SC closes criminal cases against Samay, 4 others

NEW DELHI: The Supreme Court on Friday quashed criminal proceedings against comedian Samay Raina and four other comedians over insensitive remarks concerning persons with disabilities on the show "India's Got Latent", appreciating their subsequent efforts to organise events and raise awareness and funds for people suffering from spinal muscular atrophy (SMA).

A bench of Chief Justice of India Surya Kant and justices Joyimalya Bagchi and V Mohana closed the proceedings against Raina, Vipul Goyal, Balraj Paramjeet Singh Ghai, Sonali Thakkar alias Sonali Aditya Desai and Nishant Jagdish Tanwar.

"Once there are genuine efforts, positive results are bound to be there. They are very bright youngsters. If they have started working in positive direction, there will be positive output," the bench said.

The court, however, kept the broader issue arising from the case alive, saying it would consider suggestions from persons with disabilities and issue appropriate directions on ensuring greater sensitivity and safeguards in online content.

The court recorded that the five respondents had organised a chess tournament for persons with disabilities from March 14 to 16 this year, which received widespread media coverage and generated awareness about organisations working for persons with disabilities, including SMA.

The event also involved donations to organisations working for the cause. Four further shows had been

planned for fundraising, but could not be organised with the participation of persons with disabilities because of logistical difficulties. The respondents have now expressed their willingness to invite persons suffering from SMA and provide financial support, the court noted.

The bench also appreciated the "constructive conversation" that had taken place between the comedians and the Cure SMA Foundation, which had approached the court over the content concerning persons with disabilities.

The respondents and the NGO had discussed the structure and material for programmes aimed at celebrating the lives of SMA warriors. The respondents had expressed gratitude for the Foundation's guidance and were in the process of obtaining consent from SMA warriors for their participation, the court noted.

"We have no doubt that respondents 6 to 10 will work hard in their endeavour to organise events for celebrating the lives and increasing dignity of SMA warriors," it said.

The court accordingly ordered: "Matter qua respondents 6-10 is closed. Criminal proceedings against respon-

dents 6-10 are hereby quashed. All other related proceedings are set aside."

The development marks a significant development from the court's criticism of Raina and the other comedians last month, when it had imposed a cost of Rs 3 lakh each for failing to comply with an undertaking given to the court.

On July 13, the bench had noted that Raina had taken the court "for a ride" after he failed to comply with an undertaking to make amends for the depiction of persons suffering from SMA on online shows.

"If this is not arrogance, then we may have to change the definition of this term in the Oxford Dictionary," the bench had said.

The court had earlier directed Raina and others to show remorse and engage with members of the SMA Cure Foundation, including by featuring them on their shows to raise funds and awareness about the condition.

They had subsequently told the court that they had been unable to contact members of the Foundation and had instead organised programmes involving other specially abled persons. The explanation had not satisfied the court at the time, prompting it to impose the costs and warn of coercive action if the amount was not deposited.

On Friday, however, senior advocate Aparajita Singh, appearing for the Foundation, told the bench that there had since been genuine efforts to engage with the respondents and that discussions were underway on the proposed programmes. "Our main prayer was for the guidelines," said Singh, adding that the Founda-

tion remained receptive to further suggestions and the process was "a work in progress".

The bench then said that the court was confident that genuine efforts would produce positive results. The court also explained why it was keeping the larger issue open despite closing the criminal proceedings against the five comedians.

The CJI said that he had interacted with several persons with disabilities on Thursday and that the interaction had been "quite a learning and eye opener". "Sometimes we feel that we have a fair bit of information but that is not the truth. There are many things that we learn when we meet them and the challenges which they face," he added.

The court asked persons with disabilities and the NGO to submit their suggestions on measures that could address the broader concerns arising from online content. "You are also going to give us a lot of recommendations. We will wait for that also and then some comprehensive directions can be issued," it said.

The proceedings had arisen in the larger controversy surrounding the online show "India's Got Latent", which had earlier led the Supreme Court to examine the need for safeguards governing online content and the balance between freedom of speech and the right of individuals and sections of society to live with dignity.

The court had previously asked Attorney General R Venkataramani to assist it on the broader question of framing guidelines to ensure that freedom of speech and expression does not infringe the right of others to live with dignity.

Moment in history that tore apart several lives: PM recalls Partition

NEW DELHI: Prime Minister Narendra Modi remembered the victims of the 1947 Partition on Friday, the eve of Independence Day.

The Modi government has been observing August 14 as the 'Partition Horrors Remembrance Day' since 2021 in remembrance of those who lost their lives in riots after the country's division and the ensuing exodus.

"Today we mark #Partition-HorrorsRemembranceDay. We recall the courage of all those who were impacted by Partition. It was a moment in history that tore apart several lives - families were uprooted, loved ones were lost and immense suffering was endured," Modi said on X.

The prime minister said that despite the turmoil, people rebuilt their lives from nothing, turned adversity into achievement and contributed to the nation's progress. Their lives remind everyone of the strength of the human spirit, he said.

'Victory Day': Taliban set to host first reception in India

NEW DELHI: Five years after storming to power in Afghanistan, the Taliban regime is set to host its first ever public reception in India next week to mark the anniversary of its "Victory Day", reflecting the broadening engagement between the two sides.

The "celebration and reception" on August 17 is being hosted by Noor Ahmed Noor, the Taliban's chargé d'affaires at the Afghan embassy in New Delhi, and the event is expected to be attended by diplomats, prominent members of society, members of the Afghan diaspora and the media. "The reception will be like other events that used to be hosted by the Afghan embassy before the fall of the Ashraf Ghani government in August 2021. It will be different as it is the first event being hosted in New Delhi by the Taliban," a person familiar with the matter said.

The Indian government is expected to be represented at the event, though it was not immediately clear exactly who will attend the reception, a second person said. The Indian side, which like most other countries doesn't officially recognise the Taliban regime in Afghanistan, is expected to keep a close eye on

diplomatic symbols used at the reception, such as the flag. The formal invitation for the event referred to Noor as the chargé d'affaires of the "Embassy of the Islamic Emirate of Afghanistan" in India. Over the past few months, Noor — who usually keeps a low profile — has been spotted at a handful of diplomatic receptions hosted by various countries in New Delhi. The upcoming reception will be his first major public engagement, the people said.

Noor, the first Taliban-appointed official posted in the Indian capital since the group took control of Afghanistan, arrived in the country in January. Since then, he has interacted with officials of the external affairs ministry on several occasions, reflecting India's deepening engagement with the Taliban to secure its interests in Afghanistan. He earlier served as

director general of the first political department at the foreign ministry in Kabul and was part of the delegation that accompanied Taliban foreign minister Amir Khan Muttaqi on his visit to India last October. It was during Muttaqi's visit — the first by a senior Taliban functionary to India — that New Delhi agreed to allow the group to post its diplomats in the Capital. Two other Taliban officials posted to India — Ikramuddin Kamil and Habibur Rahman Aftab — currently head the Afghan consulates in Mumbai and Hyderabad.

Following Muttaqi's visit, India decided to upgrade the status of the "technical mission" in Kabul to a full-fledged embassy. At the time, the external affairs ministry said its decision "underscores India's resolve to deepen bilateral engagement" with Afghanistan.

Since Muttaqi's visit, three more Taliban leaders have travelled to India to discuss cooperation in different areas — industry minister Nooruddin Azizi in November 2025, health minister Noor Jalal Jalali in December 2025, and agriculture minister Ataulah Omari in July this year.

India allocated ₹150 crore for Afghanistan in budget for 2026-27. India has provided humanitarian aid to Afghanistan and backed it during recent tensions with Pakistan.

CHINA AND INDIA AMONG 5 NATIONS LEADING WORLD'S TOTAL PROPOSED COAL CAPACITY

NEW DELHI: Five countries — China, India, Australia, Russia, and South Africa — account for nearly 92% of the world's proposed coal capacity, a report by US-based Global Energy Monitor (GEM) has found, highlighting the concentration of future coal development even as countries shift towards cleaner energy.

China alone has 1,321 million tonnes per annum (Mtpa) of coal mining capacity in development which is more than the rest of the world combined.

It is also more than twice India's 638 Mtpa proposed capacity, according to the report which is based on 2025 data.

"Coal mine development became even more concentrated in 2025, with just five countries — China, India, Australia, Russia, and South Africa — accounting for nearly 92% of proposed capacity (2,314 of 2,521 Mtpa), up from 89% in 2024. Development activity was once again dominated by China, which has 1,321 Mtpa in development, more than all other countries combined."

In all these trends highlight that coal's global persistence is increasingly driven by a limited number of countries rather than broad-based global demand," the report states.

India recorded the sharpest increase in planned coal development in 2025, with proposed mining capacity nearly doubling to 658 Mtpa from 329 Mtpa a year earlier, the report said.

"If built, the projects would commit India — a country with no formal coal phase-out timeline — to years of coal expansion, and would put a 1.5°C-aligned transition away from fossil fuels farther out of reach," it said.

The report, which draws on data from the Global Coal Mine Tracker, said proposed global coal mining capacity increased 11% in 2025 to 2,521 Mtpa.

China had 557 Mtpa of late-stage capacity, of which about 81%, or 450 Mtpa, consisted of underground mines, which generally take longer to develop.

India's late-stage pipeline was much smaller at 101 Mtpa, but about 90% of it consisted of surface mines.
