongs to the Kinjirkela police station area in Sundargarh district. He was stalking the victim for months, police said.

Preliminary investigation revealed that the window of the room in which the woman was sleeping had been left open.

Veteran actor and filmmaker Bhagyaraj passes away at 73

VETERAN actor-filmmaker K Bhagyaraj, known for being one of Indian cinema's master scenarists, passed away in Chennai on Saturday due to cardiac arrest.

He complained of chest pain after returning home from a morning walk and was rushed to a private hospital. Efforts to resuscitate him proved futile. He was 73.

Bhagyaraj, who ventured into

cinema to become an actor, started off as an assistant director to the filmmaker Bharathiraja in his directorial debut, 16 Vayathinile (1977). Bhagyaraj was easily the most illustrious filmmaker to come out of the Bharathiraja school of films. After casting Bhagyaraj in small roles in 16 Vayathinile and Kizhakke Pogum Rayil (1978), Bharathiraja launched him as a leading hero in Puthiya Vaarpugal (1979).
