9 CISF personnel, driver injured as vehicle overturns in J&K’s Katra

JAMMU, June 29 (PTI)

NINE Central Industrial Security Force (CISF) personnel were injured, three of them critically, when their vehicle overturned near Katra in Jammu and Kashmir’s Reasi district on Monday, officials said.

The vehicle was on CISF duty when it turned turtle near a sharp turning point on the Tarakote-Balini route, they said, adding the driver also suffered injuries. Overall, ten people were injured in the incident.

Three CISF personnel who suffered serious injuries were shifted to the Government Medical College (GMC) hospital in Jammu, while seven others sustained minor injuries and were taken to the Katra Community Health Centre (CHC).

AC blast triggers fire on 21st floor flat in Noida; no casualties

A BLAST in an air-conditioner unit triggered a fire in a flat on the 21st floor of a residential society in Noida on Monday morning, fire officials said.

No casualties or injuries were reported in the incident, they said.

The fire broke out in a flat at the Aranya Society in Sector 119 around 8:50 am, Chief Fire Officer Pradeep Kumar said.

Six fire tenders were rushed to the spot which brought the blaze under control in about half an hour, he said.

According to the fire department, the blaze was triggered by an explosion in an air-conditioner unit installed in the flat.

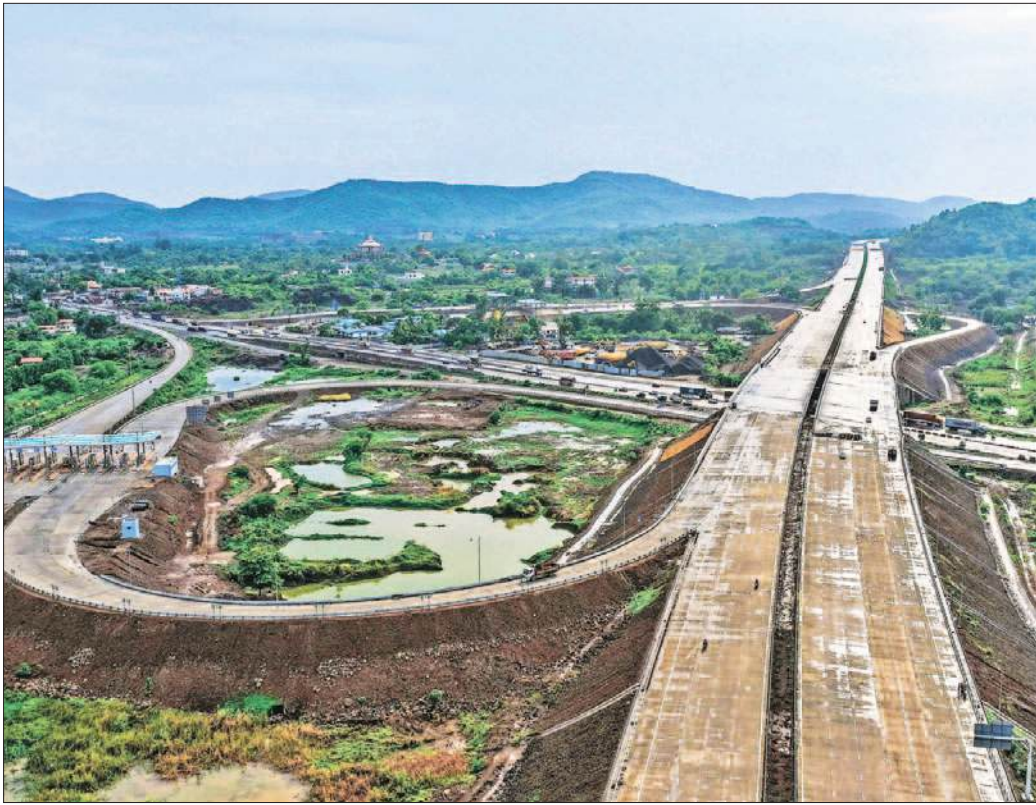
“The family was asleep when the AC unit exploded, triggering the fire. The blaze was doused promptly and no casualties or injuries were reported in the incident,” Kumar said.

Assam Police bust fake govt job racket, arrest 7

GUWAHATI, June 29 (PTI)

ASSAM Police have busted a fake job racket and arrested seven people for swindling people of lakhs of rupees on the promise of providing Government employment, officials said on Monday.

According to officials, the gang allegedly used to issue forged appointment letters with fabricated Government seals and false recruitment notices in the name of the Water Resources Department. “The accused, operating as part of an organised racket, allegedly cheated job-seeking youths of substantial sums of money,” an official said. “Victims were made to believe that they were being offered legitimate Government employment. A case has been registered.

Shah assures all possible help to flood-hit Assam, Arunachal

NEW DELHI, June 29 (PTI)

UNION Home Minister Amit Shah on Monday assured the chief ministers of Assam and Arunachal Pradesh of all possible assistance from the Centre for flood relief operations in the two States battered by heavy rain, officials said.

Shah dialled Assam Chief Minister Himanta Biswa Sarma and Arunachal Pradesh Chief Minister Pema Khandu to take stock of the situation arising from flash floods and heavy monsoon rains.

According to the Assam State Disaster Management Authority (ASDMA), nearly 16,000 people were affected by floods in 69 villages across four revenue circles in Dhemaji.

In a social media post, Sarma said he briefed Shah on the relief and rehabilitation measures presently underway. “He has also assured us all possible support and assistance from the Government of India to deal with this situation,” he said.

“I thank Hon’ble Home Minister Shri @AmitShah Ji for his phone call and enquiring about the flood situation in Dhemaji,” he added.

Arunachal Pradesh continued to receive torrential rains on Monday, resulting in devastating

floods that disrupted road connectivity, damaged infrastructure and claimed lives in around 12 districts across the state.

Floods and landslides caused by incessant rainfall

were also reported in several other parts of Arunachal Pradesh, where houses were inundated and infrastructure damaged, prompting the local administrations to launch rescue and evacuation operations, they said.

Rescue operations involving the Indian Air Force were suspended overnight due to poor visibility but resumed on Monday.

The IMD has forecast more heavy rain accompanied by thunderstorms and lightning over East

Siang and neighbouring districts, including Leparada, Lower Siang, Lower Subansiri and Papum Pare.

Akal Takht gives Punjab one month to address anti-sacrilege law objections

CHANDIGARH, June 29 (PTI)

AKAL Takht Jathedar Giani Kuldeep Singh Gargajj on Monday directed the Punjab Government to address objections concerning the anti-sacrilege law within a month.

He passed this direction at a gathering of all Sikh MLAs and Cabinet Ministers of Punjab after being summoned by Akal Takht in Amritsar. Jathedar Giani Kuldeep Singh Gargajj, on June 15, had directed all Sikh Legislators, regardless of party affiliation, and Sikh Ministers to appear before the highest temporal seat of Sikhs for their clarification after it objected to the anti-sacrilege law -- Jaagat Jot Sri Guru Granth Sahib Satkar (Amendment) Act, 2026 -- saying that it was enacted without consulting the Sikh Panth. Addressing the MLAs at Akal Takht, Gargajj asked the State Government to address their objections within one month by bringing suitable amendments to the law, and urged it not to interfere in religious affairs.

Gargajj also handed over a list of objections to the MLAs, including one regarding the replacement of the word ‘Bir’ with ‘saroop’ (a copy of the Guru Granth Sahib).

The Jathedar told the MLAs and Ministers that the Vidhan Sabha had no right to decide on the Sikh language, and asserted that only Akal Takht could take a call on the matter. He also pointed to certain provisions of the law to which the Akal

Takht had objections. He, however, stated that he had no objection to punishing those who are guilty of desecrating the Guru Granth Sahib.

The Jaagat Jot Sri Guru Granth Sahib Satkar (Amendment) Bill, 2026, was unanimously passed by the Punjab Assembly on April 13.

It includes a provision for stricter punishment, including life imprisonment for any act of sacrilege against the Guru Granth Sahib. Speaking to reporters before the appearance of MLAs in Amritsar on Monday, Jathedar Gargajj slammed the AAP Government for allegedly interfering in religious affairs and the authority of the Akal Takht, and accused the party of trying to come between the Guru and the Sikh through the anti-sacrilege law.

“We should not all go against Guru Panth and Guru Granth Sahib. We should go as per the sentiments of the Sikh Panth,” he said. Among the Sikh Cabinet ministers who have been summoned are Harpal Singh Cheema, Ravjot Singh, Gurmeet Singh Khudian, Baljit Kaur, Balbir Singh, Harbhajan Singh, Punjab Assembly Speaker Kultar Singh Sandhwan, AAP MLAs Kuldeep Singh Dhaliwal, Inderbir Singh Nijjar, leader of opposition Partap Singh Bajwa, Congress MLAs Pargat Singh, Rana Gurjit Singh, Barindermeet Singh Pabra, Tript Rajinder Singh Bajwa, Sukhpal Singh Khaira and Akali MLA Ganieve Kaur Majithia.

Guj’s Jal Abhiyan boosted water storage capacity by 20,789 lakh cubic ft this yr

GUJARAT’S ongoing water conservation drive under the ‘Sujalam Sufalam Jal Abhiyan’ has increased water storage capacity by 20,789 lakh cubic feet this year, taking the cumulative rise over the past eight years to a record 1,38,039 lakh cubic feet, Water Resources and Water Supply Minister Ishwarsinh Patel said on Monday.

The initiative, implemented in alignment with Prime Minister Narendra Modi’s ‘Catch the Rain’ campaign, has evolved into a large-scale public participation pro-

gramme aimed at improving groundwater levels and expanding water conservation infrastructure across Gujarat.

“With the objective of increasing water storage capacity across the state and raising groundwater levels, the ‘Sujalam Sufalam Jal Abhiyan’ has become a significant public movement through participation of citizens,” Patel said.

According to the minister, the campaign was launched statewide on February 23 in Gandhinagar by Chief Minister Bhupendra Patel.

By May, a total of 13,315 works had been completed across various departments through coordinated implementation.

These works include 2,450 projects for deepening ponds, 3,661 desilting works of check dams, and 1,160 repair works of check dams. In addition, canals covering 626 kilometres and drains stretching 1,277 kilometres were cleaned as part of the programme.

J&K LG performs ‘Pratham Puja’ at Amarnath cave

JAMMU/SRINAGAR, June 29 (PTI)

PRATHAM pujas were held on Monday in Jammu and at the cave shrine of Amarnath, marking the ceremonial start of the annual pilgrimage beginning July 3. Jammu and Kashmir Lieutenant Governor Manoj Sinha performed traditional rituals at the cave shrine while another pratham puja was held for the first time in Jammu city as a part of ‘maha yagya’ on the banks of the Tawi river.

The annual 57-day pilgrimage is scheduled to begin on July 3 from the twin routes - the 48-km traditional Pahalgam track in south Kashmir’s Anantnag district and the shorter but steeper 14-km Baltal route in central Kashmir’s Ganderbal district.

The first batch of pilgrims will be flagged off from the Bhagwati



Nagar base camp in Jammu on July 2. It will culminate on August 28 on Raksha Bandhan.

Sinha performed the pratham

puja, sought the blessings of Baba Barfani and prayed for peace, prosperity, health and well-being of all.
