

‘Ensure 100% distribution of SIR forms within stipulated time’

Chief Electoral Officer V Anbukumar reviews progress in Kalaburagi

KALABURAGI, DHNS

Karnataka Chief Electoral Officer V Anbukumar directed booth level officers (BLOs) to ensure 100% distribution of enumeration forms to voters.

Addressing a progress review meeting of Special Intensive Revision (SIR) here on Monday, he expressed satisfaction over the 97.64%

distribution of enumeration forms in the district. He also said that the distribution of remaining 56,021 forms should be completed within the next two days.

Stating that the collecting and digitisation of enumeration forms filled-in by the voters is a challenging task, Anbukumar said that the officials need to speed up the digitisation work without waiting until the last day of July 29.

Digitisation process

Out of the 2,400 BLOs in the district, 435 BLOs have not completed digitisation process of 0-10%. Out of these, 150 and 144 BLOs are from Kalaburagi South and Kalaburagi North assembly constituencies, re-

spectively. Applications will not be considered in the software for any reason after the stipulated period, he warned. Therefore, the work should be expedited by providing technical assistance to the BLOs. Honorarium of Rs 8,000 has been sanctioned to BLOs engaged in the SIR process, he explained.

Stating that the District Election Officers should convene a meeting of political parties every week regarding the SIR process, he said that the guidelines of Election Commission of India should be followed without giving room for complaints from the political parties.

District Election Officer Ikram Shariff said that enu-

meration forms have been distributed to 23,15,521 voters (97.64%) out of total 23,71,542 voters and 5,48,736 people have digitised their applications in the software, making a progress of 23.14% in the district.

He said that the digitisation work will be accelerated in the next 10 days and 100% mapping work will be completed within the time limit, he added.

Zilla Panchayat CEO Rahul Sankanur, Palike Commissioner Avinash Shinde, Additional DC Rayappa Hunasagi, Assistant Commissioners Sahitya Aaladakkatti, Prabhureddy, Probationary IAS Officer Shikhar Mogha and others were present.

Dry spell: Tanker water to rescue drying crops

Farmers adopting these measures as a last resort

Agriculture activities have taken a backseat throughout the taluk as dry spell continues even through the second week of July. Farmers who had sown soyabean, tur, black gram and green gram are staring at a bleak future, as there is no trace of rain. Besides, these crops are drying up and farmers are forced to purchase tanker water to save these crops.

These crops were sown during the last week of June and the first week of July. Yet, owing to failure of monsoon,

there is no moisture in the soil, leading to drying up of these crops. Farmers fear that these crops in thousands of acres in the taluk may be completely destroyed if it fails to rain in a few days.

Some of the farmers who have grown marigold flower, vegetables and sugar cane are watering the crops through borewells. Some of them are opting for drip irrigation facility and a few are even watering plants through water tankers. A few farmers are spraying urea and other fertiliser that is easily diluted in water. But its effect may be limited in case of

poor monsoon.

Santhosh Maskale, a farmer in Nagur (b) village had planted 10,000 marigold plants in his two-acre farm. He has spent over Rs 50,000 so far. But due to lack of rainfall, the plants are drying up. He has now decided to water the plants by purchasing water as a last resort to save his crop. "If it does not rain in

two days, it would be difficult to even purchase water," he said.

Other farmers in the taluk who have grown sugar cane in four acre too are facing water scarcity. "Water level in borewells too has gone down and there is no adequate power supply. We are struggling to save these crops," the farmers said here.

DC appeals farmers to grow less water-intensive crops

YADGIR, DHNS: In view of weak pre-monsoon and monsoon for 2026-27 in the district, Deputy Commissioner Rahul Pandve has urged the farmers to grow less water-intensive crops.

"Majority of reservoirs have less water availability and it would be difficult to supply water to crops, as meeting drinking water needs is the topmost priority. It is imperative to make

judicious use of water that's available in the reservoir," he said in a press release.

He also appealed to farmers not to depend on reservoir water for sowing, instead grow crops that require less water and also those that are short-term crops, as suggested by agriculture and horticulture department officials.

The government is closely monitoring water level in reservoirs, he added.
