

IIM-R scholar moves NCST against mental harassment

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RANCHI: A PhD scholar at the Indian Institute of Management (IIM) Ranchi has approached the National Commission for Scheduled Tribes (NCST), accusing the premier institute's management of institutional discrimination and mental harassment based on her tribal identity.

The student, identified as Priyanka Kujur, an alumna of the Birla Institute of Technology (BIT) Mesra, lodged her complaint with NCST Member Dr. Asha Lakra at the local Circuit House, accompanied by her parents.

According to the complainant, despite her strong academic credentials, management repeatedly subjected her to derogatory taunts and labelled her "weak" due to her tribal background.

Kujur further alleged systemic bias in academic evaluations, claiming her grades were deliberately weaponised against her.

Expressing severe concern over the developing situation, the student's parents stated that the hostile environment created by the administration was actively pushing their daughter into depression. An official close to NCST member Asha Lakra informed that the matter surfaced two days ago and no direction has been given yet.

"The matter surfaced two days ago at Circuit House in Ranchi. After the IIM assured a proper probe into the matter, no direction was given at that moment. However, the complaint has been sent to Delhi," the official said.

IIM Ranchi officials could not be contacted for their comment on the matter despite attempts.

Meanwhile, NCST member Asha Lakra on Wednesday reviewed the functioning of two universities in the state: Ranchi University (RU) and Dr. Shyama Prasad Mukherjee University (DSPMU).

A press statement issued from her office informed that she reviewed the facilities available to students and the status of promotions and pay fixation for professors and staff at Ranchi University and Dr. Shyama Prasad Mukherjee University.

"The Commission directed officials from both universities to prepare and submit a report within seven days," the press statement informed. During the review, NCST member Lakra noted that neither Ranchi University nor Dr. Shyama Prasad Mukherjee University possesses any real autonomy. "Whether it concerns the appointment of tribal teachers, student scholarships, or the promotion of professors and staff, everything is dictated by the state government," she noted, adding that there is no established system for promotions ranging from the departmental level to the tribal department within these universities and promotions occur only when the state government grants them.

‘Jharkhand should build its knowledge-based identity’

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RANCHI : Chief minister Hemant Soren on Wednesday said the mineral-rich state should build an identity based not only on its natural resources but also on knowledge and skill. He said the state should be defined not just by 'mines' but also by 'mind'; not merely by 'resources' but also by 'research'; not just by 'extraction' but also by 'innovation'; and not merely by 'growth' but also by 'inclusive growth'.

The chief minister said, inviting the industry for a longer association with the mineral-rich state.

Underlining that Jharkhand

has already been contributing to the nation's growth, Soren said: "If we talk about the country's industrial growth, we don't see that happening without Jharkhand in the picture. The state has contributed not only mineral resources but also bureaucrats, technologists and skilled professionals to the country. We need to align their expertise and move forward together."

The Jharkhand government, through its departments of Information Technology, Industries and Tourism, is organising a two-day National Stakeholders Consultation on 8-9 July 2026 in the state capital. The event will bring together leading policymakers, industry leaders, investors, technology experts and development partners from India and abroad to deliberate on Jharkhand's long-term development agenda and chart a roadmap for sustainable industrial, technological and tourism-led growth.

As part of the consultation, the government will release

draft policy frameworks and invite valuable feedback from industry and other key stakeholders. These include the Draft Jharkhand AI Policy, Draft Jharkhand Investment Promotion Policy, Draft Jharkhand Tourism Policy, Draft Jharkhand Textile Policy, Draft Jharkhand Regulations, Draft PPP Policy, and the Concept Paper on the Jharkhand Foundation, along with other draft policy initiatives.

Maintaining that every state has its own strengths and eco-

system, Soren cautioned against adopting a 'copy-paste' approach to development. "We want AI, technology and good governance. As AI and technology develop, we need to see how mining can be carried out scientifically while protecting ecology," he said.

Noting that mining activities occur in 14 of Jharkhand's 24 districts, Soren said technological advancements should be harnessed to balance economic development with environmental protection. He also high-

lighted the state's reserves of critical minerals, including uranium and mica. Jharkhand has significant uranium deposits, the chief minister said, citing assessments that suggest the reserves could meet the country's requirements for decades. He also pointed to the challenges in assessing the extent of mica deposits, saying neither the state nor the Centre currently possesses adequate technology to accurately estimate the resource.

Sarna Samiti chief granted anticipatory bail in a case related to anti-encroachment drive

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RANCHI: The Jharkhand High Court on Wednesday granted anticipatory bail to Kendriya Sarna Samiti president Nisha Kumari Bhagat in a case related to allegedly obstructing government officials from discharging their duties during an anti-encroachment drive at the DIG Ground of the Rajendra Institute of Medical Sciences (RIMS) on December 12 last year.

According to the prosecution, Bhagat led a protest at the DIG

Ground while the district administration was carrying out the anti-encroachment drive against settlers on allegedly encroached RIMS land.

According to the FIR registered at Sadar police station under sections U 126(2), 223(a), 224, 121(1), 132, 351(2), 352, 3(5) of BNS, she allegedly mobilised the mob, raised anti-government slogans and obstructed officials and the JCB while carrying out the drive.

On February 25 this year, Additional Judicial Commissioner cum Special Judge CBI (AHD) AK Tiwari had rejected

her anticipatory bail petition (ABP) after Bhagat sought anticipatory bail from him.

A high court advocate close to the matter said, "The order was passed by the bench of Justice Sanjay Kumar Dwivedi after argument of a Supreme Court advocate Shishir Raj," he said.

Raj later confirmed the order passed by the Jharkhand High Court.

Asked about the arguments, Raj said, "It was alleged that one of the lady constables was bitten by unknown persons and a Home Guard's uniform was torn in the scuffle. I pointed out that

no specific act was attributed to my client and that there were only general and omnibus allegations. I also submitted that my client's saree was dishevelled in the scuffle and that she was a victim of police high-handedness. I argued that she had only gone there to protest as a tribal leader because the homes of two senior tribal women were being demolished despite their having bona fide registered deeds and land receipts. I informed the court that my client complied with the notice served under Section 35(3) of the BNS and extended full cooperation with the probe."

2 CYBER CROOKS ARRESTED IN BOKARO; CASH, MOBILE PHONES SEIZED: POLICE

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BOKARO: The Bokaro district police have arrested two alleged cyber fraudsters and busted an organised racket that allegedly duped people by posing as bank and credit card executives over phone calls, officials said on Wednesday.

The accused, identified as 23-year-old Rohit Kumar Das of Patel Nagar, Chas, and 28-year-old Arjun Kumar Das of Ambedkarpuri, Chas, were arrested during coordinated raids conducted on July 7 by the cyber police, technical branch and local police on the directions of Bokaro Superintendent of Police (SP) Nishu Singh Meena after receiving intelligence through the Pratibimb app.

Addressing a press conference at his office on Wednesday, DSP (Headquarters) Pawan Kumar said that both the accused admitted during interrogation to their involvement in cyber fraud. "The accused disclosed that they, along with several associates, operated through WhatsApp groups and targeted unsuspecting people by impersonating bank employees and credit card executives. Efforts are on to identify and arrest the remaining members of the racket," he said.

Based on the disclosures made by the duo, police recovered four mobile phones, five SIM cards, two bank passbooks, ₹9,400 in cash and a handwritten list containing mobile phone numbers of potential victims whom they allegedly intended to target.

Police said the accused used the collected phone numbers to contact people and attempt financial fraud by misleading them with fake banking and credit card-related calls.

A case has been registered at Bokaro Cyber Police Station under No. 23/2026 dated July 7 under Sections 11, 318, 319, 328 and 340 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS), along with Sections 66(C) and 66(D) of the Information Technology Act.
