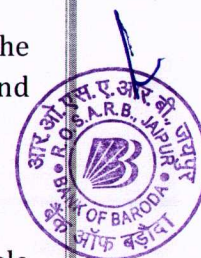

8. HAMSA, Aernnova sign MoU for India's indigenous 200-seat commercial aircraft programme

(Hyderabad, July 21 (FN Representative))

HAMSA Industries Pvt. Ltd. and Aernnova Engineering Division on Tuesday signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) to collaborate on the development of India's first indigenous 200-seat single-aisle commercial aircraft programme, marking the beginning of a long-term partnership to strengthen the country's aerospace capabilities. The agreement was announced at the Farnborough International Airshow. Under the collaboration, the two companies will jointly explore opportunities in aircraft structures engineering, structural architecture, manufacturing engineering and digital engineering to support the proposed commercial aircraft programme. Hyderabad based HAMSA Industries said in a release here. According to the companies, the

HAMSA programme aims not only to design, certify and manufacture a world-class commercial aircraft in India



but also to develop the engineering expertise, industrial partnerships, advanced manufacturing capabilities and aerospace supply chain required to build a sustainable domestic commercial aviation ecosystem. HAMSA Industries Managing Director Umesh Vankayalapati said the company's vision is to see an indigenous 200-seat commercial aircraft designed, certified and manufactured in India. He said achieving that objective requires

building a national aerospace ecosystem alongside aircraft development and described the partnership with Aernnova Engineering Division as an important first step in creating that capability. Aernnova Engineering Division Executive Vice President and Managing Director Juan Carlos Ortiz said the company looks forward to contributing its expertise in aircraft structures engineering to the ambitious programme and supporting the development of advanced aerospace capability in India. Daniel Hayes, Strategic Advisor to the HAMSA programme, said the initiative aims to build enduring national capability by combining international aerospace experience with India's engineering talent and industrial ambition to lay the foundation for designing,

certifying and manufacturing the country's next generation of commercial aircraft. The two organisations said they will now begin technical workshops and engineering studies to identify initial work packages and prepare a roadmap for future collaboration in support of the HAMSA commercial aircraft programme.
