

Census duty: Madras HC seeks State response as PG teachers seek exemption

MADURAI: The Madurai Bench of the Madras High Court on Tuesday sought a response from the State and suo

motu impleaded the Chief Educational Officers of southern and central districts in a PIL seeking exemption of postgraduate teachers from census duties for two months. The petitioner contended that their deployment for census work would affect the teaching of students appearing for public examinations.

The Division Bench comprising Justices CV Karthikeyan and R Sakthivel issued the direction when the Tamil Nadu Higher Secondary Post Graduate Teachers Association, Chennai, sought an interim order restraining the authorities from allotting census duties to PG teachers in August 2026 and February 2027, particularly those handling Classes X and XII in government and government-aided schools in southern and central districts. Though the association acknowledged that cen-



sus duty was of vital national importance, it contended that deploying PG teachers for such duties during the ongoing academic session would seriously affect classroom teaching, completion of the prescribed syllabus and revision sessions aimed at preparing students for public examinations.

The association also contended that PG teachers teaching students from poorer sections in government and government-aided schools were being assigned census duties. In contrast, teachers in private schools continued to

teach full-time. Students in private schools were comparatively from affluent economic backgrounds, it said.

The association pointed out that there were about 59 government departments in the State with numerous employees whose assistance could be sought for census work. It also said the government could consider involving NGO members in the exercise.

The petition further stated that some PG teachers in the association were aged over 55 and suffering from various health ailments.

Archaeologist A Michael Dinesh Joel, who conducted the survey with K

Karuppasamy, believes the findings warrant a detailed excavation to understand the history of the region. The survey was undertaken while looking for the cultural continuity of Pattanamurudhur, where the Tamil Nadu Archaeology Department is currently conducting excavations. Pattanamurudhur, around 6 km from the 'Odai' site, was an important centre for conch-cutting and making ornaments during the medieval period. But the evidence from the 'Odai' area appears to tell a longer story.

The northern part of the site has yielded evidence from the medieval period, while Sangam-era remains have been found in the southern portion. Spread across more than 300 acres, the site has

yielded black-and-red ware pottery, pottery with graffiti marks, burial urns, carnelian beads, decorated conch bangles and pieces left over from conch-cutting.

Iron slag and foreign pottery have also been found, along with medieval-period red ware, glass beads, conch and glass bangles, copper coins, terracotta figurines and pipes. Among the more striking finds are Chinese celadon and Barcelona pottery sherds, which Joel says point to international maritime trade.

"Over the past two years, I have been conducting field surveys and documenting various archaeological sites in Thoothukudi district. While looking for the cultural continuity of the Pattanamurudhur excavation, we surveyed the 'Odai' area," Joel said.

Kin protest after 14-year-old dies following coma in Theni



THENI: Relatives and lawyers of a 14-year-old boy who died after remaining in a coma for more than 60 days staged a road blockade outside the Theni Government Medical College Hospital, alleging that wrong treatment at Periyakulam Government Hospital led to his condition and death.

The protesters, who refused to receive the boy's body, staged the blockade on the Theni-Madurai highway in front of the government medical college hospital. The protest briefly affected

traffic in the area. Police from K Vilakku station held talks with the protesters and persuaded them to withdraw the agitation. The family members and lawyers later went to the district Collectorate and submitted their demands. They sought stringent action against the doctors who allegedly provided wrong treatment to the boy, compensation for his family and a government job for one of his family members.

The deceased was identified as Nivas Kumar (14), son of Sudha of

Saruthupatti near Periyakulam in Theni district. According to the family, Nivas Kumar was admitted to the Periyakulam Government Hospital on June 2 after he developed severe cold and fever. Doctors who examined him reportedly said that he had a growth in his nose and advised an endoscopy procedure to remove it. The family alleged that during the procedure, a tube that

was supposed to be inserted through the airway was instead inserted through the food pipe. They claimed that the boy's condition deteriorated following the procedure. He was subsequently shifted to the Theni Government Medical College Hospital for further treatment and admitted to the intensive care unit. He remained unconscious and in a coma for more than 60 days, according to the report.
