Indian woman shot dead

A 26-year-old Indian-origin woman was shot dead in a suspected targeted attack in Canada's Toronto city, police said. A 37-year-old man, also of Indian descent, was arrested on charges of her murder, they said.

The shooting took place on Friday morning at the Humberwood Boulevard and Rexdale Boulevard intersection, the Toronto Police Service said in a statement on Saturday.

The victim was identified as Navneet Kaur, while the accused, arrested by the Ontario Provincial Police, was identified as Sharnjeet Singh of Brampton.

One killed in violence

One person was killed and several others, including security personnel, were injured in a communal clash in Nepal's Sunsari district, bordering India, prompting authorities to impose indefinite restrictive orders in parts of the area from Monday.

According to the District Administration Office, Sunsari, the prohibitory orders took effect from 7:00 am and cover five market areas in the district, located in the Koshi province. The restrictions will remain in force until further notice.

US-Iran tensions ease as mediators push for talks

Mediators have achieved progress in efforts to get the United States and Iran back to negotiations and avert an all-out war in the West Asia, two regional officials said on Monday, with a pause in attacks coming after a period of rapidly escalating tensions.

The comments came after neither the US nor Iran reported carrying out any attacks for three straight days — a respite after about two weeks of sustained bombardments that had led to increasing fears of a return to all-out war.

The two regional officials, who spoke on condition of anonymity to discuss the sensitive regional talks, said mediators led by Qatar and Pakistan were working to bridge the gap between



Washington and Tehran to return to an interim ceasefire deal that had been largely undermined by recent exchanges of fire.

The US has paused attacks after targeting Iranian coastal areas and infrastructure in a nearly two-week escalation sparked by Iran's firing at ships trying to transit the Strait of Hormuz, a crucial water-

way for global oil shipments. The Pentagon did not respond to questions. US President Donald Trump is "giving talks some space. He's giving it a little bit of room," Mike Waltz, the US ambassador to the United Nations, told *Fox News*.

"We've had both Oman and Iran, and a number of our other negotiators, engaged at every level, from the most senior levels all the way down to the technical level over the past few weeks, and particularly in the past few days."

Waltz dismissed the idea that the US stockpile of interceptors crucial in defending against Iranian attacks is running low, but experts have questioned how long both the US and Iran can afford to keep up attacks.

Since the US has halted attacks for the past two nights, Iran has as well, its army spokesperson told

Iran's state TV on Sunday. Tehran in recent days has counterattacked against countries in the region hosting US military forces, killing at least three service members at a base in Jordan and one in Iraq.

One of the regional officials who spoke to AP Monday described the progress made in mediation efforts as "significant".

He said mediators were working with Iran and Oman on a mechanism for managing vessels' transit through the Strait of Hormuz, which was the trigger for the latest round of strikes and counterstrikes between Iran and the US. Iran's Foreign Ministry spokesperson, Esmail Baghaei, said during a news conference in Tehran Monday that mediators were conveying messages but that no direct negotiations were being held with the US. Bangladesh: Charges filed against Hasina, 40 others in crimes against humanity case

Bangladesh's International Crimes Tribunal (ICT) prosecution on Monday filed formal charges against deposed prime minister Sheikh Hasina and 40 others in a crimes against humanity case related to a police crackdown on a rally in Dhaka in 2013.

Several people were killed allegedly during police action on Islamist group Hefazat-e-Islam's protest rally in May 2013, when Hasina's Awami League was in power.

The charges were submitted to the registrar of the ICT on Monday.

The tribunal "has taken into contingency charges against her (Hasina) and 40 others over the killings at (capital's) Shapla Chattar



during the Hefazat-e-Islam protest rally," chief prosecutor Aminul Islam told reporters. The tribunal also issued arrest warrants for the fugitives, including the then army chief, other politicians and security officials.

Nine of the high-profile accused, including former ministers, senior police offi-

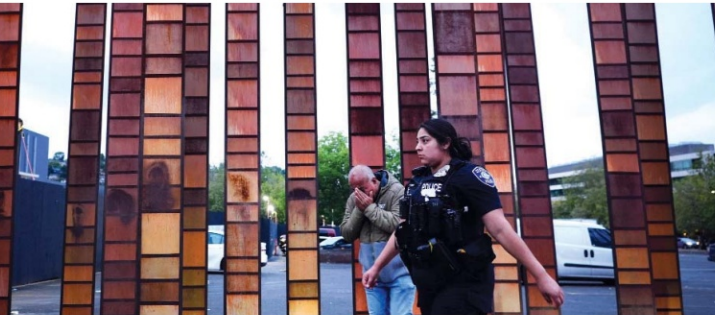
US police hunt second suspect in mass shooting

Police searched for a second suspect Monday after gunfire erupted at a crowded food festival beneath Seattle's Space Needle, leaving three people dead and four others wounded, including a toddler. Another suspect was earlier arrested.

Investigators believe the two suspects were shooting at each other Sunday and, although one remained on the loose, Assistant Seattle Police Chief Tyrone Davis told a news conference Sunday night that there was no ongoing threat to the public. Police did not have a description of the out-standing suspect, he said.

"We're still trying to figure this out," Davis said. Police did not immediately respond to phone and email messages early Monday. Two people

died at the scene and a third died at a hospital. They were described as two men, ages 19 and 44, and a 56-year-old woman.

The four wounded, including a 2-year-old boy, were hospitalised and in stable condition early Monday, police said. The rest of the wounded were adults. Davis couldn't say if any of the victims were involved in the confrontation.

The gunfire erupted around 6 pm. Sunday in the waning hours of the Bite of Seattle, an annual three-day festival that draws hundreds of food and retail vendors and performers.

Dozens of officers were providing security at the event and some saw one of the suspects firing, Davis said. One suspect surrendered at the scene, but the other fled. Law enforcement searched the grounds to no avail.
