Mithila Sansthan and Oxford institute may enter academic pact

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DARBHANGA: The Bihar government has initiated the process for an institutional collaboration between the Mithila Sanskrit Shodh Sansthan (Mithila Sanskrit Postgraduate Studies and Research Institute) in Darbhanga and the Oxford Sanskrit Text Society (OSTS) after receiving a formal proposal from the UK-based organisation seeking collaboration in preserving, digitising and promoting India's rich manuscript heritage.

The proposal was submitted by Professor Diwakar Acharya, chair of founding trustees OSTS and Spalding Professor of Eastern Religions and Ethics at the University of Oxford, in a letter to Rajya Sabha MP Sanjay Kumar Jha, who has been spearheading efforts to revive the historic institute.

In the letter, Acharya described the Darbhanga-based institute as an internationally respected centre of Sanskrit scholarship and proposed an institutional Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) for long-term collaboration in manuscript preservation, scientific cataloguing, digitisation, preparation of critical editions of unpublished texts, academic publications, research, training and international scholarly exchanges. He also proposed including the institute in an international initiative on manuscripts and Indian Knowledge Systems being developed under the University of Oxford's TORCH (Oxford Research Centre in the Humanities) programme.

Following the proposal, Sanjay Kumar Jha met Bihar chief minister Samrat Choudhary on Tuesday, seeking the state's approval for the proposed MoU. In his letter to the chief minister, Jha said the institute houses thousands of rare Sanskrit manuscripts on philosophy, Nyaya, grammar, literature, Ayurveda, astronomy and several other branches of India's traditional knowledge.

He said the collaboration would facilitate scientific cataloguing, digitisation, conservation, international research pub-

lications, scholar exchanges, training programmes and global academic partnerships while complementing the Centre's Gyan Bharatam Mission for preserving ancient manuscripts.

Sharing the development with reporters on Wednesday, Jha said chief minister Samrat Choudhary had responded positively to the proposal and directed the education department to initiate the formal process for signing the MoU.

The chief minister's office later confirmed the decision through its official X handle, describing the proposed collaboration as a "historic opportunity" for Bihar. It said the partnership would facilitate scientific documentation, digitisation, conservation, research and international publication of thousands of rare manuscripts preserved at the institute.

The proposed collaboration comes against the backdrop of the Bihar government's ₹56.8 crore redevelopment plan for the institute, approved by the state cabinet in February 2025 following an announcement made during then chief minister Nitish Kumar's Pragati Yatra. Of the total outlay, ₹48.64 crore has been earmarked for renovation, new construction and campus development, while ₹8.16 crore has been allocated for conservation and digitisation of manuscripts. The construction project is being executed by the Bihar State Educational Infrastructure Development Corporation Limited.

EOU raids areas linked to 'corrupt' excise inspector

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PATNA : Sleuths of economic offences unit (EOU) on Thursday carried out simultaneous raids at five premises linked to an excise inspector of Siwan accused of possessing assets worth ₹2.36 crore disproportionate to his known sources of income. Searches were carried out at locations in Patna, Munger and Siwan after the EOU obtained permission from a special vigilance court.

Ankesh Kumar Gond alias Ankesh Raj, had allegedly amassed assets exceeding his known income by around ₹2.36 crore. Separate EOU teams began searches early on Thursday and are examining property records, bank account details, financial documents and other records. Ankesh had joined the department as assistant sub-inspector in 2005.

During his service so far, the inspector has purchased three plots and a house.

The raids are being conducted

at Gond's residence in Sultanpur area of Danapur police station limits, his ancestral house in Chandanbagh under Kasim Bazar police station of Munger, a commercial building in Lalpukhara in Munger, his office in the Excise Department in Siwan and his rented accommodation behind the registry office in Chitragupta Nagar (Siwan).

The EOU sleuths unearthed a palatial three floor house worth Rs 80 lakh belonging to Gond at Sultanpur. The vigilance sleuths have also found that the excise inspector and his family owned several automobiles including SUVs, car, and four motorcycles. Sources said the excise inspector had purchased an SUV (Innova Crysta) worth over ₹25 lakh in the name of his wife Poonam Devi six years ago, on June 1, 2020 by paying cash. Its purchase documents and bill have been found.

EOU team have also found registration papers of Hundai i10 car, Tata Altroz car, investment in mutual funds, invoice regarding auction of a vehicle which

was seized in Neora police station in Patna.

The sleuths also have recovered eight bank passbook, ₹54 lakh in PPF account, bank locker, five life insurance policies, a commercial land purchase in Munger valued of ₹1.40 crore besides a Mahindra Scorpio on the name of his relative. Officials said the Scorpio was leased to excise department but the inspector was using it for own purpose.

Officials said the investigation is focused on assessing his income, real estate holdings, bank accounts, investments and other movable and immovable assets. Officials added that the recovered documents and assets will be evaluated after the searches conclude, following which further legal action will be taken. The search operation is still underway. The EOU said it has been taking action against public officials accused of corruption and possessing disproportionate assets and has initiated similar proceedings against several officials in the past.

3 from Araria killed as speeding SUV hits them in UP's Noida

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GREATER NOIDA: Three men were killed after a speeding SUV allegedly hit them from behind and dragged one of them for about 50 to 100 metres before fleeing the spot in Greater Noida's Jewar late Wednesday.

Police said a case was registered at Jewar police station, and the car was identified with the registration number noted down by locals and also captured in CCTV cameras. The driver was arrested late Thursday evening.

Police identified the deceased as Karan, 22, Vishwajeet, 24, and Mithun, 25, all natives of Araria in Bihar. They were residing in rented accommodation in Nimka village of Jewar and worked as daily wagers in agricultural fields.

On Wednesday, all three were

going to the market around 9 pm when a speeding SUV (Mahindra Scorpio N) coming from Jewar and heading to Khurja hit them.

"The collision was so intense that two of them fell on the sides of the road, while the third one, who sustained severe bruises and injuries, got stuck under the vehicle and was dragged about 50 to 100 metres. They were rushed to a nearby hospital where doctors declared them brought dead," said a police officer, part of the investigation, requesting anonymity.

Police registered a case of rash driving and causing death by negligence of BNS at Jewar police station on the complaint of victim's family members.

Police said that after post-mortem procedure on Thursday, the families took their bodies to their home town in Bihar for last rites.

VIGILANCE COURT REJECTS RISHU SHREE'S BAIL PLEA

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PATNA : The special judge of vigilance court Atul Kumar Singh on Thursday rejected the regular bail of contractor Rishu Ranjan Sinha alias Rishu Shree, accused in connection with the tender scam case. The court reserved the bail of another accused, Tarini Das, a retired chief engineer of the building construction department.

Special public prosecutor, vigilance court, Anandi Singh said that the court reserved its order after hearing arguments from both sides, she added.

She said, "I strongly opposed the bail as it involved a big misuse of public money. The vigilance had found 61 sale deeds in his name and that of his family."

In a related development, the hearing on the anticipatory bail plea of accused IAS officer Sanjiv Hans could not take place. The court has scheduled the matter for hearing on July 10.

Body found in Patna's VVIP area

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PATNA : Police found the body of a 45-year-old unidentified man at the VVIP area Harding Road pool no-15 under Sachiwalaya police station on Thursday.

The incident took place near bridge number 15 on Harding

Road which is considered highly sensitive and important as it houses bungalows of several state ministers and MLAs.

Police said the body was found, just 400 metres away from the residence of a MLA and hardly 200 metres away from legislative assembly premises. They suspect that the man

was killed elsewhere and his body was thrown at Harding Road by the culprits before they escaped, said sources.

Sachiwalaya SDPO-1 Anu Kumari said, "A police team soon came to the spot and sent it to the PMCH for post-mortem. The police are trying to identify the body," she added.

The statutory auditors have expressed an unmodified audit opinion on these results.				
2. The Board of Directors at its meeting held on July 9, 2026, has declared an interim dividend of ₹12.00 per equity share.

In April 2019, Computer Sciences Corporation (referred to as CSC) filed a legal claim against the Company in the Court of Northern District of Texas and Dallas Division (trial court) alleging misappropriation of trade secrets and other CSC's confidential information and sought preliminary and permanent injunctive relief, and unspecified monetary damages and disgorgement of profits.				
A trial before an advisory jury was held and on November 17, 2023, the jury returned an advisory verdict in favour of CSC, finding that the Company misappropriated CSC's trade secrets and recommended compensation of US \$70 million and a further punitive damage of US \$140 million to be paid by the Company to CSC. Subsequently, the parties filed their respective written submissions in the matter. On June 13, 2024, the trial court passed a judgment by the following:				
1. The Court ordered that the Company is liable to CSC for US \$56 million in compensatory damages and US \$112 million in exemplary damages.				
2. The Court also assessed that the Company is liable for US \$26 million in prejudgment interest through June 13, 2024.				
On November 21, 2025, the Fifth Circuit issued a decision affirming the District Court's rulings on liability and further awarded costs to CSC.				
On March 19, 2026, a petition for a writ of certiorari from the US Supreme Court was filed, seeking a review of the case. On June 15, 2026, the Supreme Court denied the petition.				
The Company had provided US \$150 million (₹1,352 crore) towards this legal claim in the statement of profit and loss for the year ended March 31, 2026 and disclosed US \$112 million (₹1,010 crore) as "Provision towards legal claim" under "Exceptional Items" and US \$38 million (₹342 crore) under "Other interest costs". Pursuant to the denial of the Company's petition by the Supreme Court, the Company has provided for a further amount of US \$70 million (₹668 crore) towards exemplary damages and costs awarded to CSC, in the statement of profit and loss for period ended June 30, 2026, and disclosed as "Settlement of legal claim" under "Exceptional Items". In addition, the Company has provided for US \$7 million (₹69 crore) towards interest paid until the date of settlement and disclosed it under "Other interest costs".
