In May, SC directed immediate FIRs for all missing adult persons Woman goes missing; Navi Mum cops lodge kidnap case

Navi Mumbai Police have registered a kidnapping case after a 23-year-old woman went missing from her home, implementing Supreme Court directions requiring police to immediately register an FIR when any person, including an adult, is reported missing. The case was registered at NRI Coastal Police Station on September 7 under Section 140(3) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita against an unidentified person. “We are aware of the court

directions and we have now started filing kidnapping cases in missing-person incidents in case of adults as well. The first such case was registered at NRI Coastal Police Station,” Navi Mumbai Police Commissioner Milind Bharambe said. The woman’s husband is an Army jawan posted along the China border. According to the complaint, she left home after an argument with him over the phone. Her family approached the police over concerns about her safety. Police registered a kidnapping FIR and launched an

investigation to trace her.

The Supreme Court directions came in SLP Crl No 11263/2025. A bench comprising Justice Ahsanuddin Amanullah and Justice R Mahadevan had on May 22, 2026, directed all states to immediately register an FIR upon receiving information about a missing person. The court later clarified that “person” covers everyone, irrespective of age or gender, after some states and administrative authorities interpreted it as referring only to minors. It also issued contempt notices to chief secretaries

and directors general of police of states that failed to comply with the Supreme Court’s earlier directions. Earlier, police generally recorded missing-person reports for adults without routinely invoking kidnapping provisions unless circumstances suggested abduction. Such cases were earlier handled primarily as missing-person complaints by police. The court also directed integration of police portals nationwide within six weeks to improve information sharing and coordination in tracing missing persons.

MACT awards ₹21.87L to injured Navy sailor

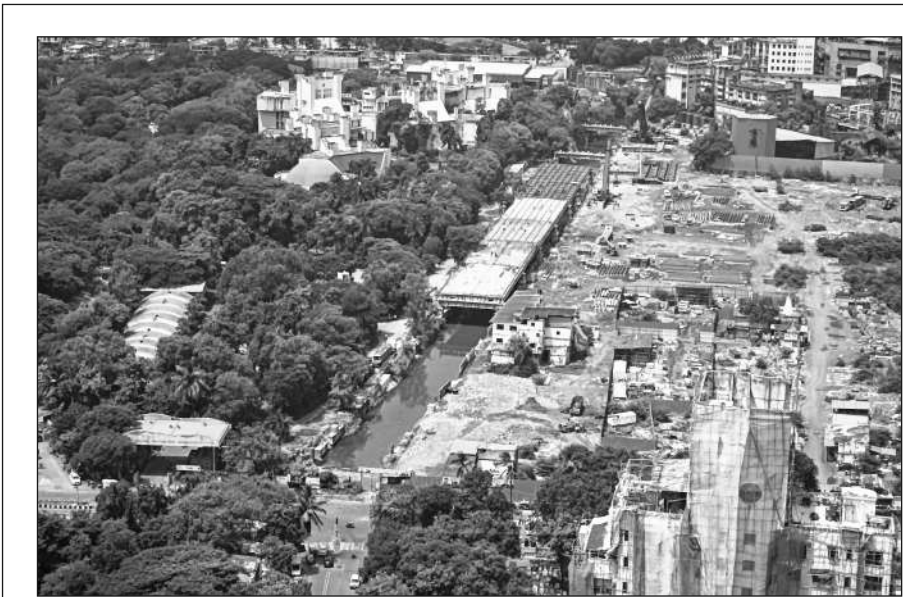

The Mumbai Motor Accident Claims Tribunal (MACT) has directed a Tardeo-based man and United India Insurance Company to jointly and severally pay ₹21.87 lakh to Indian Navy sailor Sheikh Imtiyaz Khan, who suffered 45% permanent locomotor

disability after being hit by the man’s bus in 2018. The insurer was directed to pay the award with 7.5% annual interest from the filing date until realisation. Khan, then a Petty Officer attached to INS Kalvari, was riding his motorcycle on GD Somani Road near Hotel Taj President on August 16, 2018, when the bus took a U-turn

and collided with him. He suffered a segmental fracture of his left femur and underwent surgery at INHS Asvini. His disability affected shipboard duties, promotion prospects and submarine allowance. The tribunal awarded ₹10.72 lakh for loss of submarine allowance and ₹5 lakh for reduced future earning capacity and employment opportunities.

“Consequently, the applicant’s disability had a real occupational dimension and cannot be dismissed merely because he continued to draw salary,” the tribunal observed. The tribunal found the bus driver negligent, rejecting the insurer’s contention that Khan caused the accident.

HC quashes hospital suit

The Bombay High Court has dismissed Wockhardt Hospitals Ltd’s appeal seeking over ₹1.23 crore in damages from physician Nitish Vyas, who resigned after giving seven days’ notice instead of the stipulated three months. A bench of Justices Girish Kulkarni and Neela Gokhale held that the hospital failed to provide evidence of financial loss caused by Vyas’s departure.

Vyas joined Wockhardt’s Rajkot facility as a consultant

in internal medicine and critical care under an agreement signed in August 2015. He resigned in September 2023 and stopped working seven days later. The hospital filed a summary suit seeking ₹1.44 crore, including ₹1,23,79,637 for loss of business, calculated using Vyas’s average monthly billing during his final three months. The trial court dismissed the suit ex parte in March 2026 for lack of evidence. Advocate Mohit Khanna, representing the hospital, argued: “The loss of business was calculated on a reason-

able estimate of potential loss, and no exact figure could be expected in a case where a senior doctor suddenly departs from the hospital.” Rejecting the argument, the High Court said compensation required proof of actual loss. “The basic obligation of the appellant was to establish that it actually had suffered such losses,” the bench said. The court noted that the hospital produced no evidence that patients were turned away or that it tried to hire a replacement physician to mitigate losses. It upheld the trial court’s order.

500 MLD water for Panvel from Shilar project

The state government has allocated 500 million litres per day (MLD) of water to the Panvel Municipal Corporation (PMC) from the proposed Shilar project in Karjat taluka, aimed at meeting the city’s growing water requirements up to 2057.

Panvel currently receives around 210 MLD from six sources, including Morbe Dam, Hetawane, the Ulhas and Patalganga rivers and PMC’s Dehrang Dam. The supply caters to around 5.4 lakh people, but the city currently faces a deficit of about 30 MLD. The Irrigation Department’s Shilar project is expected to take another five years to become operational and provide an additional water source for Panvel. Under the revised proposal, PMC will bear 75.42% of the project’s total capital expenditure, amounting to around ₹3,672.75 crore. The project was originally planned to supply water to Panvel, Navi Mumbai and other Mumbai Metropolitan Region areas. However, the state has approved Navi Mumbai Municipal Corporation’s full water reservation from the proposed Poshir project, leading to the revised Shilar allocation.
