

Assam Budget to Outline Five-Year Development Vision, Says Sarma

GUWAHATI

Assam Chief Minister Himanta Biswa Sarma on Monday said the state Budget, scheduled to be presented later this week, will serve as a comprehensive economic roadmap for the next five years. He stated that the Budget would be centred on fulfilling the commitments made in the election manifesto of the BJP-led alliance while laying out a long-term vision for the state's development.

The Budget session of the Assam Legislative Assembly commenced on Monday, marking the first financial session after the BJP-led alliance returned to power for a third consecutive term in the state. The government views the upcoming Budget as a significant policy document that will define its development priorities for the next term.

Speaking to reporters, Sarma said the Budget, which will be presented by Finance Minister Jayanta Mallabrahua on July 10, would go beyond routine annual financial allocations. Instead, it would outline a broader strategy aimed at accelerating Assam's economic growth over the next five years.

According to the Chief Minister, the government has designed the Budget around the promises made to the people during the Assembly elections. He said it would provide a clear direction

for the state's future while focusing on sustainable development, investment promotion and inclusive economic progress.

Sarma identified agriculture, industrial expansion, micro, small and medium enterprises, self-help groups, employment generation and renewable energy as the government's priority sectors. He noted that these areas would receive significant policy attention as the administration seeks to strengthen Assam's economy and generate new opportunities for citizens.

The Chief Minister said the Budget would introduce several initiatives aimed at encouraging investments, supporting entrepreneurship, expanding employment opportunities and enhancing the state's overall economic competitiveness. He added that the government intends to ensure that the benefits of economic growth reach both urban centres and rural communities alike.

He further emphasised that the administration is committed to balanced development across multiple sectors while creating an environment conducive to long-term investment and industrial growth. Strengthening the livelihoods of farmers, supporting small businesses and promoting renewable energy are expected to be among the major themes of the Budget.

Ram Temple probe given to SIT, not central agencies due to BJP ‘rift’, claims Akhilesh Yadav

Samajwadi Party (SP) chief Akhilesh Yadav on Monday launched a veiled attack on the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP), alleging that the investigation into the alleged Ram Temple donation theft case was entrusted to a Special Investigation Team (SIT) instead of central agencies such as the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) due to an internal power struggle within the party.

Addressing a press conference here, Akhilesh Yadav, without naming the BJP, suggested that it had two centres of power -- one in Lucknow and the other in Delhi and alleged that the handling of the investigation was influenced by this internal rivalry.

Offerings, donations, and contributions have fallen into the hands of a gang of thieves. They are unable to face the public's anger. As you mentioned, they are afraid of public outrage, which is why they are staying indoors, he said.

You mentioned the ED, CBI, and Income Tax. You did not understand what I said. I said this is a power struggle. This gang of thieves, who thrive on offerings and donations, is unable to face the public's outrage. They are terrified of this backlash, which is why they are

staying holed up at home, he said, addressing the reporters.

Elaborating on his allegation, Akhilesh Yadav questioned why the matter was not investigated by central agencies.

You haven't quite grasped the point regarding the ED, CBI, and Income Tax departments. I was talking about a power struggle. If the ED, CBI, or Income Tax were involved, who would be controlling the investigation? Before the Delhi leadership could even react, the Lucknow faction seized control of everything. Can't you understand even that much? What is this SIT? To whom was the report submitted? You fail to grasp even this simple fact, he said.

The former Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister further alleged that the choice of the investigating agency itself reflected the internal political dynamics within the ruling party.

If it were the ED, CBI, or Income Tax, who would hold the reins of the investigation? And in whose hands does the SIT investigation lie?... All of this is happening because of a power struggle. There is a saying: 'Give a man power, and you will see his true character', Akhilesh Yadav stated.

Govt Amends Legal Metrology Rules For High Capacity Scales

NEW DELHI

The Department of Consumer Affairs has amended the Legal Metrology (General) Rules, 2011 to reduce the mandatory standard weight requirement for verification of high-capacity weighing instruments by introducing a scientific, repeatability-based verification approach, an official statement said on Monday. The move will cut compliance burden for industries, warehouses, logistics operators and weigh-bridge owners as well as lower transportation and handling costs to move large quantities of standard weights, the statement from Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food & Public Distribution said. The amendment replaced the earlier rule that required standard weights of at least one tonne or 50 per cent of an instrument's maximum capacity whichever was greater with a scientific, repeatability based approach.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Monday praised the simplicity, humility and grounded nature of senior BJP leader Nitin Nabin, sharing a social media post that highlighted his modest student life in Delhi. The Prime Minister's remarks came amid a heated political exchange between the Bharatiya Janata Party and the Opposition, which has led to a fresh war of words over recent allegations and counter-allegations.

Sharing a post written by one of Nabin's college friends, who is now a noted journalist, Modi described the leader's simplicity and straightforwardness as a matter of pride for every BJP worker. The

post portrayed Nabin as someone who remained grounded despite coming from a political family and never sought special treatment because of his background.

According to the journalist, he first met Nabin in 1998 when both moved to Delhi to pursue higher education after completing their Class 12 examinations. Although Nabin was the son of a sitting legislator from Bihar, he reportedly never projected his family's political status or attempted to use it for personal advantage.

The journalist recalled that the two shared a modest lifestyle while studying in the national capital. They often lived on limited resources, splitting inexpensive meals to reduce daily expenses and travelling on Delhi Transport



Corporation buses instead of opting for costlier modes of transport. The account described Nabin as someone who preferred ordinary living and avoided displaying any sense of privilege.

In another post, the journalist narrated their days in Delhi's IP Extension locality, where Nabin and a group of friends rented modest accommodation in Patpar-

ganj because they could not afford a larger or more comfortable residence. He wrote that Nabin followed a strict monthly budget of around Rs 2,000, covering rent, food and educational expenses through careful planning and disciplined spending.

The journalist further recalled that the group shared household responsibilities equally, including preparing breakfast, washing utensils and cleaning their room. According to him, Nabin never hesitated to contribute to routine chores and maintained a disciplined lifestyle throughout his college years.

Describing his longtime friend, the journalist said Nabin was known for being disciplined, approachable and unassuming.
