

Four crushed to death by truck on NH-19 in Kaushambi

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PRAYAGRAJ: Four men, including two brothers, were killed after a truck rained into a stationary pickup van on the Prayagraj-Kanpur National Highway (NH-19) in Kaushambi district in the early hours of Wednesday, police said.

The accident took place around 1.30 am near Trilokpur village under the Saint police station limits, about 20 km from the district headquarters.

Three victims died on the spot, while the fourth succumbed to injuries at the district hospital, officials shared.

The deceased were identified as brothers Sahir Ali, 30, and Akbar Ali, 32, residents of Ward No. 10 in Sarai Aali under Saint police station, and puncture mechanics Anwar Hussain, 40, a resident of Murargan in Sar-

dipgan Ghat police station area, they rushed to the spot after hearing the impact.

There was no lighting at the accident site and the entire stretch was in darkness. The truck driver may not have noticed the parked vehicle," he said.

Circle officer, Saranah, Sayendra Prasad Tiwari, said the truck driver fled with the vehicle after the accident.

All four injured were taken to the district hospital, where doctors declared them dead. A case has been registered against the unidentified truck driver on the complaint of the victims' kin. CCTV cameras installed in the vicinity are being examined to identify the vehicle and its driver," he said.

Police have sent all four bodies for post-mortem examination and launched a search for the absconding driver.

{ DALMANDI DEMOLITION } SHOPKEEPER DIES AFTER BRICK FALLS FROM BUILDING

VARANASI: A 54-year-old shopkeeper died after being struck on the head by a brick that allegedly fell from a building being demolished under the Dalmandi road widening project in Varanasi on Tuesday, police said.

The deceased, identified as Channu alias Parvez Khan, a local resident, owned a satellite shop in Dalmandi. He was on his way to the shop when the brick fell near the corner of Marryam Hospital Lane and Janjira Shah Masjid, where demolition work is underway as part of the road widening project. He collapsed on the spot after sustaining a head injury.

Locals rushed him to the BHU Trauma Centre, where he succumbed to injuries during treatment.

Deputy commissioner of police (Kashi zone) Ganay Banswal said police received information about the incident during the demolition work.

The injured man was taken to the trauma centre, where he died during treatment," he said.

Banswal said the body had been sent for the post-mortem examination and an inquiry initiated to ascertain the circumstances leading to the incident.

According to preliminary findings, the brick is suspected to have been dislodged by a monkey from the building under demolition, though the exact cause is being verified, police said.

Several buildings are being demolished under the Dalmandi road widening project. The administration has restricted public movement around demolition sites as a safety measure, but officials said some people continue to enter the prohibited areas, increasing the risk of accidents.

Following the incident, police inspected the spot and recorded statements of local residents and eyewitnesses. The public to avoid entering restricted demolition zones and follow safety advisories. Construction agencies have also been directed to strictly adhere to safety norms to prevent similar incidents.

{ CRIME FILE } 11.57 quintals of cannabis destroyed

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PRAYAGRAJ: The Prayagraj Police Commissionerate destroyed 11.57 quintals of seized cannabis, valued at approximately Rs 5.78 crore, under a special drive named 'Operation Dahan'. The operation was jointly carried out by the Narcotics Task Force (NTF) and police teams from Soran, Mauana and Jhansi police stations. The destruction process was conducted in compliance with court directives and the provisions of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (NDPS) Act, under the supervision of a high-level committee.

The project, inspired by the world-class water sports boat house and warehouse developed by the Sports Authority of India in Kerala, is being implemented in phases following decisions taken by the divisional sports development and promotion committee headed by divisional commissioner Saumya Agrawal.
