PILGRIMS who returned from Nepal to Tamil Nadu after the devastating flash flood can contact Tele MANAS helpline number 14416 to prevent or handle post-traumatic stress disorder, Tamil Nadu Health Minister Dr K G Arunraj told *TNIE* at Kakkadhasam near Denkanikottai.

Arunraj visited Krishnagiri district to inaugurate the community baby shower programme for over 400 antenatal mothers and buildings constructed by the health department worth ₹5.70 crore at Anchetti government higher secondary school.

The minister told *TNIE*, "The state government is talking with the rescued people and monitoring their mental health. People in need of mental health support, can contact the 14416 helpline number."

Talking about the illegal sex determination rackets in the state, he said, "Serious action will be taken against people who are involved in sex determination and sex selective abortion in the state. The gov-

ernment is planning to give an incentive amount to informers who give alerts regarding such rackets."

He further added, "More 108 ambulances will be stationed at tribal areas for people to quickly access the vehicle. In Krishnagiri district, neurologist, cardiologist, will be appointed at the Government Krishnagiri Medical College Hospital. We have also provided more doctors and nurses to the District Headquarters Hospital at Hosur."

The minister inspected District Headquarters Hospital, Hosur and Denkanikottai government hospital.

Residents of Urigam and Kottayur panchayats petitioned to upgrade the existing PHC at Urigam, through which about 21,000 people will be benefited in four panchayats in tribal areas.

He also visited a PHC at Kakkadhasam village in Thalli block and he interacted with people and health staff, where he started his career as a doctor in 2004 and worked for 5.5 years.

Minister for Industries S Keerthana informed people that soon 4,000 youths will get job opportunities at the Ultraviolet company near Krishnagiri.

Eco-friendly norms for Vinayagar Chaturthi fete

AHEAD of Vinayagar Chaturthi celebrations, the Salem district administration has issued guidelines on eco-friendly idol-making, decorations and immersion, urging the public to follow the Tamil Nadu Pollution Control Board norms to prevent pollution of water bodies.

Salem Collector K Elambavath said people should use Vinayagar idols made of clay and other environmentally safe, biodegradable materials and

idols made of Plaster of Paris (PoP), plastic or thermocol are prohibited.

For colouring the idols, people have been advised to use water-based, biodegradable and non-toxic natural colours and avoid chemical, non-biodegradable and oil-based paints.

For decorations, the administration has recommended natural materials such as dried flowers, hay and other eco-friendly materials, along with reusable cloth deco-

rations. Single-use plastic and thermocol should not be used for either idols or other decorations. People have also been advised against using decorative materials containing toxic chemicals and single-use items that would add to waste.

People have also been instructed to segregate and responsibly dispose of waste generated during the celebrations instead of dumping it indiscriminately. Most importantly, idols should be immersed only at locations

designated by the district administration, following the Pollution Control Board's guidelines. Immersion in unauthorised water bodies is prohibited.

The administration said water bodies such as rivers, lakes and ponds are important sources of water and urged the public to ensure that festival celebrations do not affect them. The collector appealed to people to cooperate with the authorities and celebrate Vinayagar Chaturthi in a responsible manner.



Man injured in jumbo attack at Bettamugilalam

A septuagenarian man of Kambalam village from Bettamugilalam panchayat was allegedly injured in an elephant attack in the Denkanikottai forest range on Friday evening.

Forest department sources said that B Siddhappa (77), of Kambalam village, allegedly went inside the Bettamugilalam forest for cattle grazing on Friday.

In the evening, he was attacked by a tusker, and his left leg was injured. Another villager who was returning from the forest found Siddhappa crying in pain and alerted the forest department. Following this, the forest department and health department rushed to the spot, and he was taken to Denkanikottai government hospital. He was then shifted to a private medical college hospital at Hosur.

Denkanikottai Forest Ranger, G Murali, told *TNIE*, "The victim is now in a stable condition."

NEAR SALEM

22-year-old held for theft, chain snatching attempt aboard train

A 22-year-old man was arrested after two passengers reported a theft and an attempted gold-chain snatching aboard the Thiruvananthapuram-Chennai Central Mail.

The complaints were received through the RailMadad portal from passengers travelling on Train No. 12624. In one incident, a woman passenger reported that her handbag containing a mobile phone and cash had been stolen, while another complaint stated that an attempt was allegedly made to snatch the gold chain of a woman passenger travelling in a sleeper coach.

Following the complaints, a joint team comprising personnel from RPF, GRP and the CIB, Salem, launched an immediate search and investigation.

During the overnight operation, the team apprehended G

Vishnu, a resident of Pathanthi, Kerala, and recovered the stolen goods. The GRP in Erode registered cases under the relevant provisions relating to robbery, snatching and theft.

Verification of the accused's criminal antecedents with the GRP and local police in Kerala revealed that he was allegedly involved in 14 theft and robbery cases registered at eight police stations between 2022 and 2025.

The accused was handed over to the GRP in Erode and produced before a court, which remanded him to judicial custody.

Railway authorities have advised passengers to remain vigilant during train journeys and immediately report theft, robbery or other untoward incidents through the RailMadad portal or the toll-free helpline 139.

Ghee bottles in drawer: Aavin suspends official

A deputy general manager (production) of Aavin (Salem) has been suspended after ghee bottles meant for sale were allegedly found stored in a drawer in her room on the dairy premises during an inquiry, sources said. Officials recovered the bottles during an inspection ordered by a senior official after receiving complaints about the matter.

The bottles were reportedly part of the stock meant for sale through Aavin's regular distribution channels. A video showing the recovery of the bottles during the inspection was also recorded, sources said.

Following the recovery, the official, identified as Saradha, was placed under suspension, pending a detailed inquiry. The authorities are examining the circumstances in which the bottles were allegedly kept in the room and whether the storage was in violation of the procedures followed for handling and distribution of Aavin products.
