Seven killed in twin blasts in Pakistan

PESHAWAR: At least seven people were killed and three others injured on Saturday in twin roadside blasts in Pakistan's restive Khyber Pakhtunkhwa province, police said.

No group has claimed responsibility for it yet.

The explosions occurred in Marka Bera area of the Bannu district.

According to Bannu District Police Officer (DPO) Yasir Afridi, the first explosion occurred when an improvised explosive device (IED) planted along a roadside detonated, striking a passenger van and killing five people on the spot.

He said a second blast occurred shortly afterwards at the same location, targeting people involved in rescue efforts.

Two people were killed in the second explosion, while a vehicle was also damaged.

Those injured and the bodies

of the deceased were shifted to a nearby hospital, and an investigation into the incident has been launched, the DPO added.

Officials said the passenger van was travelling from Hathi Khel village to Bannu city when it was hit by the explosion.

Security forces and law enforcement agencies have cordoned off the area and begun collecting evidence from the blast site.

Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Chief Minister Sohail Afridi strongly condemned the incident and directed police authorities to submit a detailed report on it. He also ordered a thorough investigation into the circumstances surrounding the blasts.

Calling it "highly tragic" and "heartbreaking", he extended sympathies to the bereaved families, assuring them that the provincial government would provide all possible support during this difficult time.

He also instructed authorities to ensure medical treatment to injured.

INDIAN JAILED FOR FIVE YEARS IN UK-FRANCE PEOPLE SMUGGLING CASE

LONDON: An Indian man who admitted smuggling migrants from the UK to France in the back of trucks has been jailed for more than five years by a court in south-east England.

Jaskirat Singh, 25, was prosecuted by the UK's Crown Prosecution Service (CPS) over his role in facilitating the illegal movement of non-British nationals between December 2024 and March 2026.

Earlier this month, he pleaded guilty to conspiracy to facilitate illegal immigration.

Singh, who was sentenced by the Canterbury Crown Court on Thursday, is believed to have earned around 185,000 pounds through the illegal operations.

"The plot was exposed when 11 Indian nationals were found hiding in the trailer of a lorry stopped at Dover in December 2024.

Four other Indians were found in a separate lorry travelling to France in January 2025," the CPS said.

US eyes working with Qatar to free up Iranian funds

WASHINGTON: The United States is eyeing working with Qatar so as to chart a plan for releasing billions of dollars in frozen funds aimed at humanitarian spending in Iran, the Wall Street Journal (WSJ) reported on Friday, citing people familiar with the matter.

According to the American news outlet, yet another early financial incentive comes as a part of the recently inked peace pact between Tehran and Washington, according to people familiar with the matter.

While the plan is not complete yet, the Wall Street Journal reported that it is aimed at giving Iran access to spend and utilise some of its estimated USD 100 billion in cash frozen worldwide--with the first access being to the USD 6 billion held in Qatar.

Under the deal, it was informed that Qatar would purchase humanitarian goods such as food and medicines ordered by Iran's central bank by utilising the money drawn from Tehran's frozen assets that includes cash from oil sales that have been locked up overseas by sanctions.

This comes as Qatar has reiterated its support for launching negotiations between the United States and Iran to address outstanding issues through dialogue and peaceful means as the first round of technical talks, scheduled to take place in Switzerland, got cancelled following the signing of the memorandum of understanding (MoU) between the two sides in order to end the

hostilities in West Asia.

According to a statement issued by Qatar's Ministry of Foreign Affairs, this came during the discussion between Prime Minister and Minister of Foreign Affairs Sheikh Mohammed bin Abdulrahman bin Jassem Al Thani and Swiss Foreign Minister Ignazio Cassis that took place at Burgenstock Resort in Switzerland on Friday.

On Thursday, the Swiss Foreign Ministry confirmed that the planned talks between the US and Iran have been postponed.

Responding to an email from ANI, the Swiss Foreign Ministry said it remains ready to facilitate the talks.

"The planned talks between the US, Iran, Qatar and Pakistan have been postponed. Switzerland remains ready to facilitate these talks. The relevant preparatory work at Burgenstock is continuing. No fur-

ther information can be provided at present," it said.

The 14-point MoU between the US and Iran includes an immediate and permanent cessation of military operations, including in Lebanon, and a pledge to conclude negotiations on a final deal within 60 days, extendable by mutual consent.

Under the memorandum, the US will begin removing its naval blockade and related restrictions, while Iran will facilitate the safe passage of commercial vessels through the Strait of Hormuz free of charge for an initial 60-day period, during which technical talks will also take place on Iran's nuclear programme.

The document also outlines plans for the phased lifting of sanctions, the release of frozen Iranian assets, US Treasury waivers for Iranian oil exports, and a US-backed reconstruction and economic development programme for Iran.

Ukrainian officials return Polish awards after Nazi row

KYIV: Top Ukrainian officials said on Saturday they were returning Polish awards after President Volodymyr Zelensky was stripped of Warsaw's top order, in a row between the allies over WW 2 massacres. Zelensky infuriated Poland by naming a military unit after the nationalist UPA that took part in massacres against Poles in WW 2. On Friday, Poland stripped Zelensky of its highest honour. On Saturday, Zelensky's top aide, Ukraine's ambassador to Warsaw and the foreign minister said they were relinquishing awards bestowed by Poland.

Court bans Spanish PM's wife from leaving country

MADRID: A Spanish court has ordered the wife of Prime Minister Pedro Sanchez, Begona Gomez, to stand trial by jury for corruption and banned her from leaving the country, according to a court order released Saturday. The case is one of several corruption affairs that have embroiled the Socialist leader's family and former allies, threatening to topple his minority coalition government. Judge Juan Carlos Peinado ordered Gomez to hand in her passport and to appear before the court twice a month until a verdict is reached in the case. No date for the trial has been set.
