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## SC restrains police releasing digital data

### Centre Denies Police Excesses Against Students

It came after senior advocates Gopal Santhanarayanan, Shyam Divan, Shobh Alam and Shadan Parsat sought a fair, impartial and independent pan-India probe by an SIT headed by a retired CJI into alleged police excesses against student protesters. The bench in its interim order directed police in all states to ensure that no personal data collected by them using various devices, including facial recognition devices, are not disclosed in public domain till further orders.

On release of under-18-year-olds, the bench said they should be released on execution of a simple personal bond or a bond by their family members, if authorities insist on such a surety requirement. The petitioners demanded a retired CJI head the SIT to render credence to impar-

tiality and fairness of investigations. The bench asked Delhi Police, Centre and states to file their responses by Monday to PILs and bring on record their version of violent incidents and supporting evidence to facilitate passing of appropriate orders on the nature of investigation to be carried out.

Solicitor general Tushar Mehta supported impartial probe into incidents of violence while denying police excesses against students. He said 280 police personnel also suffered injuries. "Govt does not believe that students had indulged in violence against police or vandalised public property. Subject to inquiry, I don't think students have done it. Some criminals and miscreants entered protest and caused this. Delhi Police has certain data on this and would file it before the court," he said.

Justice Bagchi said there is a large number of miscreants and criminal elements infiltrating a peaceful agitation to discredit it. For family members of police personnel, senior advocate Sidharth Potaraju said the men in

uniform also need a fair investigation into incidents of violence unleashed against them in a planned manner.

Mehta said, "Students who were protesting peacefully must not be harassed as a result of miscreants and criminals, who indulged in wanton violence, must be brought to book. We will place all the evidence before the court in two or three days and then abide by whatever decision the court takes on it," he said.

Petitioners complained that police had collected massive amount of digital data on protesters from CCTV cameras, body cameras, hand-held cameras, drone cameras and facial recognition devices. Portraits of protesters are being released in public domain, violating privacy of the individuals and endangering their safety, they said.

The CJI-led bench restrained police from releasing these data. "Police authorities shall ensure that the personal information and digital data of protesters, collected during the students' protests, are preserved and are not disclosed to the public domain for the time being," it ordered.

### People Lost ₹3Kcr Through Scams, CBI Tells SC

Justice Bagchi said that coming up with a law designed to deal with digital scams is a job that govt alone can do. "We now have deep-fakes which can be used for misleading people or can be used for cheating and impersonation. Using our (exclusive) powers under Article 142 of the Constitution, we can neither define a crime nor create a new offence," he said.

Solicitor General Mehta told the bench that he has been consulted on this issue by govt and it is likely to intro-

duce a relevant bill in the current session of Parliament. Venkataratnam said he because of a coordinated action facilitated by the inter-departmental committee, incidents of digital arrest have become a rampant phenomenon. The investigating agency told the court that people were defrauded of Rs 3,000 crore through digital scams.

AG informed the court that CBI is investigating 20-odd major digital arrest scam cases involving loss of Rs 10 crore or more, and that rest of such cases are being investigated by state police.

With amicus curiae and senior advocate V S Nappinai and AG seeking several directions from the court, SC postponed the matter for further hearing on Wednesday.

### 'Will fully cure this disease of paper leak'

Speaking on the Public Examination (Prevention of Unfair Means) Amendment Bill as the debate began a little after 2 pm, Union minister Jitendra Singh said the "malaise" of paper leaks had affected state-level and national exams irrespective of the place in office, and lauded the proposed law as a reaffirmation of govt's commitment to safeguard students' welfare.

"Govt's intentions are honest and the amendment has been brought with an honest attitude. No member of any party should have any objection to it and if they have, then people will have objections to their demand," he said.

BJP MP Anurag Thakur said paper leak was no less a danger than terrorism and Maoism, and targeted the youth first like the two security threats. "I want to tell the youth of the country that we will fully cure this disease of paper leak because the Modi govt has given us medicine for all diseases so far," he said.

## Students end protest after written assurance on basic necessities

The protesters demanded immediate action from the college administration. Some of the students' all carried portraits of Dr Bhimrao Ambedkar. Despite the sultry weather, the students remained stationed at the protest site.

The agitation soon caught the attention of the district administration, prompting education officials to step in and address the students' concerns. The protest ended after the students secured written assurances from the authorities to fulfill most of their demands.

District inspector of schools, Rakesh Kumar, said, "We have accepted all the demands of the students, barring the one for opening a stream. So far, fans will be installed in every classroom (the school has 17 of them), while faulty electrical wiring will be repaired and concealed. Desks and benches will be provided within a month, and an RO water purifier and water cooler will also be installed."

The administration has also assured the students that the quality and distribution of midday meals will be monitored properly.

On the demand to introduce a science stream, District inspector of schools, Rakesh Kumar said, "The school will first have to obtain recognition from the Uttar Pradesh Board and develop the required infrastructure, including the laboratories and other facilities, in accordance with the prescribed norms. Only after these requirements are met can the science stream be introduced."
