

Babus push Aadhaar for rest, resist for own health scheme

Linking Has Helped State Ensure Transparent, Leak-Proof Delivery

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Over 3,100 Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) schemes and more than 360 public services currently use Aadhaar-based authentication/verification, said a statement issued by PIB some months back. Interestingly, the bureaucracy that makes the rules compelling common people, often the poorest, to struggle with Aadhaar linking, has itself resisted linking Central Govt Health Scheme (CGHS) cards to Aadhaar despite the scheme being 90% funded with public money. There is no annual verification or scrutiny to weed out cards of dead pensioners or their dependents who might have become ineligible. Aadhaar linking



“has helped state ensure targeted, transparent, and leak-proof delivery while eliminating duplicate and ineligible beneficiaries” said the PIB statement issued on March 27. However, the bureaucrats aren’t walking the talk when it comes to doing the same for their own health scheme. Two other central govt health schemes, the Ex-Servicemen Contributory Health Scheme (ECHS) and the railway health scheme, have made it mandatory to link Aadhaar. Govt has issued office memoranda making Aadhaar linking

mandatory several times starting from June 2015, but has had to withdraw it in the face of stiff resistance from its employees. The last such withdrawal happened in July 2024 when govt was forced to keep the directive to link CGHS beneficiary ID with Ayushman Bharat Health account ID (ABHA ID), created using Aadhaar, “in abeyance till further orders”. The linkage has since been made voluntary for central govt employees, though it is mandatory for a poor woman to get Rs 300 as daily wage under the employment guarantee scheme.

While Aadhaar has been mandated for “welfare schemes funded from the Consolidated Fund of India” including many DBT schemes, babus have been arguing that CGHS is a

contributory scheme and not a DBT scheme, despite 90% of spending on the scheme coming from the Consolidated Fund of India. Their contributions amount to a tiny part of the annual expenditure on the scheme.

CGHS incidentally has a higher per capita expenditure when compared to ECHS and the railway health scheme. It would in reality be even higher if deceased beneficiaries and ineligible dependents had been weeded out. Cards of dependents including deceased parents, daughters and sisters who might have got married or employed or both, and of sons who might have got employed, remain in the system as the validity of such cards are for ‘lifetime’.

Many foreign nationals join Nepal’s animal rescue efforts

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Dehradun: As rescue agencies continue searching for people in flood-hit areas of Nepal, animal welfare groups are running a parallel operation to rescue stranded animals, provide medical aid, and safely dispose of carcasses to prevent health risks.

TFC (Thanks For Caring) Nepal, Pawdassy Nepal, and Karmayog Foundation are among the organisations involved in the effort.

TFC Nepal, whose volunteers include people from India, Germany, and several other countries, has so far rescued around 15 dogs. Some were found stranded on balconies of houses buried under silt after their owners died or went missing.

Tula Ram Rajbanshi, founder of TFC Nepal, told TOI from Kathmandu that the rescued dogs were being



given primary medical care before being brought to Kathmandu for better shelter and treatment.

“Just like humans, the animals who survived the disaster are in extreme trauma. They are still scared and avoid going near people. But they are injured and need medical care. Our volunteers are somehow managing to rescue them and provide the required treatment in these challenging times,” Rajbanshi said.

He said a team of around 12 volunteers left for flood-affected Rasuwa and nearby areas on Saturday to locate

and bury animal carcasses. The team had collected essential material, including PPE kits, on Friday.

“Just like decomposing human bodies, the carcasses could pose a health risk to survivors. We will locate them and ensure they are properly buried,” Rajbanshi said.

Meanwhile, Karmayog Foundation, which has been involved in relief work in flood-hit areas for the past few days, is arranging food for animals, said Saurav Rimal of the organisation.

Rimal said caring for animals was particularly important in Nepal, where dogs are revered during Kur-Tihar, a festival dedicated to them.

“In our culture, we have deep respect for animals. Hence, it is our duty to stand by them in this hour of need without discrimination,” he said.

DNA profiling of kin of missing TN tourists begins in Thanjavur

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Trichy: Ten days after flash floods in Nepal left several Tamil Nadu tourists untraceable, DNA profiling of their first-degree relatives began at Thanjavur Medical College Hospital on Saturday. In the first phase, family members of 23 missing tourists gave blood samples for profiling. The autosomal STR DNA profiles of the relatives are expected to be shared online with Nepali authorities within 3-5 days for comparison with DNA profiles obtained from unidentified mortal remains of the flood victims.

The profiling is being carried out through the Regional Forensic Science Laboratory (FSL) at Pillayarpetti near Thanjavur. A dedicated team at Thanjavur Medical College Hospital is collecting blood samples from relatives between 10am and 4pm.

10-year-old UP boy offers piggy bank to help Nepal flood victims

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Lucknow: For 10-year-old Alfaz Sheikh, the little piggy bank he carried to the Kushinagar district magistrate’s office on Thursday held much more than coins and currency notes. It had a dream — carefully saved over months in one- and two-rupee coins and ₹10, ₹50 and ₹100 denomination currency notes.

But images of devastation in Nepal made him rethink what those savings meant. Instead of spending his savings on objects that children of his age crave for, the Class V student decided to give it to people

struggling for food, shelter and safety after the disaster in the neighbouring country.

A resident of Betia village in Kushinagar, Alfaz, son of businessman Imran Ali Siddiqui, reached the office of district

magistrate Mahendra Singh Tanwar with his father and handed over his piggy bank. He also submitted an application requesting the administration to ensure his savings reach those affected in Nepal.

Researchers identify 9 expanding glacial lakes in Himachal Pradesh

Shimla: The unprecedented devastation and loss of lives in the wake of the Nepal flash floods have set off the alarm bells for Himachal Pradesh, with researchers from the IIT-Mandi, identifying nine rapidly expanding glacial lakes in the state — terming them ticking “water bombs”.

These lakes could pose a serious threat to downstream communities as rising temperatures accelerate melting of glaciers across the Himalayas, IIT-Mandi researchers said. The researchers, through analysis of satellite imagery and other datasets, found that the number of glacial lakes in the Himalayan region has in-

creased by nearly 30 per cent over the past decade — their size, too, has expanded significantly.

This raises concerns over the possibility of sudden glacial lake outburst floods that could unleash massive volumes

of water and debris downstream, said Prof Dericks P Shukla, Founding Chairperson, School of Civil and Environmental Engineering, IIT-Mandi, who led the six-member research team. ¶
