

MLA Techi Kaso unveils conference-cum-dining facility at car parking lot in Itanagar

ITANAGAR, Jul 01: Itanagar MLA Techi Kaso on Wednesday inaugurated an Itanagar 360 Conference-cum-Dining facility on the rooftop of the multi-level car parking facility located at ESS Sector in the city.

During the inauguration ceremony, Kaso was accompanied by Itanagar Capital Complex Deputy Commissioner Toko Babu and several Heads of Departments of the Capital Complex, including officials from the Urban Development, Power, PWD, and PHED departments.

The facility has been leased out to a private party, Bamang Taniang Kiogi under the name to run the facility on its 1st day activity. Both the dignitaries congratulated Kiogi.

While speaking on the occasion, MLA Techi Kaso said the initiative is expected to



help address parking issues in the area, which is one of the most important and prime locations in the entire Itanagar Capital Complex.

He inform that several important offices and institutions are located nearby, including the Directorates of Education, Higher Education, Technical Education, and Elementary Education, as well as Mallo Tarin Government Higher Secondary School, Arunachal Pradesh Public Service Commission (APPSC), Anti-Corruption

Bureau, Arunachal Pradesh Legislative Assembly, and Arunachal Pradesh Civil Secretariat.

This parking lot is one of the extended parking facilities in the area to cater to parking facility for the officers and public visiting various officers.

The people, who come to State capital to meet the officers, now can have their lunch and dinner and fulfill the requirements of the conference hall for meeting, party and other official pur-

poses. He congratulated the team members of Itanagar 360 Conference-cum-Dining and asked them to maintain the infrastructure and keep it clean and hygienic.

As parking space is limited for officials, government vehicles, and visitors to the Civil Secretariat, State Public Service Commission, Higher Education campus, and Assembly premises, a parking pass system will be introduced. Those wishing to park their vehicles will be issued parking passes and

will be required to pay reasonable charges as per government-approved rates, said MLA Techi Kaso.

The facility also includes a convention hall with adequate space to accommodate around 200 to 300 people. Visitors attending events at the venue will be able to park their vehicles in the same parking complex, which has the capacity to accommodate more than 100 cars.

The Deputy Commissioner of the Capital Complex also addressed the gathering and congratulated the management team during the inaugural ceremony.
