

AP emerging as defence mfg hub: Rajnath

Indian Navy commissions indigenously built stealth frigate INS Mahendragiri into Eastern Fleet in Visakhapatnam

THE Indian Navy commissioned the indigenously built stealth frigate INS Mahendragiri into its Eastern Fleet in Visakhapatnam on Saturday, marking the induction of the sixth of the seven Project 17A Nilgiri-class stealth frigates.

At the commissioning ceremony, Defence Minister Rajnath Singh underscored India's progress in indigenous defence production and described Andhra Pradesh as an emerging centre for defence and aerospace manufacturing.

"Andhra Pradesh has emerged as a new powerhouse of India's defence and aerospace manufacturing. It is playing its role across air, water, land, and the unmanned domain," he remarked, adding, "This means the weapon systems that we once used to import from abroad will now be produced near our own Vizag," he said.

He cited the foundation stone laying for the Advanced Medium Combat Aircraft (AMCA) Core Integration and Flight Testing Centre at Puttaparthi

and Bharat Dynamics Limited's upcoming Naval Systems Manufacturing Facility in Anakapalli, where autonomous underwater vehicles, torpedoes and underwater countermeasure systems will be produced.

"AMCA in the skies, BDL's naval systems in the depths of the ocean, Kurnool's drones in the unmanned domain, and today, INS Mahendragiri on the surface of the sea signify that Andhra Pradesh is now contributing to India's defence

strength across every sphere," he noted.

The Defence Minister also underlined the changing character of warfare, observing that technological advances were transforming military operations without diminishing the importance of conventional capabilities.

"Future wars may be fought with Artificial Intelligence, but they will still be won by national resolve, trained soldiers and credible military power," he re-

marked. Emerging technologies such as artificial intelligence, drones, cyber warfare, hypersonic weapons and space-based systems, he emphasised, complement rather than replace conventional military platforms.

Citing Operation Sindoor, the Defence Minister pointed to the operation as an illustration of the effective integration of modern technologies with conventional military capability.

The frigate was designed by the Indian Navy's Warship Design Bureau and built by Mazagon Dock Shipbuilders Limited, Mumbai. With over 75% indigenous content, the 6,670-tonne warship can attain 28 knots. It is configured for fleet air defence, anti-surface and anti-submarine warfare, maritime interdiction, surveillance and HADR.

It carries supersonic and medium-range missiles, stealth features, sensors, network-centric systems, anti-submarine weapons and a multi-role helicopter. It could also be equipped with the BrahMos missile system.

Describing maritime securi-

ty as integral to India's economic interests, the Defence Minister observed that secure sea lanes were essential for trade, energy security and resilient supply chains. He noted that the Indian Navy's humanitarian assistance, anti-piracy operations and evacuation missions had reinforced its role as a first responder and a preferred security partner in the Indo-Pacific.

Referring to Operation Urja Suraksha during the West Asia conflict, he stated that the Navy had safely escorted 18 merchant vessels carrying cargo worth more than ₹9,000 crore.

Chief of the Naval Staff Admiral Krishna Swaminathan described INS Mahendragiri as another milestone in indigenous warship construction that would strengthen the Navy's operational capability.

Built with contributions from more than 200 Indian industries, including several MSMEs, the frigate is named after the Mahendragiri mountain range in the Eastern Ghats and will enhance the Navy's operational reach in the Indian Ocean Region.

Pushkarams: SCoR GM inspects stations & ghats

IN view of the forthcoming Godavari Pushkaram, General Manager, South Coast Railway, Sandeep Mathur, conducted a comprehensive inspection of key railway stations and major pilgrim ghats to review passenger amenities, safety measures, and operational preparedness for the anticipated rush in pilgrim traffic.

Accompanied by the Divisional Railway Manager (DRM), Vijayawada Mohit Sonakiya, Chief Administrative Officer/Construction Ankush Gupta; Principal Chief Engineer BSK Rajkumar; Principal Chief Commercial Manager K Sambasiva Rao; IG & Principal Chief Security Commissioner AK Sinha and senior railway officials of the Division, the General Manager inspected Kovvur and Godavari railway stations to assess passenger circulation, crowd management arrangements, and amenities.

At Rajahmundry railway station, he reviewed the ongoing station redevelopment works and directed officials to expedite the works while maintain-



ing the highest quality standards to ensure enhanced passenger convenience.

Sandeep Mathur inspected bathing ghats, including Pushkar Ghat, Markandeya Ghat, Shraddhanagar Ghat, Saraswati Ghat, and Gowthami Ghat, to evaluate connectivity and ease of movement for pilgrims between the railway stations and the riverfront.

Sandeep emphasized that the Railway will work in close coordination with the State Government and law enforcement agencies to ensure efficient management of the large pilgrim turnout during Godavari Pushkarams. A high-level meeting was held at Rajahmundry with government officials, later joined by D Narasimha Kishore, SP, Rajahmundry District, and senior railway officials.

Police arrest Radha Gayatri's husband

UTTARAKHAND Police arrested Somayajula Sree Charan on Saturday after he remained absconding for several days in connection with the alleged murder of his wife, Vizag software professional Parupudi Radha Gayatri, who died under suspicious circumstances at a homestay in Mussoorie on June 15, 2026.

Police teams tracked him down after obtaining a non-bailable warrant from the Judicial Magistrate, Mussoorie. The court remanded him to 14 days of custody and police later shifted him to the District Jail at Sudhawal.

Deputy Superintendent of Police JC Pant is investigating the case. Radha Gayatri, 27, died at a Mussoorie homestay on June 15 after the couple travelled from Delhi via Rishikesh and checked in on June 14.

Police registered a case against Sree Charan under Section 103(1) of the BNS after Gayatri's parents, Sudhakar and Satyavati, alleged that he had murdered their daughter and demanded his arrest.

The Dehradun district administration ordered an inquiry and invited the public to submit information by July 17. Radha Gayatri married Sree Charan in Vizag on November 8, 2025, and had joined a company in Gurugram before the couple travelled to Mussoorie.

On June 15, Sree Charan informed Radha Gayatri's family of her death, but her parents alleged foul play and sought preservation of evidence. Police recovered blood stains, liquor bottles and food items from the room. Sree Charan later absconded after claiming innocence, and police also summoned his parents.



34K get degrees at JNTU-GV's first convocation

ity urban infrastructure projects worth ₹1,122.86 crore across participating ULBs.

The initiative aims to create a sustainable funding source for civic infrastructure while strengthening financial disci-

pline, creditworthiness and municipal governance.

It supports the CM's Swarna Andhra@2047 vision of developing clean, liveable and economically vibrant cities. The pooled bond mechanism will

enable municipalities to access institutional capital for projects such as drinking water supply, stormwater drainage, waste management and street lighting without relying on government grants.
