

ED freezes TMC's ₹440-crore bank deposits under PMLA

New Delhi: In yet another blow to Trinamool Congress, Enforcement Directorate has frozen Rs 440 crore in three accounts held by the party with HDFC Bank as part of its investigation into alleged laundering of Rs 160 crore of party funds through a Kolkata-based company, Carewell Aviation. The funds were allegedly used to buy an Embraer 600 aircraft and an Agusta chopper for Rs 112 crore in what ED considers to be dubious transactions.
This is the first time the agency has seized bank accounts of a political party. Last month, Kolkata police had frozen debit operations on these three accounts based on complaints from the TMC's rebel MLAs seeking a probe into the source of the funds, amid an internal bat-

chopper were solely used by a top TMC functionary and more funds were laundered as "rentals" using the aviation firm, the ED claimed.
The freeze is seen as a prelude to formal attachments of the three accounts and actions against party functionaries concerned.
"The Embraer Legacy 600 aircraft and Agusta helicopter were rented to TMC itself, even though they were purchased from the corpus of the party, and substantial amounts were transferred on the pretext of aircraft usage. The above stated dubious arrangement is under investigation to ascertain the actual beneficial purpose of the transactions," ED said. Sources said ED may question TMC functionaries, including former CM Mamata Banerjee and party general secretary Abhishek Banerjee. **PTI**

BJP: Encounter 'divine justice'; 'jungle law': TMC

Kolkata: The alleged police encounter killing of one of the prime accused in the Baruiপুর rape-murder case Wednesday quickly turned into a political battleground, with BJP hailing it as "divine justice", the Mamata Banerjee camp in TMC calling it "jungle law", and its rival faction defending the police action.
The West Bengal units of Congress and CPI(M) termed the encounter "pre-planned", with Congress demanding a judicial probe and the Left party calling for a thorough investigation into the incident.
The encounter, the first since BJP gov't assumed office in May, has thrust Bengal into the familiar national debate over "encounter justice", with rival parties accusing each other of importing policing models from other states while trading charges over West Bengal's record on crimes against women.
BJP projected the encounter as evidence of its "zero tolerance" policy against crimes against women. "The demon Prabhakar Mondal... was killed in police firing after trying to flee with firearms. Divine justice," BJP spokesperson Debjit Sarkar said in a post on X.
State BJP president Samik Bhattacharya said gov't had acted firmly to send a message that "no criminal or rapist would be spared". **PTI**

Kolkata: One of the prime accused in the rape-murder of an 11-year-old girl in West Bengal's Baruiপুর was killed in an alleged encounter early Wednesday after he "snatched a firearm from a policeman and tried to escape from custody" during a crime scene reconstruction exercise, a senior officer said.
The encounter — the first such police action since BJP gov't assumed office in May — came amid mounting public outrage over the crime, which had sparked violent protests and put the police under intense pressure.
The accused, **Prabhakar Mondal**, was the first person arrested in the case and considered one of the key suspects after multiple CCTV footage purportedly showed him with the girl shortly before she had gone missing.
According to a senior police officer, Mondal was taken to Suriyapur in South 24 Parganas district around 12.45 am as the investigators

attempted to reconstruct the sequence of events after alleging that he had been misleading the probe and giving contradictory statements.
"During the exercise, he suddenly snatched a service firearm from a policeman and attempted to escape. He also fired a round at the police team. The police retaliated in self-defence, in which he suffered bullet injuries," the officer said.
Mondal was taken to Baruiপুর Sub-Divisional Hospital, where doctors declared him dead. A magisterial in-

quest will be performed on the deceased following which the body will be sent for autopsy, police sources said.
A team of police personnel visited the encounter site Wednesday morning and recorded videographic evidence of the alleged exchange of fire.
Investigators claimed that Mondal was an accomplice to the brutal rape and murder of the minor and had taken her to her assailants, all of whom have now been arrested, after he was allegedly promised Rs

10,000 for the job.
Mondal, they said, had taken the girl to a secluded location after she had left her home to buy a birthday gift for her friend before overpowering her with the help of the other attackers.
Meanwhile, another accused, Kabir Molla, was arrested from Basirhat in North 24 Parganas district in a joint operation by STF Baruiপুর SOG and the district police. Police said Molla had been absconding since the crime. He was brought to Baruiপুর for interrogation, taking the total number of arrests in the rape-murder case to four. Besides Mondal, Anand Sardar and Dibakar Sardar had earlier been arrested.
All three suspects were made to sit face to face at the Baruiপুর police station and interrogated by the investigators on Tuesday. The statement of the victim's mother was also recorded.
The body of the girl, who had gone missing on July 4, was recovered from a pond in the Suriyapur Haat area the next day. **PTI**

'No regret', says mom, refuses to claim body



Wife and mother of Prabhakar Mondal who died in police encounter

Kolkata: The mother of the accused Prabhakar Mondal in the Baruiपुर rape-murder case, who was killed in an alleged police encounter Wednesday, refused to claim the body of her son, asserting that he had met the consequences of his actions.
The accused's mother, Sandhya Mondal, said she had no regret over her son's death in the alleged exchange of fire and would not even go to see his body at the hospital.
"The little girl died after suffering from immense pain. My son got what he deserved for what he did," Sandhya Mondal told reporters after the police informed her of Prabhakar's death.

She said police personnel came to her house, confirmed her son's identity and informed her that his body was lying at the Baruiपुर Sub-Divisional Hospital. "They asked whether I wanted to see him. I don't want to see his face. I will not go to claim the body, and nobody from the family will either," the mother said.
Soon after Prabhakar's arrest in the rape-murder case, Sandhya Mondal had publicly said that her son should be punished if found guilty.
The mother of the accused also alleged that her son had long been addicted to intoxicants and never listened to her advice. **PTI**

Cannot say if he was innocent, I faced abuse after marriage: Wife

Kolkata: The wife of Prabhakar Mondal, a key accused in the Baruiपुर rape-murder case shot dead in an alleged police encounter Wednesday, stated that she cannot say whether her husband was innocent and claimed that he had subjected her to abuse after their marriage.
Speaking to reporters after being informed of her husband's death, Champa Mondal said Prabhakar did not have any regular occupation and mostly stayed at home.
"I cannot say whether he

committed this crime. After our marriage, I saw his behaviour. I have endured a lot of abuse while living with him. When his name surfaced in the case, I felt he was capable of doing something like this," Champa said.
The accused, Prabhakar Mondal, was the first person arrested in connection with the case and was considered one of the prime suspects after CCTV footage purportedly showed him with the minor girl shortly before she had gone missing. **PTI**
