Rupee gains 16 paise to 95.66 vs USD

MUMBAI, July 29 (PTI)

The rupee rose 16 paise to 95.66 (provisional) against the US dollar on Wednesday, extending its gaining streak for the fourth straight session, amid hectic buying in domestic equity markets and lower global crude prices.

Foreign capital inflows and a weak American currency ahead of the US Federal Reserve's interest rate decisions also supported the local unit, forex traders said. At the inter-bank foreign exchange, the rupee opened at 95.70 and touched the intraday low of 95.80 against the greenback. The unit hit the day's high of 95.48 before ending the session at 95.66 (provisional) against the dollar, up 16 paise from its previous close.

Gold steady at Rs 1.47 lakh/10g

GOLD prices remained flat at Rs 1.47 lakh per 10 grams in the national capital on Wednesday, while silver made a modest recovery by Rs 500 to Rs 2.25 lakh per kg amid firm trends in the international markets.

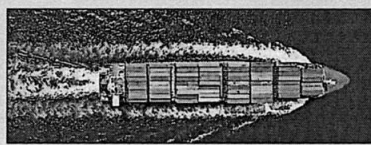
According to the All India Sarafa Association, the yellow metal of 99.9 per cent purity remained unchanged at Rs 1,47,000 per 10 grams.

PM Modi-led FTA strategy opens access to \$60 trillion markets: Piyush Goyal

NEW DELHI, July 29 (IANS)

INDIA'S recent Free Trade Agreements (FTAs) with major economies are opening access to markets worth nearly \$60 trillion and supporting the country's push to become a global export hub, Union Commerce and Industry Minister Piyush Goyal said on Wednesday, crediting Prime Minister Narendra Modi's leadership for the trade expansion strategy.

A video shared by the minister on social media platform X highlighted that the FTAs negotiated under PM Modi's leadership were aimed at expanding market opportunities for Indian



exporters, boosting manufacturing and creating jobs.

"Here's why India is signing multiple Free Trade Agreements with major economies," Goyal said in the post, adding that the agreements were providing access to some of the world's largest markets.

India's exports have grown by

73 per cent over the last five years, with FTAs helping sectors such as textiles, gems and jewellery, engineering goods and pharmaceuticals gain access through lower or zero-duty benefits, the video showed.

It further noted that the trade agreements also safeguard sensitive sectors, including dairy

and agriculture, while creating opportunities for investment inflows. These FTAs are also bringing billions of dollars in investment, boosting manufacturing, creating jobs, and helping Indian businesses enter global value chains.

India has been actively pursuing trade pacts with key economies to enhance market for domestic exporters and integrate Indian businesses with global supply chains.

The Govt has been highlighting FTAs as a key component of its strategy to strengthen exports, attract foreign investment and expand India's manufacturing capabilities.

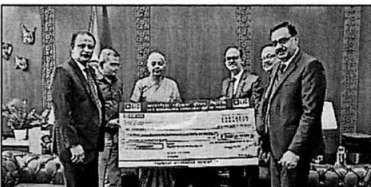
FM Nirmala receives dividend cheque of Rs 12,207 cr from LIC

According to an X post by Finance Minister, Public Sector Banks (PSBs) witnessed a significant improvement in asset qual-

ity during FY 2025-26, with Gross Non-Performing Assets (GNPA) declining to a record low of 1.9 per cent and combined net profit reaching an all-time high of Rs 1.98 lakh crore.

The net profit of public sector

banks recorded a robust 11.1 per cent increase in FY 2025-26, marking the fourth straight year of profitability as reforms and strengthened Governance practices have reinforced healthier balance sheets, enhanced operational resilience, and strong capital adequacy.

Improved asset quality, healthy credit expansion and higher income contributed to improved profitability of PSBs during FY 2025-26, an earlier Finance Ministry statement said.

The aggregate business of public sector banks (PSBs) increased to Rs 283.3 lakh crore as on March 31, 2026, registering a growth of 12.8 per cent over the previous year, it said.

Govt-backed EDF mobilises Rs 1,335.77 crore for 128 startups, companies

NEW DELHI, July 29 (IANS)

THE Government's Electronics Development Fund (EDF) has helped channel investments worth Rs 1,335.77 crore into 128 startups and companies engaged in Electronics System Design and Manufacturing (ESDM) and Information Technology (IT), according to an official statement on Wednesday.

The Electronics Development Fund set up by the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY).

As a Fund of Funds has invested Rs 257.77 crore in eight SEBI-registered venture capital funds, known as 'daughter funds', as of June 30.

These Daughter Funds have, in turn, invested Rs 1,335.77 crore

in 128 startups and companies to support innovation, indigenous technology development and intellectual property (IP) creation in the electronics and IT sectors.

According to the Government, the selection of startups for investment was based on factors such as innovation capability, indigenous technology development, IP creation potential, technical expertise of the founding team and the scalability of the business model.

Canbank Venture Capital Funds Ltd. (CVCF) serves as the fund manager for the EDF, while MeitY is the anchor investor.

Of the 128 companies supported, 77 operate in the ESDM sector and 51 in the IT sector.

BPCL expects Rs 633 crore monthly compensation for under-recoveries on LPG sales

NEW DELHI, July 29 (IANS)

BHARAT Petroleum Corporation Ltd. (BPCL) is in talks with the Central Government regarding compensation for its under-recoveries on the sale of domestic LPG (Liquefied Petroleum Gas) below the market prices amid the West Asia crisis, with the firm expecting a compensation of Rs 633 crore per month till October, according to an NDTV Profit report that cited a company statement on Tuesday.

The oil and gas company stat-

ed that it was confident of Government backing regarding LPG losses, due to the fact that the firm has been selling its domestic LPG, petrol, and diesel below the market prices.

This development comes amid the ongoing conflict between Iran and the US in West Asia, which led to a choking of the Strait of Hormuz, through which 20 per cent of the world's oil and gas exports transit during normal times.

This had led to a spike in global crude and gas prices.

UPI now accepted for online bookings at Burj Khalifa

NEW DELHI, July 29 (IANS)

INDIAN travellers can now use the Unified Payments Interface (UPI) to make online bookings for the Top Burj Khalifa, with the iconic attraction becoming the first in the UAE to accept the payment system for e-commerce transactions, NPCI International Payments Limited (NIPPL) said on Wednesday.

The international arm of the National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI) said the launch of the facility is in partnership with NEOPAY and Emaar Entertainment.

The move enables Indian visitors to book tickets and experiences at the world's tallest building through the attraction's official website using UPI-enabled payment apps before travelling to the UAE. The latest integration builds on NIPPL's existing

partnership with NEOPAY.

Since the introduction of QR code-based UPI merchant payments in the UAE in 2022, Indian travellers have been able to use UPI for payments at merchants across NEOPAY's network.

With the new rollout, UPI acceptance has now been extended to online bookings.

Indian travellers are increasingly seeking payment experiences that are simple and seamless when they travel abroad.

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India posts record smartphone exports of nearly \$10 bn in Q1

NEW DELHI, July 29 (IANS)

INDIA'S smartphone exports touched a record high of nearly \$10 billion in the first quarter of FY27, driven by Apple iPhone shipments, according to the latest data.

Smartphone exports by value rose 23.4 per cent to \$9.84 billion during April-June, compared to \$7.97 billion in the corresponding period of the previous fiscal.

Moreover, the US remained by far the largest market for India's smartphone exports during the quarter which showed strong demand for India-manufactured devices.

However, the performance also boosted the country's overall electronics exports, with smartphones accounting for 64.8 per cent of total electronics goods exports of \$15.2 billion during the April-June period. The latest figures came after the strong momentum witnessed in

recent years.

According to a report, shipments of 'Made in India' smartphones grew 8 per cent in 2025, driven by a 28 per cent jump in exports, while exports accounted for nearly one-third of all smartphones manufactured in the country.

Apple's manufacturing partners have remained the biggest drivers of this growth. Foxconn Hon Hai recorded a 48 per cent year-on-year increase in exports in 2025 on the back of strong iPhone shipments. Samsung also increased its export contribution, registering 4 per cent growth.

Earlier this year, India's iPhone exports reached a record \$3.8 billion in FY26, making Apple the country's single largest branded export across all product categories.

Overall smartphone exports from India stood at around Rs 2.6 trillion (\$29.4 billion) during the fiscal.
