Accused in the case of stabbing a local liquor shop salesman to be tried in court

Gopalpur (correspondent):Gopalpur police today arrested and tried the accused in the case of stabbing two people. The accused has been identified as Jogendra Das. Dharma Sahu and Tutu Patnaik were injured in the stabbing. On receiving information, the accused reached the counter of Ambapua No. 3 local liquor shop at 9:30 am today and abused Tutu Patnaik in vulgar language and demanded liquor from the counter salesman Dharma Sahu. He threatened to kill him if he did not give it. Later, the accused attacked Dharma on the hand and stomach with the knife he brought and stabbed Tutu on the middle right hand. Dharma has registered a complaint at the Gopalpur police station. The complaint has been registered as Police Case No. 413/26. A case was registered and the police reached the spot and started investigation. The accused Jogendra was arrested from Pokadibandha Chowk in the afternoon and the knife used in the attack was seized and he was charged to court, the police said.

MAN HELD FOR ALLEGED ATTEMPT TO MURDER WOMAN

Paralakhemundi,(correspondent)::A youth was arrested for allegedly stripping a woman, attempting to sexually assault her, and trying to murder her in a secluded hill forest near Antarada under R. Udayagiri police station in Gajapati district. The victim, a resident of Dhepagunj under Adava police limits, was allegedly lured by the accused, identified as Rahul, to a hill near Dagadpur village. According to her complaint, he took her into a remote forest, attempted to sexually assault her, attacked her with a knife, and later tried to kill her by striking her with a stone. Villagers rescued the seriously injured woman and rushed her to Khajuripada Community Health Centre. She was later shifted to the District Headquarters Hospital at Paralakhemundi for advanced treatment. She sustained severe injuries to her head and hands and is undergoing treatment. Based on the investigation, R. Udayagiri Police arrested the accused and produced him before the court. Further investigation is in progress.

High Court Comes to the Aid of Differently-Abled Government Employee

Bhadrak, (correspondent):In a significant relief for a differently-abled government employee, the Orissa High Court has directed the competent authorities to reconsider his grievance regarding his transfer following promotion and dispose of his representation in accordance with law within a stipulated time.The petitioner, Dhruva Charan Panigrahi, a differently-abled employee working under the Directorate of Economics and Statistics in Bhadrak district, challenged his transfer to Mayurbhanj following his promotion. As per the Directorate's office order No. 3629 dated June 29, 2017, he was promoted and simultaneously transferred from Bhadrak to Mayurbhanj.

Jewellery Trader Robbed at Gunpoint After Blank Firing

J A J P U R (Correspondent): Panic gripped the area after a jewellery trader was robbed at gunpoint near Ghantiali Bridge under Binjharpur Police Station limits. The miscreants allegedly fired a blank shot and fled with approximately 3 kg of silver, 20 grams of gold, and ₹7,000 in cash. On the day following the incident, Binjharpur Police intensified their search to apprehend the absconding accused. According to reports, Chandan Sahu,



son of Sharat Sahu, owner of Maa Tarini Jewellers at Mainda Chhak, was returning home at around 9:00 p.m. on Tuesday after closing the shop. Near Ghantiali Bridge, he was intercepted by three unidentified miscreants who arrived on a black Pulsar motorcycle. The accused attempted to snatch the bag containing jewellery. When

Chandan resisted, they fired a blank shot to intimidate him and escaped with 3 kg of silver, 20 grams of gold, and ₹7,000 in cash. On receiving information, Binjharpur Police reached the spot and seized the cartridge used in the firing. A case has been registered at the police station (Case No. 345/26), and an investigation has been initiated. On Wednesday morning, police began examining CCTV footage from various locations in the area to

identify the movement and escape route of the accused. Reliable sources said that two special police teams have been formed to trace and arrest the miscreants, and raids are being conducted at different locations. Meanwhile, a scientific team visited the crime scene and collected forensic evidence and other relevant materials. Police have reportedly intensified the investigation to ensure the early arrest of those involved in the robbery.

Rayagada Municipality Intensifies Sanitation Drive Ahead of Rath Yatra

Rayagada, (correspondent): With preparations in full swing for the annual Rath Yatra, the Rayagada Municipality on Tuesday launched a comprehensive cleanliness and sanitation drive across the town's Grand Road (Bada Danda) and adjoining areas to ensure a safe, hygienic and devotee-friendly environment during the festival. The drive was undertaken under the leadership of Municipality Chairperson P. Mahesh Patnaik as part of the "Safai Apnao, Bimari Bhagao" campaign.

Accused arrested in murder attempt and bike theft case

Gopalpur (correspondent): Nimkhandi police have solved a blind case within a few hours and arrested an accused. The arrest was made on charges of attempted murder by slitting throat and motorcycle robbery. Police sources said that on Tuesday, Sunita Nahak, wife of Ashok Nahak of Old Khajuria village under GosaniNuagaon police station, filed a written complaint. Based on the complaint, case number 225/2026 was registered at Nimkhandi police station. The case has been registered under Sections 126(2)/118(1)/18(2)/309(6)/109(1) of the Indian Penal Code. According to the complaint, on



Monday evening, a carpenter and farmer named Ashok Nahak was returning home on his motorcycle (registration no. OR-07-X-9302) near Phulta when an unknown person asked him for a lift. After giving

Ashok a lift, the person got on the bike and suddenly slit his throat with a knife and escaped with the bike. The seriously injured Ashok was immediately admitted to the MKCG Medical College and Hospital in Berhampur. The

Nimkhandi police team reached the spot and started investigation. The unknown accused was identified in coordination with the Srikakulam district police of Andhra Pradesh. The accused is Dharma @ Pappu Sahu of Berhampur Baidyanathpur police station area. Within a few hours of the case being registered, the police arrested the accused from Palasa and interrogated him. He confessed to the crime and helped in recovering the knife used in the murder attempt from the trunk of the bike. In the presence of witnesses, the knife along with Hero Honda Passion Pro motorcycle No. OR-07-X-9302 were recovered from the accused.

Training camp for field level staff for preparation of district census handbook

SUBARNAPUR --A two-day training camp for the preparation of district level census handbook for Census 2027 was organized by the Subarnapur district administration under the chairmanship of Additional District Magistrate (General) Anjalina Pradhan. Joint Director of the Directorate of Census Dr. Abhaya Narayan Nayak, District Coordinator Shivam Yayashwal and other resource persons provided training. Tehsildars, Revenue Inspectors (RIs), Revenue Observer, Additional Tehsildars, Additional Revenue Inspectors, Amins and executive officers of Notified Area Councils and Municipalities from various tehsils were provided training on the preparation of district census handbook. The program was organized in the presence of Additional District Magistrate (Revenue) Rajendra Majhi. Census Officer-in-Charge Satyabrata Sahu coordinated the training camp.

Bargarh administration concedes: fertiliser crisis diffused..

Baragada (correspondent):– A potential district-wide protest by farmers over concerns related to fertiliser shortages and black-market activities has been deferred after the District Agriculture Department assured that non-loanee farmers would receive government-rate fertilisers within the week. The emergency bilateral meeting, held today at the Ghens Dhanmandi area and attended by senior agriculture officials and leaders of the Shaheed Madho Singh Regional Farmers' Organisation, concluded with an agreement. After approximately 90 minutes of discussion, the administration consented to the farmers' primary request that all eligible farmers, regardless of whether they have taken loans from primary cooperative societies, be permitted to purchase fertiliser at the designated government prices.

The ongoing concerns have emerged as the Kharif sowing season progresses. Farmers have expressed concerns that, within primary cooperative societies, fertiliser distribution largely favours "loanee" farmers, potentially excluding non-loanee cultivators. Traders are reportedly taking

advantage of this situation by selling fertilisers at inflated prices and engaging in black-market trade and smuggling, fostering unrest across the district. In July 2025, the Sanjukta Krushak Sangathan, representing 15 farmer organisations across 12 blocks in Bargarh, had raised similar concerns about private dealers hoarding key granular fertilisers and pressuring farmers to buy nano-fertilisers as a precondition for accessing DAP. Additional reports of black-market sales at high rates also emerged in Bhatli block in August 2025. In response to these issues, the farmers' organisation

had indicated its readiness to shut down all cooperative societies in the district and to organise protests if fertiliser accessibility for non-loanee farmers at government prices was not ensured. The prospect of a broader agitation prompted an expedient response from the district administration. During today's meeting, officials assured the farmers that this week the societies would supply fertiliser at government rates to non-loanee farmers as well. They also emphasised that strict measures would be taken against traders involved in black-market activities and smuggling.
