

CM launches Jan Kalyan Shivirs at 42 locations across national Capital

Delhi Chief Minister Rekha Gupta on Thursday inaugurated a Jan Kalyan Shivir at the MCD Community Hall in Sandesh Vihar, Shalimar Bagh. The camp was the first of 42 such welfare camps being held across all districts of Delhi from June 18 to 20, designed to bring Central and Delhi Government scheme benefits under one roof for citizens. Meanwhile, Delhi Assembly Speaker Vijender Gupta separately inaugurated a parallel camp in Rohini. The camps run daily from 10 am to 5 pm at all 42 locations and have been organ-

ised under the theme "12 Years of Trust, Development and Public Welfare." MLA from Tri Nagar Tilak Ram Gupta was present at the Sandesh Vihar launch.

The Chief Minister said that earlier, Delhi residents had to visit different offices to access the benefits of various schemes, with many facilities remaining unavailable to them for years. She said the present Government is now reaching people at their doorstep with what she described as a resolve of service, convenience, and solutions, under a double-engine Government and a triple-engine system dedicated to public service.

Eligible beneficiaries can access information, assistance, and registration facilities for various schemes from different departments at a single location. Separate counters have been set up by departments, including the Delhi Jal Board and the House Tax Department, to provide assistance without causing inconvenience. The Chief Minister appealed to residents to visit their nearest Jan Kalyan Shivir with the required documents and avail themselves of the benefits on offer.

The camps offer access to a wide range of services. These include Pink Cards, Ration Cards, e-Shram Cards,



Jan Dhan Accounts, the Lakhpati Bitiya Yojana, the PM-UDAY Scheme, the PM SVANidhi Scheme, Aadhaar registration, the Talent Hunt Hauslon Ki Udaan programme, the Rashtriya

Vayoshri Yojana, House Tax services, information on the PM Surya Ghar Yojana for solar power, and loan facilities for MSMEs and industries. Saplings are being distributed under the Ek Ped

Maa Ke Naam campaign. Assistance is also available for scholarships, higher education support, and caste certificates for Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe members, along with the Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana, the Widow Daughter Marriage Assistance Scheme, regularisation of Delhi Jal Board water connections under LPSC, record updates for widows and persons with disabilities, and issuance of Ayushman Cards for senior citizens above 70 and BPL card holders.

At the separate Rohini camp, inaugurated at Rana Pratap Sarvodaya Kanya Vidyalaya in Sector 5, Speaker

Vijender Gupta said the camp reflects the government's commitment to ensuring citizens can access welfare schemes without unnecessary procedural difficulties. He described the camp as a comprehensive service platform offering facilities related to ration cards, e-Shram cards, Jan Dhan accounts, the Lakhpati Didi Yojana, Ayushman Bharat, PM Ujjwala Yojana, PM Vishwakarma Yojana, disability welfare schemes, and pension-related services.

Gupta said such outreach programmes strengthen the connection between Government institutions and citizens, with special atten-

tion given to women, senior citizens, persons with disabilities, workers, entrepreneurs, and economically weaker sections so that no eligible beneficiary is left out. He urged residents of Rohini and adjoining areas to actively participate and take advantage of the services on offer.

Both camps will remain operational through June 20, running in parallel with 40 other locations across Delhi's districts as part of the same coordinated outreach effort timed to coincide with the completion of 12 years of the Modi Government and reinforced by the Delhi government's own welfare delivery push since taking office.

Delhi Assembly forms 32 House committees for 2026-27

Delhi Assembly Secretariat, on the directions of Speaker Vijender Gupta, has constituted 32 House committees for 2026-27. Speaker Gupta will chair five House Committees, while Deputy Speaker Mohan Singh Bisht will head three, an official statement announced on Thursday.

Opposition AAP MLAs Gopal Rai and Praveesh Ratn will chair the committee on papers laid on the table and the committee on delegated legislation, respectively.

All the remaining panels are headed by the ruling BJP MLAs, according to the statement from the Delhi Assembly Secretariat.

The youngest MLA in the House, Umang Bajaj (32), will chair the department related standing committee on education (covering education, higher education, training, art, culture, and sports). Bajaj is the BJP MLA from Rajinder Nagar constituency.

Both the BJP and opposition AAP MLAs have been given proportional repre-



sentation in the panels, according to the statement.

The Delhi Assembly speaker will chair the business advisory, private members' bills and resolutions, rules, general purposes, and library committees. Deputy Speaker Bisht will head the committee on Government assurances, the questions and references committee, and the committee on peace and harmony.

The committee of privileges will be chaired by BJP MLA Pradyumn Singh Rajput. Its members will include Abhay Kumar Verma, Ajay

Kumar Mahawar, Neeraj Basoya, Ravi Kant, Satish Upadhyay, Surya Prakash Khatri, all BJP MLAs, and AAP MLAs Ram Singh Netaji and Surendra Kumar.

The specialised House — committee on violation of protocol norms and contemptuous behaviour by Government officers with MLAs — will be chaired by BJP MLA and former minister Kailash Gahlot.

The committee on the Municipal Corporation of Delhi (MCD) will operate under the chairmanship of BJP MLA Om Prakash Sharma.

MLA Karnail Singh will head the committee on the welfare of transgenders and persons with disabilities. Its members include Anil Goyal, Harish Khurana, Kailash Gahlot, Kailash Gangwal, Manoj Kumar Shokeen, Prem Chauhan, Shikha Roy, and Virender Singh Kadian.

The committee on issues related to unauthorised colonies will be headed by Kuldeep Solanki, while Deepak Chaudhary will chair the committee on the welfare of students and youth.

Speaker Gupta stated that these committees will immensely benefit the legislative process, ensuring rigorous oversight and structured deliberation on matters of public welfare.

He also expressed hope that the committees would make meaningful recommendations and contribute significantly towards addressing the aspirations and concerns of the people of Delhi.

The Delhi Assembly, having a membership of 70, comprises 48 BJP and 22 AAP MLAs.

Ex-Agniveers to get 20 per cent reservation in Group C posts: LG

Delhi Lieutenant Governor Taranjit Singh Sandhu on Thursday directed 20 per cent reservation for ex-Agniveers in group 'C' posts of police constables, firemen, forest guards, jail warders and wildlife guards.

Setting a firm operational timeline, the Lt Governor issued a strict deadline of June 30th for all concerned departments to finalise the required processes and implement the necessary amendments to their respective Recruitment Rules. All concerned departments have a June 20 deadline to complete the necessary processes and amendments to recruitment rules, he said.

Sandhu reviewed the strategy for extending reservation benefits to ex-Agniveers (retired short service Army personnel) across various Government departments and agencies in Delhi during a meeting with the chief secretary and Delhi Police Commissioner



and other senior officers. Delhi Chief Secretary Rajeev Verma and Police Commissioner Satish Golcha and other senior officers were present in the meeting.

This initiative is being implemented in accordance with the guiding vision of the Government of India, Sandhu said in a post on X.

"To effectively harness the discipline, skills, and training of these young men and women, directed the implementation of a 20 per cent reservation in direct recruitment to vacant Group 'C' posts, including Police Constables, Firemen, Jail Warders, Forest Guards, and Wildlife Guards," the LG said.

Group C posts are non-gazetted positions. He said

recruitment will be open to all eligible ex-Agniveers to ensure equal opportunity and recognise their service to the nation. Sandhu had proposed recruitments of former Agniveers to the Delhi Fire Service in a meeting held on June 8.

The departments have further been empowered to deploy and utilise the specialised capabilities of these recruits in line with their operational requirements, he added. Agniveer scheme is the new recruitment system introduced by the Government of India for the Indian Army, Navy, and Air Force. Under the scheme, eligible candidates are enrolled as Agniveers for a fixed period of four years.

₹5 lakh aid for Malviya Nagar fire hero, Govt to bear treatment cost

The Delhi Government on Thursday provided financial assistance of ₹5 lakh and announced to bear the entire cost of treatment of a man who saved lives in the Malviya Nagar fire. In the tragic incident earlier this month, 23 persons died while over two dozen were injured. Chief Minister Rekha Gupta sent a "heartfelt" letter to Rohit Mukhiya, appreciating his sense of duty and compassion in the face of danger, said a Delhi CMO statement.

The chief minister in the letter saluted the courage and humanity of Mukhiya, a resident of Khirki Extension, who risked his life to save several people in the fire incident, it said. The chief minister has sanctioned an ex-gratia assistance of ₹5 lakh for him and also assured him that the Delhi Government will bear all medical expenses until his complete recovery, it said.
