Pratyush battles for life; BJP for murder charge on police

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JAMSHEDPUR: 25-year-old Pratyush Anand, injured in the fatal chopper attack in front of police outside the Double Down (DD) Bar and Cafe here on June 27 midnight that killed 28-year-old Himanshu Singh, is battling for his life with 22 stabbing wounds in a private hospital in Kolkata even as a BJP delegation on Saturday demanded murder case against the police personnel present on the spot at the time of the attack, people close to the development said on Saturday.

"Pratyush was stabbed at 22 places of his body and the doctors had to operate out one of his lungs because of the irreparable damage caused to it. His intestines have also been severely damaged. He is now out of the ventilator but is still in critical condition in the CCU," Chandan Singh, uncle of Pratyush, told HT on Saturday.

Singh also revealed that the pathological tests didn't found alcohol in Pratyush's stomach.

"Tests didn't find alcohol in Pratyush's stomach. We have not filed an FIR as of now because our priority is to save Pratyush and get him fully cured. Pray for his well being Let him recover fully. Once he is in state to talk, we will file FIR as per his statement. We want justice not money or job or anything else," asserted Singh.

Singh, a noted builder in Adityapur, however, minced no words in expressing his hurt feelings on being isolated in this hour of crisis.

"I am also a member of the BJP family but unfortunately none from this family stood by

us when we needed them most. Jharkhand BJP president Aditya Sahu and a senior leader from Delhi called me today over phone. Aditya ji wanted to come to our Adityapur residence today but all our family members are in Kolkata, camping at the hospital premises. Hence, I requested him not to come. We thought the BJP leaders would raise the issue that Pratyush and Himanshu were attacked and stabbed in front of the police. They should have questioned why the PCR police kept Himanshu and Pratyush waiting for over 20 minutes when they were leaving for home? They should have demanded legal action against these police personnel for assisting in murder," an emotional Singh said.

He also thanked CM Hemant Soren for calling him at 12 AM on June 28 when Pratyush was in the operation theatre.

"Our entire family is thankful to CM Soren for his call on June 28 midnight when Pratyush was in the OT. He promised all possible help from the government and assured action would be taken against all the guilty, including the police personnel. Even the CM could call us but not anyone from my own party BJP which I considered our extended family. Former health minister Banna Gupta, former Ichagarh MLA Arvind Singh 'Malkhan', Uplendra Singh Mastaan, Ranchi-

based Manoj Singh and Om Prakash Sonu (patron of Shah-eed Bhagat Singh Fans Club) visited us at the hospital in Kolkata. We thank them all," said Singh.

Why didn't police fire in air: BJP

Meanwhile, BJP state president Aditya Sahu, former LoP Amar Bauri and party MLA Bhanu Pratap Shahi visited late Himanshu Singh's residence in Adityapur on Saturday and demanded registration of FIR for murder charge against the police personnel present during the chopper attack.

"We demand that the state government register murder case against the police personnel present during the chopper attack on Himanshu and Pratyush on June 27 midnight and be sent to jail immediately. Two youths were attacked with choppers and other sharp weapons under the nose of the police in Jamshedpur. They rushed into the police van to save their lives, the assailants dragged them out and stabbed continuously in front of the police. Why didn't the police fire in the air? It seems there is not rule of law but parallel government of criminals running in the state with the patronage of the police," Aditya Sahu told the media on Saturday.

Bauri and Shahi said the state government was trying to whitewash the crime and divert the case.

"BJP will not allow the government to succeed in doing so. Now, Jamshedpur has been shut down and if justice is not delivered to the victim families soon, entire Jharkhand will be shut down. A BJP delegation will meet the governor in this matter shortly," they said.

Arrest warrant against 5 accused, Neeraj bail hearing on Monday

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JAMSHEDPUR: The court of the Jamshedpur district and sessions judge on Saturday transferred the anticipatory bail application of hotelier and builder Neeraj Singh to the court of ADJ-1 while calling for report on seizure of his two cars and search in his house without any warrant, seizure list and notice, lawyers close to the development said on Saturday.

"The court of district judge transferred Neeraj Singh's bail application to the court of additional district judge (ADJ-1) hearing on which will be on July 6. We have argued that accused Neeraj Singh wasn't present on the spot and reading the FIR suggest that his name was added in the last for conspiracy. There is no role of Neeraj in the main part of the FIR. Nowhere in the FIR has even been said that Neeraj Singh played any direct role in the incident. There can't be any vicarious liability," Prakash Jha, senior advocate representing Neeraj Singh, told HT on Saturday.

Jha said the legality of the FIR, police action, seizure process had been challenged in the three petitions filed by Neeraj Singh and his wife Sandhya Singh.

"In the petitions filed by Sandhya Singh, the court of the chief judicial magistrate has called report from the Bistupur PS. They seized away two cars from their house but didn't give any seizure list. They went into his house without any notice or search warrant and the court wasn't informed... The police entered, searched and made seizures in Singh's house where only his wife, 13-yr-old daughter and a domestic help live," said

Meanwhile, Jamshedpur police have obtained arrest warrants against five named accused in the FIR - Neeraj Singh, main accused Biswanath Lohra alias Bodra, Vijay Kumar bar manager, Rahul Dubey and Amit Lohra. In the murder of Himanshu Singh outside Double Down (DD) Bar and Cafe.

Police said Biswanath Lohra alias Bodra had fled the state with his wife and three teams had been conducting raids in Bihar, West Bengal and Odisha.

"Biswanath reached Chaibasa first after the fatal chopper attack on Himanshu and Pratyush in Bistupur. He runs and illegal liquor business and leads a luxury life. As per the CCTV footage, the dispute was triggered over Biswanath and Sonu Ram Sardar insisting on playing a particular song while throwing currency notes on the dancing girls, which Himanshu and Pratyush opposed to. Sardar has confessed that after he was hit by Pratyush with a tile on their way out from the bar that Biswanath called their associates from Gambaria," police said.

The CCTV footage also showed Sonari resident Rahul Dubey and several other dubious characters inside the bar.

"Rahul is a member of the Ravi Das gang of Sonari," police said.

Dhanbad: Alleged threat calls by gangster Prince Khan spark political storm

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DHANBAD : A fresh controversy involving Wasseypur-based fugitive gangster Prince Khan has triggered a political storm in Dhanbad after both Nirsra MLA Arup Chatterjee and Dhanbad MP Dhullu Mahto claimed to have received separate threat and extortion messages from him. While the MLA has alleged a criminal conspiracy hatched by the MP, Mahto has rejected the charge and linked the threats to the deteriorating law and order situation in Jharkhand.

The latest development comes even as the political confrontation between the two leaders over the proposed elevated flyover at Nirsra is still continuing.

CPI ML-L legislator Arup Chatterjee alleged that around noon on Friday he received a WhatsApp voice message, text message and a video showing firing from an international number displaying a South Africa code. In the message, the sender, claiming to be Prince Khan, allegedly demanded extortion money and warned him to "manage the matter within 24 hours" or face death.

According to the MLA, the voice message said, "Block the number if you want, but that will not save you. Tell us clearly whether you will pay or not. If not, we will directly give the result."

On Saturday, Chatterjee lodged a written complaint at Nirsra Police Station. He also forwarded his complaint to CM Hemant Soren, the DGP, home secretary and the Dhanbad SSP.

In his complaint, Chatterjee alleged, "I have received threats to my life through WhatsApp after refusing to pay extortion. I believe these threats are part of a criminal conspiracy hatched by Dhanbad MP Dhullu Mahto. The purpose is to intimidate me and prevent me from performing my constitutional and democratic responsibilities."

The MLA further claimed, "I have already exposed several issues related to the MP, including his alleged links with Prince Khan. A day after I raised these issues publicly, I received the threat. The entire matter, including the alleged relationship between Prince Khan and the MP, should be investigated."

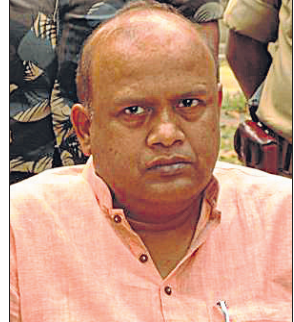
He also demanded CBI inquiry into the case and security for himself and his family, saying, "I am not afraid of such threats, but the truth must come out."

Responding to the allegations, Dhullu Mahto disclosed that he too had received an extortion and death threat from Prince Khan on July 1 through WhatsApp. He said he had already informed the ministry of home affairs as well as Dhanbad and Delhi police.

"The state government should investigate the matter and take strict action," Mahto said.

Rejecting the allegations levelled by the MLA, the MP said, "I have no connection with any criminal or mafia. I am fighting only for the development of Dhanbad and will continue to do so."

urday carried out attachment proceedings at Prince Khan's house in Wasseypur. A police team led by City SP Ritwik Srivastava reached the premises with a JCB machine and began demolishing a portion of the building.

City SP Ritwik Srivastava clarified, "The structure was in a dilapidated condition and posed a safety risk as children frequently play nearby. During execution of the court's attachment order, the unsafe portion was demolished. Prima facie, the building also appears to violate sanctioned building norms. Further action will be taken after a detailed inquiry."

Dhanbad SSP Prabhat Kumar said police had started investigation into the MLA's complaint.

"We have received the written complaint and are examining all available evidence, including the WhatsApp messages and call details. Necessary legal action is being taken as per law," the SSP said.

With both a sitting MP and an MLA claiming to have received threats from the same gangster, the incident has once again brought the spotlight on organised crime, political confrontation and law and order in the coal belt of Dhanbad.
