

Police nab 3 middlemen who brought Bangladeshi nationals to M'luru

Following the tracing of 11 Bangladeshi nationals at two construction sites in Urwa Police Station limits, the Urwa Police have arrested three men from West Bengal and registered a case for allegedly bringing them to Mangaluru and employing them as labourers.

Commissioner of Police Sudheer Kumar Reddy C H said the middlemen had been identified as Moidul Islam (35) from Laigola, Murshidabad, West Bengal, Delaewar Hossain (29) from Shyampur, Murshi-

The trio had been bringing labourers from various northern states to work in Mangaluru. During the investigation, it was found that some Bangladeshis had allegedly been brought along with these workers.

The police have arrested Moidul Islam and Delaewar Hossain in Mangaluru. Rasul Islam was traced to Kolkata through coordination between the Mangaluru Police and the Kolkata Police. The police commissioner said the enquiry was still going on and their antecedents were being verified.

He told *DH*, "We are interrogating them and collecting information. We will seek their police custody and continue interrogation, so that we will know more details on other Bangladeshi nationals if any."

He said, "The exercise on verification at construction sites and other places is going on. We only could trace Bangladeshi nationals here. Labourers from other states at the site continue to work normally after the verification," he added.

The interrogation of the arrested is expected to reveal whether more people were involved in the alleged network

of bringing illegal immigrants to Mangaluru for employment. The investigation is underway.

The police commissioner said the Deputy Commissioner of Police (law and order) coordinated with the Kolkata Police to secure Rasul Islam's arrest. A Mangaluru police team has already left for Kolkata to take him into custody and bring him to the city for further investigation.

According to the police, the Bangladeshi nations were brought to Mangaluru by creating fake documents. The trio had lured Bangladeshi nationals with promises of money and

employment. They are accused of bringing the Bangladeshi nationals to Murshidabad in West Bengal, creating forged documents, and transporting them to Mangaluru.

The accused allegedly made them work as labourers by promising higher wages while paying them only a portion of the agreed salary, thereby profiting from their labour.

The preliminary investigation revealed that the accused facilitated the illegal entry of Bangladeshi nationals into India, helped them reside unlawfully, and provided them with forged documents.

VHP lauds police action against illegal migrants

MANGALURU, DHNS: The Vishva Hindu Parishad (VHP) has welcomed the Mangaluru City Police's ongoing crackdown on illegal Bangladeshi migrants and urged the authorities to extend similar operations across all the coastal districts of Karnataka.

VHP Karnataka South Province Joint Secretary Sharan Kumar Pumpwell lauded Police Commissioner Sudheer Kumar Reddy for directing all police stations under the commissionerate to intensify action following the detection of suspected illegal Bangladeshi migrants in Surathkal and Urwa. The VHP appealed to the Inspector General of Police to intervene and order similar verification drives across DK, Udupi and Uttara Kannada districts.

MLC Ivan D'Souza on Tuesday condemned the BJP leaders for accusing the Congress of protecting Bangladeshi nationals in the name of the Special Intensive Revision (SIR) of electoral rolls. "There is no question of protecting infiltrators into the country."

He told mediapersons that during the tenure of former prime minister Manmohan Singh, the Centre deported around 83,000 people to Bangladesh over a period of 10 years. "In contrast, the BJP-led Centre has deported only about 8,000 people in 12 years. The BJP leaders should know the history before making such allegations."

Referring to West Bengal,

he questioned as to how many illegal immigrants had been deported from the state.

He urged the Centre to issue a white paper detailing the number of illegal immigrants deported to Bangladesh from West Bengal, Uttar Pradesh, Odisha, Assam and other northeastern states. He also called upon the BJP leaders in Karnataka to press the Centre

for the information.

He alleged that, in the name of identifying illegal migrants, Muslims were being targeted and genuine voters' names were being deleted from the electoral rolls. "It is the responsibility of the central government to prevent infiltration into the country," he said.

Wild boar deaths in Kundapur region trigger concerns

UDUPI, DHNS: The sudden deaths of wild boars in Byn-door and Kundapur region have triggered concerns among the residents and authorities.

Veterinary and forest officials are awaiting laboratory reports to ascertain the exact cause of deaths. The deaths have been reported over the past several days from villages, including Alur, Senapura, Haladi and Hattiyangadi, all located within a radius of about 30 to 40 kilometres.

Locals said they had come across several wild boar carcasses in agricultural fields, roadside vegetation and forest fringes, prompting fears of a possible disease outbreak among the wild animal population.

Chief Veterinary Officer Dr Nagaraj told *DH* that reports of wild boar deaths had been coming in for several days. "However, officials were able to conduct post-mortem examinations on only eight carcasses that were found in a condition suitable for examination. Out of the eight wild boars examined, samples from two animals have been collected and sent to the Indian Institute of Animal Health

and Veterinary Biologicals (IIAH&VB) laboratories in Mangaluru and Bengaluru for detailed analysis. We expect the test results within the next couple of days," he said.

According to Nagaraj, there is currently no indication that the deaths were caused by poisoning or any other human intervention. "At present, it appears to be either a viral or bacterial infection, but we cannot confirm the cause until the laboratory reports are received," he said. Official records presently account for eight wild boar deaths. However, Dr Nagaraj noted that interactions with the locals suggested the actual number could be significantly higher.

"People in the affected villages have informed us that they have seen more than 15 wild boar carcasses in different locations. Since many of the animals were found much later, some carcasses had already decomposed, making post-mortem examination impossible," he added.

The Forest Department sources said the situation was being closely monitored in coordination with the Animal Husbandry Department.

Software engineer on Hong Kong tour goes missing

MANGALURU, DHNS: A software engineer, who travelled to Hong Kong for a tour, has been reported missing after he failed to return home.

The missing person has been identified as Chetan Ramachandra Karkera (37), who worked in Bengaluru.

He had informed his family that he would be travelling to Hong Kong from November 9 to December 12. However, he failed to return home.

Anyone with information about his whereabouts is requested to contact the Urwa Police Station, said a release.

5 booked for moral policing

MANGALURU, DHNS: The Belthangady Police have registered a case against five identified persons and others for allegedly threatening and abusing a young woman and her friend near the Didupe Falls in Belthangady taluk.

According to the police, the complainant, a young woman employed in Mangaluru, had visited the Didupe Falls in Ma-

lavantige village along with her friend. When the two arrived at the parking area, they were allegedly intercepted by a group of five to six people.

The complainant alleged that the group objected to her being accompanied by a youth belonging to a different faith. They allegedly abused the duo in foul language and threatened them with dire consequences.
