

KERALA UNDER TYPHOON DOLPHIN EFFECT, BRACES FOR MORE RAIN

State also under influence of cyclonic circulations over TN, K'taka

KERALA is bracing for another spell of heavy rain over the next three days, with the IMD issuing orange alerts for several districts on Thursday. According to meteorologists, the indirect influence of Typhoon Dolphin over the western Pacific is expected to strengthen the southwest monsoon over Kerala until Saturday, bringing heavy rain to a state that has already received nearly half of its normal August rainfall in the first five days of the month.

Kerala recorded 226 mm of rainfall between August 1 and 5 against the normal 90.6 mm —

an excess of 149%. The IMD has upgraded rain alerts in several districts, warning of heavy to very heavy rainfall over the next two days.

IMD Director Neetha K Gopal told *TNIE* that the impact of the fresh spell could be significant as many parts of the state have already received substantial rainfall over the past few days. "The volume of rainfall alone does not determine the impact. The ground is already saturated, and minor landslips have been reported in several places," she said. Kerala is currently under the influence of multiple weather systems, including



cyclonic circulations over Tamil Nadu, Karnataka and the Bay of Bengal. According to IMD, Typhoon Dolphin is not directly influencing Kerala but is altering the larger atmospheric circulation. "Combined with a cyclonic circulation over the Bay of Bengal, the typhoon is strengthening the westerly winds that transport moisture from the Arabian Sea towards the state, leading to enhanced rainfall," Neetha said. However, IMD does not expect another major widespread rainfall event after August 8. The strengthening El Nino continues to pose a challenge to the southwest monsoon during the latter part of the season.

₹2,132cr school infra push, Gen Z in focus

TN BUDGET



The TVK government is transforming its youthful political momentum into policy with its maiden 2026-27 budget targeted at Gen Z. Finance Minister N Marie Wilson, in his revised budget for 2026-27, has attempted a tightrope walk to balance the implementation of populist poll promises of the TVK with fiscal prudence.

The budget weaved concrete schemes covering education, human capital, social infrastructure, employment generation, hostels, skills training, AI programmes, social infrastructure and anti-drug measures with repeated political and philosophical messaging underscoring that the younger generation is both the primary beneficiary and the engine of Tamil Nadu's future success.

Education emerged as the biggest priority, with announcements including the 'Super Clean Super Campus' programme for 10,000 government schools, the ₹2,132-crore 'Palli Niraivu Thittam' for infrastructure improvement in 3,734 schools, establishment of Perunthalaivar Kamarajar Schools of Excellence and

modern bicycles with helmets for nearly 5.32 lakh Class XI government school students at a cost of ₹277 crore. The TN SPARK programme will also be expanded to 2,600 schools to help students get a grip of emerging technologies.

With an allocation of ₹2,000 crore to equip college students with digital learning tools, the budget proposed 'Vetri Laptop Scheme', by rebranding an earlier DMK scheme.

To address the accommodation needs of students and young professionals, the government has announced the establishment of the Tamil Nadu Student Housing & Infrastructure Corporation. The agency will execute the 'TN-SUDAR' initiative to construct 200 Integrated Student Hostels with one lakh beds through a Public-Private Partnership model at an estimated cost of ₹3,200 crore.

HYDERABAD : A four-year-old boy was critically injured after his father allegedly hurled him to the ground and attacked him with a stone near PVNR Expressway under the Gudimalkapur police station limits on Wednesday. Media trial plaintiff by Dileep: Chargesheet filed

KOCHI : The Kerala government has informed the High Court that the investigation into the five FIRs registered over the alleged media trial of actor Dileep in connection with the 2017 actor abduction and sexual assault case has been completed, and chargesheets have been filed before the court. The FIRs were registered based on a complaint filed by Dileep, who alleged that details of the trial in the 2017 actor abduction and sexual assault case were published in violation of the court's directions. **ENS**

TG, Maha to talk Tummidihatti: Centre

HYDERABAD : Telangana CM A Revanth Reddy urged Union Jal Shakti Minister CR Patil to convene a meeting between the Telangana and Maharashtra governments to resolve the long-pending issue of increasing the height of the proposed Tummidihatti barrage on the Pranahita river. Patil said a meeting would first be organised under the leadership of the Central Water Commission. He also assured that a meeting between the Irrigation ministers of the two states would be arranged subsequently. **ENS**

'LAPSES BY MGMT IN ENSURING SAFETY STEPS'

AFTER the incident, the relatives of the victims protested near the factory demanding adequate compensation and action against the management.

Pacifying any concerns over a wider spread of the chemical, a scientist told *TNIE* that the effect of sulphur dioxide release remains only for a few minutes and to a limited area. The leak does not spread far and dissipates within a few minutes. There are no leftover effects either, he added.

Yadgir SP Prathvik Shankar told *TNIE* over phone that based on a complaint filed by Joint Director of District Industry Centre B Satishkumar, an FIR was registered against CIL Laboratory Manager KV Murthy, Human Resources Officer Madhu and site in-charge Shiyakumar. Prima facie, there was a lapse by the management in ensuring safety measures, he added.

Medical Education Minister Dr Sharan Prakash Patil, who is monitoring the drought situation in Yadgir district, visited the spot and interacted with officials. Patil told *TNIE* that he instructed Yadgir Deputy Commissioner Rahul Pandve and the SP to act against the CIL management. Steps will be taken to ensure compensation to the next of kin of the deceased from CIL and also the government, he said.

Patil said he instructed officials of the Karnataka State Pollution Control Board to conduct tests in other factories in the industrial area to ensure that safety measures are in place and to submit a report to the government. Home Minister Priyank Kharge in a press note stated that he has asked officers to conduct an inquiry and submit a report to the government. The DC and SP visited the spot, he added.

The industrial area houses 27 factories, of which four shut down a couple of years ago. Those staying near the factory said that a similar incident took place a few years ago at the factory, but there were no casualties at that time. They urged the authorities to conduct thorough tests of all chemical factories in the industrial area. North-East Range IGP Shantanu Sinha apart from the SP and DC visited the spot.

Kharge stated that CIL has promised to provide a compensation of Rs 20 lakh to the kin of each deceased and all facilities under ESIC and Factories Act.
