Seven booked for drug consumption in J&K's Anantnag

SRINAGAR, June 16 (PTI)

SEVEN people have been booked in Anantnag district of Jammu and Kashmir for the consumption of banned drugs, police said on Tuesday.

In Bijbehara, police, in coordination with a medical team, conducted tests using a rapid drug detection kit, a police spokesperson said.

During the exercise, five people tested positive for drug consumption and separate cases were registered against them under the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (NDPS) Act, he said.

According to the spokesperson, Kokernag police station received reliable information about two persons found at separate locations under suspicious circumstances.

Both were apprehended and subjected to medical examination. Their test reports came back positive for drug consumption and they were booked under the NDPS Act, the police spokesperson said.

2 truck drivers burnt alive following vehicles' collision in Odisha

ROURKELA, June 16 (PTI)

TWO truck drivers were burnt alive after their vehicles caught fire following a head-on collision on the Biju Expressway in Odisha's Sundargarh district on Tuesday, police said.

The accident took place near Kaintara Chhak under Bhasma police station limits on the State highway-10.

Police said one 16-wheeler lorry, which was coming from Sundargarh jumped the road divider and hit another heavy vehicle moving on the parallel road. The collision caused an immediate fire, in which one of the drivers was burnt to ashes inside the vehicle itself, while another was rescued in half-charred condition. He too succumbed to burn injuries very soon, police said.

Personnel of the Bhasma police station and the fire services reached the spot and extinguished the blaze.

The identities of the deceased drivers have not been established so far. Police have begun an investigation to ascertain the exact cause of the accident, it said.

Railway guard raises alarm over overheated wheel; prevents accident

NEW DELHI, June 16 (PTI)

A FREIGHT train guard prevented a major accident in Bihar by raising an alarm about smoke emanating from an overheated wheel of another passing goods train after both the concerned station and track-side detector failed to detect the fault.

The incident occurred at 2.40 pm on June 13 when train manager Rakesh Kumar, while overseeing operations of his empty freight train heading towards Sasaram (in the Howrah direction) from Deen Dayal Upadhyay Junction, noticed thick smoke coming from the wheels of another freight train operating in the opposite direction on the Dedicated Freight Corridor (DFC).

The DFC and the Indian Railways network run parallel to each other in the area. Kumar was operating his train on the IR network, while the train with the defective wheel was running on the DFC network.

SC seeks responses on plea for use of Aadhaar only as ID proof

NEW DELHI, June 16 (PTI)

THE Supreme Court on Tuesday sought response of the Centre and States on a plea alleging misuse of the Unique Identification Authority of India-issued Aadhaar cards as proof of citizenship, domicile and residential address, and seeking directions to restrict its use strictly for identity verification.

A bench of Chief Justice Surya Kant and Justice V Mohana issued notices to the Centre and all the States and UTs on a plea filed by advocate Ashwini Kumar Upadhyay and tagged it with the pending similar matters.

The plea has sought directions to the Centre, States and the Election Commission to ensure that Aadhaar is used as a proof of identity and not as a proof of citizenship, domicile, address and date of birth.

The plea, filed through advocate Ashwani Dubey, also sought direc-



tions that the use of Aadhaar as a proof of date of birth and residence in the application form for new voter registration be considered against Section 9 of the Aadhaar Act, 2016, Section 23(4) of the RPA, 1950 and Article 14 of the Constitution.

“Section 9 of the Aadhaar Act, 2016 expressly states that ‘Aadhaar is not the evidence of citizenship or domicile’.

The Unique Identification Authority of India notification dated August 22, 2023 clearly states that ‘Aadhaar is proof of identity, not of citizenship, address or date of birth’...

“Despite this, Aadhaar is not only being used as a proof of age, citizenship and domicile for school admission, property purchase and to obtain a birth certificate, ration card, driving licence but also being used in the application form for new voter registration (Form-6) as a proof of date of birth and proof of residence. And thus, infiltrators and illegal immigrants are obtaining various documents using Aadhaar,” the plea said.

The petition contended that the existing verification mechanism under Form-6 is inadequate and might allow individuals without proper supporting documents to be included in the electoral database. The plea sought a comprehensive overhaul of the verification framework used in electoral processes and proposed the establishment of a high-powered monitoring committee to oversee reforms.

Tirumala temple body inks pact with CSIR-CFTRI to upgrade food quality

TIRUPATI, June 16 (PTI)

THE TTD has signed an agreement with the CSIR-CFTRI, Mysuru, to bring scientific rigour into its food systems, ensuring that all offerings and *prasadam*s meet the highest standards.

The agreement will preserve the traditional character of TTD's food and *prasadam*s while adhering to the highest standards of safety, nutrition and quality, a press release said on Monday.

“With the noble aim of ensuring that all food and sacred *prasadam*s of Srivaru (the deity), prepared and distributed by TTD, adhere to the highest standards of safety, nutrition and quality while preserving their traditional character, TTD has signed an MoU with CSIR-Central Food Technological Research Institute,

Mysuru, to integrate scientific methods into its food systems,” it said. The partnership focuses on strengthening safety and quality controls, modernising systems, preserving the traditional character of *prasadam*, building capacity, and engaging experts.

As part of strengthening safety and quality controls, joint teams will develop and implement strict quality-control standards, SOPs and monitoring systems for procurement, preparation and distribution.

Under modernisation of systems, CSIR-CFTRI will advise on upgrading storage, testing and procurement processes, recommending scientifically validated technologies and best-practice workflows to minimise contamination risk and improve consistency.

ED raids premises of 2 accused in Rs 500 crore crypto scam

SHIMLA, June 16 (IANS)

IN FRESH action in a Rs 500 crore Crypto Currency Scam, the ED recovered incriminating documents and digital devices during search operations at the premises of two co-accused, an official said on Monday.

The Enforcement Directorate (ED), Shimla Office, conducted search operations at the premises of Vijay Juneja and Masoom Juneja, already under arrest, under Section 17(1) of PMLA, 2002, on Monday, the ED said in a statement. The two were associated with key accused Subhash Sharma, who has reportedly fled to Dubai, and indulged in collecting funds from nearly 2.4 lakh duped investors, the ED said.

The ED initiated an investigation based on FIRs registered by the Himachal Pradesh and Punjab Police against Subhash Sharma and others.

Investigation revealed that in 2018, Sharma, in connivance with co-accused, including Hem Raj,

Sukhdev Thakur, Abhishek Sharma and Radhika Sharma, launched a cryptocurrency-based MLM scheme through an online platform to enable controlled operations and large-scale investor enrolment, the ED said. The platform was later shifted to foreign servers (Digital Ocean) and operated through domains such as korvio.io and voscrow.com to run the scheme, the statement said.

The accused induced public investment in “Korvio Coin (KRO)” by promising assured high returns, conducting misleading seminars, manipulating token values, and introducing new tokens to sustain a Ponzi structure, wherein funds from new investors were used to pay earlier investors, it said.

SJM writes to US envoy over Indian seafarers' killing, seeks probe

NEW DELHI, June 16 (PTI)

RSS-affiliate Swadeshi Jagaran Manch (SJM) has written to the US Ambassador protesting the killing of three Indian seafarers in separate incidents between June 8 and June 11 in US attacks.

The outfit has demanded a transparent investigation and compensation for the victims' families.

In a letter addressed to US Ambassador Sergio Gor on Monday, the RSS affiliate expressed “deep pain and anguish” over the alleged unprovoked killing of three unarmed Indian seafarers by US Armed Forces. “These incidents have sent a wave of disbelief and anger among the people of India. The US administration added insult to injury by an insensitive and irresponsible response, hurting Indian sentiments further, as Indians have always considered the US to be a great friend,” SJM national co-convenor Ashwani Mahajan said in the letter.

The organisation demanded a transparent, time-bound and impartial investigation into the incidents and sought accountability for those responsible, whether individuals or state actors.

It also called for compensation and justice for the victims' families, assurances against any recurrence and adherence to international legal obligations.

“India's anguish is deep and its resolve is firm: Those responsible must be held accountable, and the dignity and safety of Indian seafarers must be upheld at all costs,” Mahajan said.

India's rise should bring peace, prosperity to world, says Bhagwat

NEW DELHI, June 16 (PTI)

RSS chief Mohan Bhagwat on Monday said India's emergence as a “Vishwaguru” should be guided by its civilisational values and aimed at bringing peace and prosperity to the world. He also stressed the dignity of labour, equitable distribution of prosperity, ethical wealth creation and the role of the younger generation in nation-building.

Delivering the keynote address at the 18th BML Munjal Awards organised by Hero Enterprise here, Bhagwat said Bharat is not

merely a geographical entity but an enduring civilisation that has survived invasions, foreign rule and historical upheavals.
