Ahead of dole rollout for women, Punjab notifies Rs 1,500-crore borrowing

THE AAM Aadmi Party dispensation in Punjab Friday announced to raise Rs 1,500 crore in fresh loans by notifying the sale of government securities, the move coming days ahead of the planned rollout of its ambitious monthly financial assistance to women from the first week of July. The fresh borrowing takes the total loan raised in the current fiscal to Rs 6,800 crore.

According to two separate notifications published in the Gazette, the state will borrow Rs 1,000 crore and Rs 500 crore separately through four-year tenure securities. The auctions are set for June 30, with payments scheduled for July 1.

The notifications specify that the stocks will be sold through auction by the Reserve Bank of India's Mumbai office.

The repayment is due on July 1, 2030 and interest will be paid on January 1 and July 1 each year.

The Punjab government had raised Rs 2,500 crore on May 19, Rs 1,300 crore on April 21 and Rs 1,500 crore on April 2.

The government is preparing to disburse in advance three installments of the financial assistance under the Mukh Mantri Mawan Dhiyan Satkar Yojana, under which it has promised Rs 1,000 per month to general category women and Rs 1,500 to those from Scheduled Caste families. Around 28 lakh women have already registered for the scheme and government estimates that it will need around Rs 1,500 crore to pay the advance to eligible beneficiaries.

Punjab has relied on market borrowings to fund various welfare measures and bridge revenue gaps. The women's assistance scheme is a key poll

promise of the AAP that is now being implemented.

Punjab's public debt is projected to cross Rs 4.50 lakh crore by March 2027, with net borrowings for 2026-27 estimated at nearly Rs 40,000 crore. A significant portion of revenue goes towards salaries, pensions, power subsidies, and interest payments, leaving limited fiscal space.

Punjab Congress chief Amarinder Singh Raja Warring claiming that the AAP government was pushing the state towards bankruptcy.

"It is a classic case of robbing Peter to pay Paul," he said, adding the state was being continuously burdened with debt. "I am sure, the AAP will leave a bankrupt Punjab for the successor government," he said.

The Ludhiana MP said the ruling party is aware they will soon be out of power, and is creating massive liabilities for the next government. He warned that it may take generations for Punjab to repay these loans.

"The tragedy is that the loans are not being taken for

any productive or purposeful development but only for the AAP's extravagance. "Given the past experience, it is obvious that the loan money will be used for unproductive purposes like publicity that the AAP desperately needs, to cover up the mess it is in."

He called for greater transparency in how the borrowed funds are used and what long-term benefits they generate for the state.

"The issue is accountability. The people of Punjab deserve to know how every borrowed rupee is being spent and what returns it is generating," he said and asked Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann about total borrowings since March 2022, and the major assets, infrastructure projects, or long-term investments created from these borrowings? "How much public money has been spent on the ongoing 'Lok Milni' programmes, including helicopter travel, event management, publicity campaigns, logistics, and other administrative expenses?" he asked,

3 held for spying for Pak-based handlers, booked under UAPA: Jalandhar police

JALANDHAR POLICE have arrested three local youths for allegedly spying for Pakistan-based handlers and sharing sensitive information about important government and security establishments.

Jalandhar Police Commissioner Satinder Singh said, "A special investigation team constituted under the supervision of senior officers, DCP (Investigation), ADCP (Investigation) and DSP (Investigation), led the operation and arrested Pradeep Singh, who has one case of manhandling in the past, Bhagat Verma and Sachin Khosla, all residents of Jalandhar."

Police said all three (in their mid 20s) accused were engaged in small-scale occupations and belonged to modest economic backgrounds. According to police, their active presence on social media led them to establish contact with Pakistan-based handlers, who subsequently recruited them into the network.

According to police, the trio has been booked under the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act (UAPA), and investigations are underway to identify other members of the network.

Maharashtra to consult Sikh bodies before tabling Bill on Nanded Sahib Board: Dhillon

SAD's Harsimrat, Cong's Randhawa oppose draft law

PUNJAB BJP president Kewal Singh Dhillon Friday claimed that the Maharashtra government has decided to constitute a committee for wider consultations with religious bodies, Sikh scholars and other stakeholders before introducing a draft legislation on Takht Sri Hazur Sahib Board in the Assembly. His remarks came as Punjab leaders, including former Union minister and Shiromani Akali Dal leader Harsimrat Kaur Badal, Congress MP Sukhjinder Singh Randhawa and Akali Dal Waris Punjab De leader Manpreet Singh Ayali, opposed the proposed legislation.

The Punjab leaders' objections follow the Maharashtra Cabinet's approval of the decision to repeal the Nanded Sikh Gurdwara Sachkhand Sri Hazur Abchnagar Sahib Act, 1956 and bring in a new law, which will pave the way for a new administrative framework governing the gurdwara board.

In a letter to Fadnavis, Harsimrat said the Sikh community was anguished over plans to change the character of the Board. She informed that the management of the Takht had also issued a 'gurmat' (collective edict) against the Maharashtra government's decision.

She said the sentiments of the Sikh community, the Shiromani Gurdwara Parbandhak Committee (SGPC) or Hazuri Sachkhand Diwan have not been taken into account in making the decision.

There was a growing impression that this move was an attempt to end the autonomy enjoyed by the Board, she said. "Sikhs worldwide also perceive this as an attempt to take complete control of the shrine to the detriment of the community," Harsimrat told the chief minister.

According to the Bathinda MP, in February 2024, the Maharashtra government amended the Act governing the shrine by giving a go-ahead to appoint 12 out of 17 members of the Board through direct nomination by the government. It was rolled back later. "The representation of the SGPC was reduced and that of the Chief Khalsa Diwan and Hazuri Sachkhand Diwan was abolished altogether. Though this amendment was taken back after massive protests by the SGPC and local Sikh organisations, the government seems to have decided to bring similar changes in the structure of the Board in the new Act," she said.

She appealed to the CM to withdraw the draft law. "This will serve to diffuse the tension which has risen in the Sikh community," the SAD leader added.

Congress MP Randhawa said respecting the autonomy, religious sanctity and traditions of Sikh institutions is the responsibility of every government and constitutional authority.

In a statement, the former Punjab deputy chief minister said that Takht Sri Hazur Sahib is a centre of faith for millions of Sikh devotees and any unnecessary interference in its religious and administrative affairs not only hurts the sentiments of the community but also raises questions regarding established religious traditions and institutional au-

tonomy.

Meanwhile, Dhillon said he personally insisted that broader consultations must be undertaken with the Sikh Panth before any legislative framework concerning the administration of the Takht is finalised.

His intervention was part of a high-level discussion facilitated by BJP national spokesperson R P Singh, who had conveyed community's concerns to the Maharashtra CM. Responding promptly, Fadnavis deputed his Cabinet colleague Chandrashekhar Bawankule to conduct detailed discussions on the matter, according to Dhillon.

Dhillon thanked Fadnavis "for responding positively and with great sensitivity" to the concerns of the Sikh community. "Their assurance of wider consultations is deeply reassuring and reflects genuine respect for the sanctity and spiritual significance of Takht Sri Hazur Sahib." He further said that Takht Sri Hazur Sahib is not merely an institution but a "living symbol of Sikh faith, sovereignty and heritage, revered by Sikhs across the globe".

"Any legislation touching upon its administration must be shaped through dialogue, consensus, and the full participation of religious authorities and the wider Sikh community," he said, adding that the BJP has always stood as a steadfast guardian of Sikh institutions, traditions, and religious sentiments.

Dhillon expressed confidence that the committee formed for wider consultations would ensure that all Panthic voices are heard, and that the final legislative framework, when brought forward, would command the trust and respect of the entire Sikh community.

Jalandhar: Man murders friend, buries his body in a heap of garbage, arrested

POLICE HAVE arrested a man (31) for allegedly murdering his friend and burying his body beneath a garbage dump in the Cantonment area, Jalandhar, after the victim's body was recovered during an investigation of the missing person.

Police identified the victim as Gurpreet Singh alias Noni, a resident of Mohalla No 15, who had been missing since June 22. Sudden disappearance of the deceased, who worked as a part-time DJ, had caused deep concern among family members. On June 23, Gurpreet's family filed a missing person complaint.

One recording showed victim entering the dump yard, but was never seen coming out; following this, investigators detained his friend, Ravi, who worked at the yard

During the investigation, police examined footage from several CCTV cameras in the area. One particular recording showed Gurpreet entering the garbage dump premises, but he was never seen coming out, which raised suspicion. Following this, investigators started focusing on individuals working at the site.

What linked the victim and the dump was the deceased's friend, Ravi, who worked at the yard. Police subsequently detained him, who allegedly confessed to the crime during interrogation. On the night of the incident, he and Gurpreet had been consuming alcohol when an argument escalated, leading Ravi to kill his friend.

To conceal the crime and mislead police, Ravi allegedly

buried the body beneath garbage at the dumpsite. He also reportedly disposed of the victim's motorcycle and mobile phone by throwing them into a canal.

After the confession, police used a bulldozer to excavate the dump and recover the body. The remains were then taken into custody for further legal and forensic procedures.

A relative of the deceased, Ranjit Singh, alleged that Ravi may not have acted alone and demanded that police investigate the involvement of other individuals as well. Police said the accused had been working for the past seven years as a JCB operator at the yard.
