

Six dead in lightning strikes in Bihar

Bihar: At least six people died in separate lightning strikes in Bihar's Banka district, police said Monday. Additional District Magistrate (ADM) A.K. Kumar said reports have been sought from the police stations concerned over the deaths that occurred on Sunday in Khaba village, 35-year-old Brahman Singh Yadav and his seven-year-old son Prince Kumar died in their paddy field, police said. The two had taken shelter under a tree to escape from rain when they were struck by lightning. A person identified as Inam Yadav (son of Golahu village and Sarla Devi (39) of Libharan village died.

₹5cr fine on catering cos for poor food quality

New Delhi: After inquiries from several complainants regarding poor food quality in trains and unhygienic pantry cars over the last three years, a fine of Rs 5.15 crore has been imposed on service providers, railway minister Ashwini Vaishnaw said in the Rajya Sabha. Congress MP Chandrakanth Hanotra, while raising the issue of food quality served on premium trains, had asked about the number of complaints received regarding poor food quality in unhygienic pantry cars and food on premium trains during the last three years, state-wide and zone-wise. Hanotra also sought to know the statutory action taken against IRCTC for alleged overcharging and serving substandard food or less than the prescribed quality. "Indian Railways serve about 59 crore meals every year on average. About only 0.0008% complaints are received on average. Based on inquiry on these complaints during the last three years, a fine of Rs 5.15 crore has been imposed," Vaishnaw said in a written reply on Friday. "Indian Railways continuously endeavour to provide good quality and hygienic food items to the travelling passengers as per the prescribed norms," he said.

Military integration key to robust defence ecosystem: Rajnath

'To Tackle Emerging Challenges'

New Delhi: Defence minister Rajnath Singh on Monday said there was a need to "deepen integration" between the military and civil components of the defence ecosystem to tackle evolving security and technological challenges.

In his address at the foundation day celebrations of Armed Forces Headquarters (AFHQ) Civilian Services Day, he also said that if officers of the AFHQ Civilian Services develop defence-specific common cyber tools leveraging their expertise, it could prove beneficial to the defence ecosystem.

Singh emphasised that both the uniformed and civil services share the same commitment of "nation first" and "understanding of warlike, every element of the system transforms into national strength."

Underlining that defence forces are marching towards greater jointness with new vanguard, he said there was a need to deepen integration between the military and civil components of the defence ecosystem to foster greater synergy within the defence ecosystem to tackle evolving security and technological challenges.

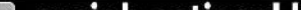
He also suggested that a "potential for coop between India, Uzbekistan in mining"
