

Bid to promote natural farming in TG

The Society for Elimination of Rural Poverty, in collaboration with the Agriculture Department, will soon establish 326 Bio-Input Resource Centres (BRCs) across Telangana under the National Mission on Natural Farming to strengthen the adoption of natural farming practices in the State.

As part of the initiative, the National Institute of Plant Health Management, Hyderabad, partnered with SERP to build capacity for setting up the centres and recently conducted training programmes for 56 district-level officials and 318 women entrepreneurs in 10 batches. The trainees were also provided with the equipment and infrastructure.

Rain toll rises to 18 in Kerala; over 13,000 in relief camps across State

THIRUVANANTHAPURAM

Heavy showers continued to batter parts of Kerala for the third consecutive day on Monday, taking the death toll to 18, despite a considerable reduction in the intensity of rain.

Chief Minister V.D. Satheesan, who chaired an emergency meeting on Monday morning to review the flood situation, said the situation in most districts was now under control following a decline in rainfall. However, 18 people have lost their lives in rain-related incidents, while three others remain missing, according to official figures.

A total of 13,496 people are currently sheltering in 363 relief camps across the State.

Addressing a press conference after a review meeting, the Chief Minister said teams of the Fire and

Rescue Services and the National Disaster Response Force (NDRF) had been deployed in the worst-affected areas, including Pathanamthitta and Kottayam, to carry out rescue operations.

Preparations have been completed to air-drop food packets to people stranded in isolated areas. Mr. Satheesan urged residents in vulnerable locations to relocate immediately as instructed by authorities.

The government has announced a total compensation of ₹8 lakh for families of the deceased, with an immediate assistance of ₹10,000 to meet funeral expenses. Families returning from relief camps will be provided ₹10,000 to clean their houses. For a ration card-holding family that lost its livelihood, ₹300 each will be provided to two members until normalcy returns. As part of the rehabilitation package,

assistance for purchasing land and constructing a house has been increased from ₹10 lakh to ₹12 lakh, while compensation for those who have lost their houses has been raised from ₹4 lakh to ₹6 lakh.

Mr. Satheesan said the flooding was triggered by extremely heavy rainfall, with some places recording over 350 mm of rain. He clarified that no major dams had been opened because of the heavy rainfall. Only smaller dams with comparatively lower storage capacity, such as Moozhaiyur, had released water. The India Meteorological department (IMD) issued an orange alert for 12 districts for Tuesday.

Head constable suspended for neglecting Dial-100 call

A head constable attached to Raidurgam police station in Cyberabad has been suspended for allegedly neglecting an emergency Dial-100 complaint related to a road accident near IKEA in Gachibowli here.

Cyberabad Police Commissioner M. Ramesh suspended head constable Syed Younus following an inquiry into the incident that occurred around last Saturday midnight.

According to officials, two cars collided near

IKEA and one of the victims contacted Dial-100 twice, seeking police assistance. However, the head constable, on duty at the time, allegedly did not visit the accident spot and closed both complaints by marking them as "caller nuisance".

The matter was brought to the notice of the Commissioner, who ordered immediate suspension of the head constable for negligence in duty. The suspension will remain in force until the completion of a departmental inquiry, officials said.

Swift police response saves man's life

Swift response from a head constable attached to the Chandur police station in Nalgonda district helped save a man's life following a call to Dial 100 about a domestic dispute.

According to police sources, head constable Adimulam Srinivas received information about a quarrel between a couple

in Udatalappalli village and rushed to the spot, reaching the house within five minutes.

On entering the house, the head constable found the man in a life-threatening situation.

Recognising the urgency, Srinivas forced open the door, rescued the victim, administered first aid, including CPR, and arranged for his immediate transport to a hospital,

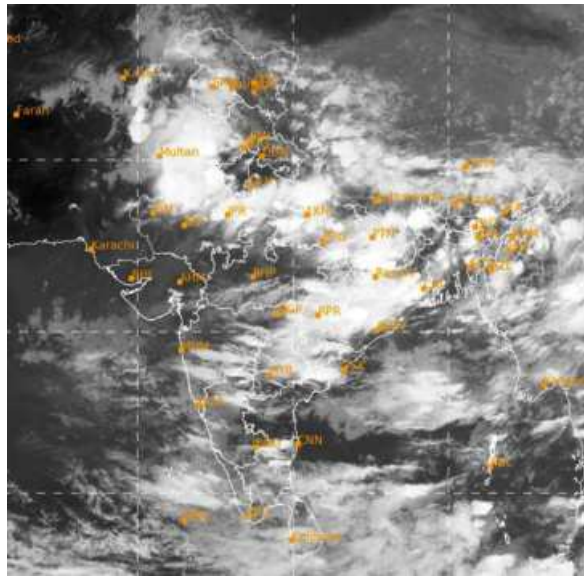
where he is currently undergoing treatment.

Senior police officers and local residents commended the head constable for his presence of mind, courage and prompt response, stating that his timely intervention was instrumental in saving the man's life.
