Recruiting physically disabled persons as lift operators will help them have a financial independence, he noted.

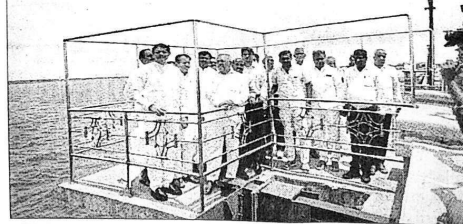
Ramalinga Reddy visits Almatti and Basavasagar reservoirs

HUNASAGI, DHNS

Water Resources Minister Ramalinga Reddy on Tuesday said that it would be difficult to release water for irrigation from the Lal Bahadur Shastri reservoir at Almatti and the Basavasagar reservoir at Narayanpur owing to current water availability.

He was speaking to media persons on Tuesday, after inspecting the Basavasagar reservoir and the Budihal-Peerapur lift irrigation project in Hunasagi taluk.

Ramalinga Reddy said that, excluding the dead storage, the Almatti and Narayanpur reservoirs together currently hold 86 tmc ft of water. "Of this, around 70 tmc ft has been earmarked to ensure continued drinking water supply for all villages and towns that are currently dependent on

these reservoirs. Filling tanks to meet drinking water needs will remain the top priority," he added.

He added that after meeting drinking water requirements, priority would be given to power generation units, including the Raichur Thermal Power Station (RTPS). "Only about 10 tmc ft of water would then remain which is insufficient to support agricultural needs," the minister observed. However, as the rainfall continues in the ghat regions of Maharashtra, everyday nearly 4 tmc ft inflow is registered.

"If the rainfall continues and the reservoirs receive adequate

inflow, water for irrigation would be considered, only if there is sufficient storage," he said.

He reiterated chief minister's appeal not to depend on reservoir water for irrigation as there is drought-like situation.

With regard to alleged encroachment of thousands of acres of land belonging to the corporation in Yadgir district, the minister said protecting the corporation's assets would be a priority.

On incomplete Nandawad Lift Irrigation Project, the minister assured that the issue would be discussed at the next board meeting.
