

MONSOON FURY | Gangapur Dam nearly 98% full; Godavari over danger mark

Heavy rain disrupts life

Heavy rainfall that began on Wednesday night continued to lash Nashik district through Thursday, severely disrupting normal life across both urban and rural areas. By 5.30pm on Thursday, the district had recorded an average rainfall of 135 mm over the previous 24 hours. Continuous downpours accompanied by strong winds led to widespread waterlogging in several low-lying parts of Nashik city, uprooted trees, damaged houses and disrupted traffic and power supply. Gangapur Dam, the city's primary source of drinking water, has now reached nearly 98 per cent of its storage capacity. Authorities reported that 51 trees were uprooted and five houses were damaged, while floodwaters from the Godavari River entered the Bhande Bazaar area, causing hardship to traders and residents. Rainfall eased on Friday morning, bringing temporary relief after two days of relentless showers.

Trimbakeshwar taluka recorded the highest rainfall in the district at 193.3 mm, followed by Surgana (164.5 mm), Nashik (73.4 mm), Peth (66.5 mm), Igatpuri (56.8 mm), Dindori (53.7 mm), Kalwan (50.7 mm), Baglan (43.1 mm), Niphad (39.9 mm), Deola (38.7 mm), Chandwad (28.3 mm), Sinnar (25.1 mm), Malegaon (13.2 mm), Yeola (10.7 mm) and Nandgaon (4.4 mm).



Strong winds, with speeds touching 50 kmph in some areas, uprooted dozens of trees across Nashik city. Several electricity poles also collapsed, damaging residential properties and disrupting power supply in a number of localities. Industrial estates witnessed prolonged outages, affecting manufacturing activities and bringing production to a halt in several units.

Heavy rainfall in the upper catchment areas triggered a sharp rise in inflows into Gangapur Dam, prompting the Water Resources Department to gradually increase water discharge from the reservoir. As a result, the Godavari River rose above the danger mark for the first time this monsoon, bringing the season's first flood to Nashik. Authorities have advised residents living along the riverbanks to remain vigilant as

The inflows into Gangapur Dam have been further sup-

ported by rising water levels in other reservoirs. Kashyapi Dam has reached 71 per cent of its storage capacity, while Gautami Godavari Dam is nearly 90 per cent full, indicating healthy water reserves across the district.

Continuous rainfall over the past two days also led to substantial inflows into the Nandur Madhmeshwar Dam, forcing authorities to release 55,775 cusecs of water into the Godavari River towards the Jayakwadi reservoir. The increased discharge inundated areas along the river and submerged the bridge on the Niphad-Sinnar State Highway. Traffic on the route has remained completely suspended since 8am on Thursday, and officials said the road would remain closed until floodwaters recede and the bridge becomes safe for movement.

The heavy rainfall also affected daily life in several parts of the district.

Waterlogging was reported from low-lying localities, traffic moved at a crawl on several major roads, and commuters faced long delays. Rivers and streams across the district continued to flow above normal levels, while disaster management teams remained on high alert to respond to emergencies.

Agricultural weather experts have advised farmers to plan agricultural operations according to weather forecasts. They have urged cultivators to ensure proper drainage in waterlogged fields, shift agricultural produce, machinery and equipment to safer locations, and avoid working in farms during thunderstorms and lightning.

District Collector Ayush Prasad said the district administration has activated its Emergency Disaster Management Cell to deal with any untoward situation arising from the heavy rains. He appealed to citizens to stay

away from riverbanks, overflowing streams and other vulnerable locations, and to cooperate with the administration by following official advisories. He also assured that government hospitals have been stocked with adequate medicines, emergency supplies and essential equipment to deal with any rain-related emergencies.

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Despite heavy rainfall across Nashik district over the past three days, the situation has remained under control due to timely administrative action, effective coordination among various government agencies, and strong public cooperation. No loss of life or any major emergency has been reported, District Collector Ayush Prasad said.

Addressing a press conference at the Collector's Office, Prasad said that although the intensity of rainfall has reduced and the India Meteorological Department (IMD) has issued a Green Alert for the district, the potential risk has not completely subsided. He urged citizens to remain cautious and strictly follow official advisories.
