NEW DELHI: Chief of Defence Staff Gen Anil Chauhan on Monday visited strategically important military bases of Suratgarh in Rajasthan and Naliya and commended the troops for maintaining high state of operational readiness. The Pakistani military attempted to target both the bases during the military confrontation between the two sides recently. In his interaction with the troops, Gen Chauhan also complimented the synergy among the three services during Operation Sindoor.

The Chief of Defence Staff (CDS) emphasised on the need to remain ever prepared for responding to any challenge with "decisive force", according to the defence ministry.

"To boost the morale of the armed forces, Chief of Defence Staff Gen Anil Chauhan paid a visit to the strategically important Suratgarh military station and Naliya air force station today," it said. Gen Chauhan also emphasised the importance of operational readiness and resilience in the face of evolving security challenges, it said.
