

Maha's TET language policy for Kannada teachers flayed

THE Karnataka Vidyavardhaka Sangha (KVS), Dharwad, has strongly condemned the Maharashtra government's decision to require Kannada-medium teachers in Maharashtra to write the Teacher Eligibility Test (TET) in Marathi, alleging that the move violates the norms of the National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) and is aimed at weakening Kannada education in the border areas. In a resolution passed at a special executive committee meeting, the sangha described the decision as 'unconstitutional' and an act of discrimination against Kannada-speaking teachers.

It stated that Karnataka conducts the TET for teachers of Marathi-medium schools in Marathi, and Maharashtra should adopt a similar approach by allowing Kannada teachers to write the examination in Kannada. The sangha alleged that the Maharashtra government's refusal to provide the examination in Kannada reflects an intention to discourage Kannada learning and education. It also expressed concern that the Maharashtra government had ignored the proposal submitted by the Karnataka government on the issue.

Warning of strong protests by the Kannada-speaking community if the decision is not withdrawn, the sangha urged Chief Minister D K Shivakumar to immediately intervene and take up the matter with Maharashtra Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis and to ensure justice for Kannada teachers. The sangha executive committee also appealed to Union Minister for Education Dharmendra Pradhan to treat the issue with urgency and initiate necessary steps to resolve the matter.

Monsoon brings back sea erosion nightmares to U-K

AS the Southwest Monsoon lashes the coast, the familiar terror of sea erosion has returned to Uttara Kannada, swallowing homes and livelihoods across 15 villages. Official data shows that 11.282 kilometres of coastal land have already been damaged, with Harwada in Ankola taluk alone losing 2.2 kilometres to the advancing sea. For Suresh, a resident of Harwada, the nightmare began in the dead of night. Jolted awake by the roar of torrential rain and crashing waves, he found seawater gushing into his house. In a desperate race against time, he and his family managed to salvage wooden doors, windows, and roof tiles before fleeing to safety. Moments later, they stood helplessly as witnesses to their own home being battered and damaged by the relentless sea. Suresh is not an isolated case. Across the coastal belt, dozens of houses stand denuded, half-collapsed, or completely abandoned, victims of an annual crisis

that has only intensified in recent years.

In Belambara village, also in Ankola taluk, at least three dozen houses are on the verge of collapse, while many more have already been deserted. Compound walls that once offered protection now lie breached, with seawater lapping at the very foundations of homes. "We built these houses with our own hands, and now we are forced to watch them being swallowed by the sea. The erosion has worsened drastically over the past few years," said Satish Harikant, a Belambara resident.

"We have appealed to the district administration for retaining walls. We received assurances, but nothing has moved beyond that promise," he said. Vijay Kharvi, another local, described the rapid progression of the crisis. "It started just two years ago with one house being washed away. Today, there are many. Women stand with tears in their eyes, watching their homes crumble into the water," he said.

According to a 2025 report sub-

mitted by the district administration to the state Revenue Department, the affected villages include Majali and Devbagh (Karwar taluk), Harwada, Belambara, and parts of Gokarna (Ankola taluk), Belikan, Alvekodi, Dareshwara, Ramanagindi, and Kadle (Kumta taluk), Thoppalak-eri (Honnar taluk), Murudeshwara, Belake, Shambavi, Mavalli, Thudalli, and Bedrakeri (Bhatkal taluk).

Despite the district administration preparing an action plan, implementation has remained stalled. Deputy Commissioner of Uttara Kannada, Lakshmi Priya, told media persons that the state government has assured 70 crore for the proposed action plan. "Until the funds are released, we have directed the Port Department to undertake emergency measures to curb the erosion," she said. For the residents of these fragile coastlines, however, every monsoon brings not just rain, but the heartbreak of watching their world wash away, one wave at a time.

Man ends life over money-lending harassment, leaves six-page note

A 38-year-old man, Sampath Dandagi, a resident of Kariyammakal Extension, allegedly committed suicide by hanging himself on Saturday, citing relentless harassment over 'meter interest' as the primary cause. In a selfie video and a six-page death note recovered from the scene, Dandagi detailed names, monetary transactions, and how he was allegedly trapped and driven to the extreme step. He also mentioned that he had taken about Rs 60 lakh on interest to lend to others and urged investigators to check audio files on his mobile phone and CCTV footage from his house for further clarity.

According to family sources, Dandagi was threatened by two local men—Dharmagouda Kariyanagoudar and Ravi Shivanagutti—who claimed that cheques in his and his wife's names were outstanding.

His wife and mother have alleged that

the duo repeatedly threatened to file a cheque bounce case, subjecting him to continuous mental torture. In his poignant video message, Dandagi said: "I went to help people, and this is where I stand today. I helped those in need, but no one came to my aid when I was in trouble. Maruti Karane spread misinformation about me. Now they are threatening me over money taken from Dharmagouda Kariyanagoudar. I am taking this decision without knowing where I am going."

The Gadag Extension police have registered a case and initiated an investigation. While authorities have externed 13 individuals over the past three months in connection with illegal money-lending, officials admitted that the menace of 'meter interest' continues to persist in the region. "Investigation is underway, and all aspects will be ascertained after a thorough probe," a police official said.
