

BJP chief given rousing welcome

BJP chief Nitin Nabin on Saturday lauded Uttar Pradesh's transformation under the party's "double engine" government and said the BJP would win the assembly polls next year.

Nabin arrived in Lucknow on a two-day visit, during which he is expected to hold a series of meetings with senior leaders to streamline the party's strategy for the 2027 assembly polls and "guide the newly formed team of the state BJP".

His visit also comes amid a controversy over the alleged embezzlement of Ram temple's donations, a issue around which the opposition, particularly the Samajwadi Party, has tried to corner the BJP.

Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath and top leaders of the party received Nabin, the youngest national BJP chief ever, at the Lucknow airport. "The way the double-engine government Modi-Yogi duo has transformed Uttar Pradesh into Uttar Pradesh, Lotus will bloom in Uttar Pradesh, which is home to cities of Kashi Vishwanath, Ayodhya and Mathura," Nabin told PTI Videos.

"Based on the enthusiasm we saw today among the party workers across Lucknow and the entire state, we can say with certainty that the BJP workers are fully prepared for 2027," Nabin said, responding to his party's prospects in the 2027 assembly polls.

UP BJP chief Pankaj Chaudhary, both Deputy Chief Ministers Keshav Prasad Maurya and Brajesh Pathak, and other UP ministers were also present at the airport. BJP general secretary (organisation) B. Santhosh also arrived in Lucknow on Saturday when he was received by Chaudhary.

The two-day schedule of Nabin includes a dinner meeting with CM Adityanath, separate meetings with UP

BJP chief Chaudhary, deputy CMs Maurya and Pathak, some intellectuals, party lawmakers and others.

In view of the upcoming assembly elections in Uttar Pradesh next year, this visit of the BJP national president is extremely important to sharpen the BJP's strategy and guiding the newly announced UP BJP," the party said.

"Several issues, including plan and strategy for 2027 UP polls, will come up for discussion," a senior BJP leader said. Nabin is also tipped to meet party functionaries like regional presidents, district unit presidents and heads of various morchas. A meeting with the party's core committee is also likely to take place.

Later, he will meet prominent personalities of Uttar Pradesh at the residence of Padma Shri awardee Dr Vidya Bindu Singh in Lucknow. This is Nabin's third visit to the state since taking over as the party chief. A visit to the Hanuman Setu temple is also on the cards, party leaders said.

After his arrival at the airport, a

grand roadshow to party headquarters began as leaders and workers lined up to welcome the BJP president. Some party workers were also seen standing on a bulldozer front where they showered petals on him.

The BJP president travelled on a specially designed motorised chariot, which covered a distance of almost 18 km, and was welcomed at around 40 places by party workers. His motorcade virtually crawled as party cadres jostled to meet and greet him.

Some Muslim women were also seen standing with a garland of 403 lotus flowers (symbolising 403 seats of the UP Assembly) as they welcomed the BJP president near Hind Nagar, UP BJP Minority Morcha chief Basit Ali told PTI.

In a post on X in Hindi, Adityanath said, "A warm welcome and greetings to the national president of BJP, Shri Nitin Nabin ji, in Uttar Pradesh—a land sanctified by the dust of the holy feet of Lord Shri Ram and the divine Lord Shri Krishna, and a centre of culture,

values, and creativity."

Chaudhary, who is also the Union Minister of State for Finance, posted on X, "during the grand welcome procession from the airport, the people of Uttar Pradesh and energetic party workers welcomed the national president with great enthusiasm and warmth at various points along the route." In another post, Chaudhary said, "Extended a warm welcome to national general secretary (organisation) B. Santhosh at Lucknow Airport today. Your energetic presence and able guidance always provide the organisation with a new direction and strength."

Deputy CM Maurya told reporters that the entire city of Lucknow and the state unit of the BJP are extending a warm welcome to the BJP national president at the state office. A series of meetings with him is scheduled for Saturday and Sunday, infusing "renewed enthusiasm" among the party workers, he said.

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LDA to undertake development, beautification works across city

Lucknow Development Authority (LDA) will undertake development and beautification works across the city worth ₹266 crore.

An approval was granted to 120 development projects during the Infrastructure Development Fund Meeting held recently at the LDA.

One of the projects includes the water laser light and sound show.

LDA Vice-Chairman Prathamesh Kumar said that a light-and-sound system for the water laser show would be installed along the Gomti Riverfront for ₹25 crore. Residents and visitors will soon be able to enjoy a water laser light-and-sound show at the Gomti Riverfront. The show will creatively showcase the history of Uttar Pradesh, as well as Lucknow's art, culture, and heritage.

To strengthen the city's firefighting capabilities, two modern hydraulic platforms will be purchased, for which LDA will provide ₹68 crore to the Fire Services.

The LDA vice-chairman also stated that ₹15 crore will be spent on utility shifting and other works under the Green Corridor Project.

Open gyms will be set up in the Kanpur Road scheme, Ashiyana, Sarojini Nagar and other areas at a cost of approximately ₹10.67 crore to promote public fitness and



Infrastructure development works worth nearly ₹10 crore will also be undertaken in Gram Sadraha. An RCC drain will be constructed in the Cattle Colony for ₹7.50 crore. Another RCC drain will be constructed from Lok Bandhu crossing to the LDA parking area.

Kumar further said that a modern library will be developed within the historic Butler Palace at a cost of around ₹5 crore. The internal portion of the building will be renovated and repurposed for this purpose.

Revenue Board to expedite land dispute cases

For the speedy disposal of cases related to land disputes and other cases, the Board of Revenue has formed three-member special benches for its courts in Lucknow and Prayagraj to hear all cases related to reserved category land, government land, gram sabha land, Nazul, rural evacuee property and enemy property (if any). This arrangement has been implemented with immediate effect.

Board of Revenue Chairperson Archana Agrawal said, "Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath has consistently emphasised freeing government and public land from encroachment, ensuring time-bound resolution of land disputes, and making the revenue justice system modern and technology-driven."

"Accordingly, exercising the powers conferred under Section 9 of the Uttar Pradesh Revenue Code, the new arrangement has been implemented. Its objective is to ensure transparency, judi-

cial quality and uniformity in the disposal of these sensitive matters," the Board of Revenue Chairperson said.

The arrangement has come into effect immediately, under which all pending and new cases in these categories before the Board of Revenue courts in Lucknow and Prayagraj will now be placed before the specially constituted three-member benches.

These special benches will regularly hear such cases every Wednesday," she said. Archana Agrawal said under the new arrangement, cases related to reserved category land, government land, gram sabha land, Nazul land, evacuee property and enemy property will no longer be heard by a single bench of the Board of Revenue or by the Circuit Court.

These matters will now be considered collectively by the specially constituted three-member bench. This will incorporate diverse judicial perspectives on important matters and strengthen the decision-making process, making it more impartial and just.
