WITH the India-UK Free Trade Agreement coming into effect, the first batch of home textile consignment worth ₹2 crore was flagged off to the UK from Karur at an event organised by the Karur Textile Manufacturer Exporters’ Association (KTMEA) on Wednesday. Additional Director General of Foreign Trade D Shridhar, Collector C Muthukumar, and office-bearers of the association were present.

Talking to reporters, Shridhar said the agreement is expected to double Karur’s home textile exports to the UK. “Karur is cur-

rently exporting home textiles worth about ₹800 crore to the UK every year. Only high-quality textiles are exported and the UK imports only products that meet its quality standards. India will gain an advantage over its competitors such as China, Pakistan and Bangladesh, whose textile exports to the UK continue to attract import duties,” he said.

The agreement will strengthen trade ties between the two countries, Shridhar added.

Association president P Gopalakrishnan said the UK’s import duty of 8 to 12% on Indian textiles have now been removed. “The ₹2 crore consign-

ment flagged off from Karur will be shipped through the Thoothukudi port. Textile products worth about ₹20 crore are expected to be exported to the UK within the next 15 days,” he said.

The agreement removes tariffs on 99% of Indian exports to the UK and 90% of UK exports to India, particularly benefiting the home textiles sector.

Muthukumaran said, “Steps will be taken to provide hostel facilities for workers employed in textile units that do not have accommodation. Skill development centres are already training workers.”

One stabbed, 7 assaulted in clash over temple fest

ONE person was stabbed and seven others were assaulted in a dispute between two groups over conducting a festival at an HR&CE temple near Manappalai on Tuesday.

According to police, violence occurred at Anaiyur in Vaigampatti union in connection with the Kulakkarai Muniyappasamy Temple, where relatives from Anaiyur, Karumagoundampatti, Kalathupatti and Sundakkampatti traditionally celebrate a festival once in three years.

The dispute centred around two groups led by P Boopathi (33) of Anaiyur; and M Subramani (45) of Kandakkampatti. According to police, the festival had earlier been stalled after Subramani allegedly attempted to perform customary rituals in June to fix the festival date without informing the other relatives, triggering a road

blockade residents of other villages.

On Tuesday, Boopathi’s group allegedly made fresh arrangements to perform the customary rituals, following which Subramani’s supporters attempted to prevent it, leading to a clash. Gautham (26) of Kandakkampatti sustained a stab injury. Over seven persons sustained injuries and were admitted to hospitals.

Tension rose following reports that youths from one group had been detained by residents of Sundakkampatti, prompting a road blockade near Kalathupatti. Another group of over 50 youths allegedly entered Sundakkampatti and threatened residents, creating panic. Superintendent of Police Dongre Pravin Umesh visited the spot and reviewed the situation.

Police have been deployed at eight locations across the four villages.
